Agent Suman Hedge celebrates the success of newly crowned champion Written Tycoon after struggle to establish stallion

Written Tycoon (Iglesia) will have awoken yesterday morning proudly settling into his new throne as Australia's champion sire.

But behind all the glitz and glamour that now surrounds him, the making of Victoria's newly-crowned king is a tale of toil and graft that saw him nearly never make it onto the breeding battlefield at all.

Alongside every monarch is his trusty lieutenant, one that has shown belief and unwavering loyalty to elevate them to a position

of power, which, in turn, can often prove the launching pad for their own careers and, in the case of Written Tycoon, one man has shared that journey from strife and struggle to success and sanctuary more than anyone else.

"The hardest part was the first part. That was actually getting someone to take him and then giving him the sufficient numbers to keep him going and make him a viable prospect," said bloodstock agent Suman Hedge, referring to the moment he and his boss, Sheriff Iskander, took the decision to retire Written Tycoon from his racetrack career and embark upon the long and winding challenge of making the stallion. *Continued on page 2>>*

GB: Away He Goes for the Melbourne Cup

British representation is likely to be considerably smaller in this year's Lexus Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) but one stayer primed for Australia's biggest race is Away He Goes (Farhh) after a career-best second in the Al Shaqab Goodwood Cup (Gr 1, 2m) on Friday. Newmarket trainer Ismail Mohammed plans to break new ground by saddling Away He Goes, his first runner in Australia, in the Flemington showpiece. Away He Goes, owned by Khalifa Saeed Sulaiman, is a three-time winner who has only once finished out of the first five in 15 starts, finishing second to Logician (Frankel) on debut in 2019. *Continued on page 13>>*

Hedge has traversed the trials, tribulations and, ultimately, jubilations with Written Tycoon since his days as a promising, but as yet unfulfilled, racehorse, being by the horse's side through his time working at Iskander Racing, through to a spell at Eliza Park where the stallion began his stud career, and then in nominations and sales at Woodside Park before moving on to pastures new and creating a successful, burgeoning career as a bloodstock agent.

On the track, Written Tycoon claimed the Todman Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at two and ran 11th in the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) when trained by Grahame Begg, but his career as a three-year-old, having been transferred to John O'Shea, was cut short with the horse requiring a tie back operation, a fact that made it harder to find a stud suitor.

“We always felt like there was this force against us,” said Hedge. “Rejection from the

market and from farms. We had offered him to so many farms across the journey and been told ‘he’s not good enough’ or ‘we can’t have an Iglesia’ or ‘he’s a Victorian horse’, all these excuses. And it just took such a long time to get him market acceptance.

“We eventually found a home for him at Eliza Park and I think he stood there for about six years, and initially it was really difficult because we just couldn’t sell nominations in him.”

On the face of it, a first season stallion garnering 118 covers in his first year is quite the satisfactory amount. Yet that figure does not explain the full story of the lengths taken to get those all important early numbers, which was reached through the enormous backing of the stallion through Iskander’s broodmare band and ‘selling’ nominations any which way they could.

“He was standing for \$8,000, but he never really stood at that figure. We were dealing him at \$5,000,” revealed Hedge. *Continued on page 4>>*

"Through a combination of sending our own mares, 40 or 50 of them, to the horse in the first couple of years, we were giving away a lot of nominations for free and doing deals such as 'three for \$9,000' and 'add him as a free nom if you went to another stallion,' such as God's Own. Anything we could to get numbers to the horse.

"We had situations where we were offering free nominations to people and they were rejecting it. We offered stallion tenders and nominations to racing clubs for free who would then auction them and they were rejecting him for that. It just felt like a lot of rejection for the horse."

The hard work was rewarded, however, with Written Tycoon claiming the champion first season sire mantle, success that attracted further attention from breeders, but still not the recognition his talent as a stallion warranted.

"He started off really well. He won champion first season sire and, from the get-go, he was pretty good," said Hedge.

"Early doors (he had) Masthead, which the Freedmans trained from his first crop. He was really important, because he was showing ability in the spring of the first crop and that helped us get numbers for the horse. I think he ended up running third in the Blue Diamond and then fourth in the Golden Slipper, so that really helped get the horse champion first season sire.

"But it probably wasn't until (Golden Slipper winner) Capitalist came through and that's when people started to take notice of the horse."

Mark Rowsthorn, who had recently taken over the running of Woodside Park from his father, Peter, spotted the talent of Written Tycoon and transferred him to his stud in 2013, with the stallion having spent one season at Eliza Park's Queensland property.

It was on the condition that Hedge went with him.

"A lot of people don't know, but when we moved the horse from Eliza to Woodside Park, part of the deal was that they had to take me with the horse. That was the deal that we brokered," Hedge revealed.

"Sheriff was very protective of me and he wanted to make sure I had a viable job, so he told them that if they wanted the horse they had to take me as the nominations person. They agreed and I stayed there a couple of years.

"To be frank, most of the work was already done before we even moved him to Woodside. Woodside certainly took on the horse in good faith and supported him well."

Hedge was quick to attribute the persistence and belief of Iskander as the principle reason behind the stallion's success, saying his backing of the horse in his early days almost left him with nothing.

"I'd say if it wasn't for Sheriff Iskander, that horse wouldn't even be standing at the moment. He just wouldn't be a commercial entity at all," he said.

"When I first met Sheriff he was a very wealthy guy and he had a lot of things going, and by the time I nearly finished he was nearly bankrupt by the industry. Fortunately Zoustar came along and then after Zoustar Written Tycoon really started hitting his straps and it worked out for him and everything was fine.

"I don't know many people that would risk what Sheriff risked on this

horse. His level of belief was unmatched. But for me, being so close to the horse, I know that he was the real reason for the horse being successful."

In April this year, ANZ Bloodstock News revealed Iskander had bought out Mark Rowsthorn's share in the stallion, before a deal was negotiated to take Written Tycoon to Yulong, where he will stand for \$165,000, having stood the 2020 covering season at Arrowfield Stud and, despite the horse having sired Group 1 winners Ole Kirk, Pippie and Odeum among 12 individual stakes winners this season, Hedge has delivered an ominous warning that the best is yet to come.

"He's obviously had multiple Group 1 winners throughout his career, but I honestly think the best is ahead of him," Hedge said.

"We really haven't seen the progeny of the best mares yet. It's really only his last two books, and the book that he's about to get this season, that's head and shoulders above any book that he'd served prior.

"The Arrowfield book was unbelievable and the Yulong book is going to be equal, if not better. Sometimes stallions don't always react to those better mares and they still perform similarly, but this horse has actually improved significantly since the mares have been getting better, so I think there's a good reason to believe that there's a lot to look forward to with him."

Written Tycoon will have a battle to keep his crown and, although at more of a distance, his lieutenant will continue to take up the fight to keep him there, having purchased several high-class mares to support the 19-year-old.

"(I still have) a strong interest in the horse, even commercially, and he's so commercial now that I think in terms of trainers that I'm working with, and I'm working with Rosemont Stud who bought a couple of colts by him this year, he just stacks up and makes a lot of sense.

"He's an outcross who produces these fast, early types and they sprint, so he kind of fits exactly what the market is looking for.

"I'd hope that I can buy more of them, I mean they're getting more and more expensive, but hopefully we can continue to. I bought some really good mares this year, I think, and a good selection of them will be going to him."

Ten for Sooboog

Dynamic Jewel (2 f ex Anniversary Jewel by Danroad) took her sire Sooboog (Snitzel) into double figures of winners for his first crop when the John Zielke-trained filly won the 850-metre two-year-old maiden at Wondai on Saturday. The Kitchwin Hills-based Group 3 winner is one of six stallions to reach ten or more winners from their first crop and he will stand for a fee of \$13,200.

From The Bush wins Forbes Cup

The Gayna Williams-trained From The Bush (Poet's Voice) justified favouritism to win the Forbes Cup (1600m) at the Club's feature meeting yesterday. From The Bush, a son of the late Poet's Voice (Dubawi), defeated Reward Seeker (Reward For Effort) by three-quarters of a length to claim the \$22,000 winner's cheque, with Toulon Brook (Hinchinbrook) in third, two and a half lengths behind the winner. Five-year-old From The Bush takes his record to five wins from 11 starts, and won the Highway Handicap (1400m) at Randwick on his start prior.

First Wootton Bassett winner in Australia

Coolmore's powerhouse sire Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj) has sired his first winner in Australia after the Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained Rapid Achiever won by three lengths on debut at Donald yesterday. The three-year-old northern hemisphere-bred mare was a €130,000 yearling purchase by John Foote out of the Arqana Deauville October Yearling Sale. She is out of Duke Of Marmalade (Danehill) mare Diavola, from the family of Prix du Jockey

Club (Gr 1, 2100m) winner and champion sire Darshaan (Shirley Heights) and dual Group 1 winner Daliapour (Sadler's Wells), as well as Too Darn Hot (Dubawi). Wootton Bassett, the sire of four Group 1 winners including Almanzor, will shuttle to Coolmore Australia in 2021 where he will stand for a fee of \$71,500.

First Melbourne winner for Hayes brothers

Ben and JD Hayes trained their first Melbourne winner together on the opening day of the new season as New Zealand import Mr Brightside (Bullbars) showcased his considerable talent at Sandown Lakeside on Sunday. Ridden to victory by jockey Craig Williams, the \$2.60 favourite took the Ticker Handicap (1600m) under BenchMark 64 conditions by three and three-quarter lengths. "It is really good to just get that first metro winner with my brother JD," Ben Hayes told Racing.com. "We've been knocking on the door, lots of seconds and it's been very frustrating but it's really good to get it and in the new season as well. Well done to everyone back at home, we've been working hard and it was a big result." Hayes believes Mr Brightside has Group 1 potential, reminding him of 2016 Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m)

winner He's Our Rokkii (Roc De Cambes) who was also sourced as an inexperienced horse from New Zealand. "The way he won here today, he can go straight to the city (on a Saturday) and be ultra-competitive. I think a Toorak, that could be a race he could pop up in if he keeps improving but he has to do that still." Hayes said.

Clarke with strong Darwin hand

Soon to be nine-time successive premierships-winning trainer Garry Clarke is confident his two horses Paghman (Ilovethiscity) and Reserve Street (Street Cry) are more than capable of taking out Monday's 2000-metre staying feature. The pair have had a similar preparation so far, both entering the race third-up and are looking to be thereabouts at the business end. Paghman has seen more market support than his stablemate, having gone very close in last year's edition of The Darwin Cup (2000m), when beaten half-a-length by Ihtsahymn (Ihtiram). "I'm not taking anything away from the winner but maybe we were a little bit unlucky cause he never jumped. He was last out of the gates in Alice (Springs)," Clarke said. Formerly trained by the Maher and Eustace team, Reserve Street has never been tested over the distance but is a horse that Clarke believes sets up perfectly for the Darwin Cup in terms of preparation and should not be underestimated even with the wide draw. "He is having his first crack at the 10 furlongs but they're the type of horses I take for the Darwin Cup, you need more of a miler, a tough front running mile horse, they still need a bit of brilliance to position up through the race. I'm happy to have him in even though he is unproven over the 2000 metres," Clarke said.

Everest contender up and Running

Arguably Sydney's most progressive sprinter, Lost And Running, has returned to trainer John O'Shea's Randwick stable and he is adamant that the horse is back better than ever. The Per Incanto (Street Cry) gelding has built a good record with six wins from seven starts, capturing the attention of Everest (1200m) slot holders, TAB, who have snapped him up to represent them in the \$15 million feature. Lost And Running claimed the Luskin Star Stakes (Listed, 1300m) at Rosehill in May, a race that has proven to be a strong form reference with Trekking (Street Cry), Osborne Bulls (Street Cry) and Clearly Innocent (Not A Single Doubt) all winning it and running competitively in the Everest the following spring. O'Shea said Lost And Running was shaping up well and would trial in the middle of August. "He was always a horse that just needed a bit of time. He has improved dramatically each preparation and this one is no different," O'Shea said. "He's not far off a trial. He trials on the 20th (of August) so everything is starting to come to hand for him. We're really looking forward to the next few months with him." With a slot in the Everest already booked, O'Shea is under no pressure to showcase Lost And Running's talents and can instead plot a path to the October 16 race to best suit the horse. The five-year-old will follow the same path that Everest winner Classique Legend (Not A Single Doubt) took 12 months ago, launching his campaign in The Shorts (Gr 2, 1100m) at Randwick on September 18.

Big spring plans for Savatoxl

A bigger and stronger Savatoxl (Kuroshio) can add to his Group 1 tally in the spring, according

to his trainer Tony McEvoy. McEvoy reported that his Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) hero is back in work in South Australia, although his upcoming racing agenda will focus only on interstate races. In a solid Autumn campaign, Savatoxl won Adelaide's feature sprint in May and finished a length off Vega One (Lope De Vega) in the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) at Eagle Farm. McEvoy said the six-year-old will attempt to emulate the feats of recently retired sprinter Hey Doc (Duporth) by winning the Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at The Valley and the Winterbottom Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Ascot. "He's back in work and I've got to say that physically, he looks like he's just arrived," McEvoy told Racing.com. "He's always been a long, narrow horse but now he looks incredible. He's had a nice spell after Queensland and he's actually in work up at our river property doing a bit of work in the morning and having a bit of paddock time during the day. We've got an exciting and an aggressive plan for him-I'd like to kick him off in the Schillaci Stakes and then go to the Manikato and the Winterbottom."

Ryan continues top form

Trainer Nick Ryan continued his winning form into the new season as Mynumerouno (Vancouver) claimed the first Flat race of the 2021/22 season in Melbourne at Sandown Lakeside on Sunday. Ryan saddled 12 winners from 51 starters in Melbourne last season, ending the previous period with Mahamedeis (Magnus) winning over 2040 metres at Moonee Valley yesterday. Mynumerouno should have added to Ryan's win tally last season when a luckless third at Sandown Hillside over 1000 metres on July 14 but atoned in Sunday's 1200-metre handicap for three-year-olds. "It was a great season," Ryan told Racing.com. "I had a lot of support, good staff and what a start to the new season. We thought he was a bit stiff the other day, he missed the start and he was still a little bit green but he was mowing them down late. We had him in yesterday in Adelaide (Morphettville) and Moonee Valley but we thought up to the 1200 metres and here (Sandown Lakeside) would suit better which it did." Mynumerouno has won two of

his three starts, opening his account over 975 metres with a well-backed win at Swan Hill during their three-day carnival in June. Ryan is currently unsure of what future targets may lie ahead. "We'll take him home and have a think about it but he's certainly going to measure up to something better," Ryan said.

Bred To Win back on TV screens

The popular breeding series fronted by Caroline Searcy, Bred To Win, returns to screens today, featuring a profile of the exciting crop of first season stallions and a review of some of the racemares that have set the sales ring alight in recent months. The first episode, which will profile Coolmore's dual Group 1-winning juvenile King's Legacy (Redoute's Choice), will air at 7.30pm (AEST) today on Sky Thoroughbred Central.

NEW ZEALAND

El Noir on the mark

El Noir, the five-year-old daughter of El Roca (Fastnet Rock), finally broke through for the win she had been promising of late, when taking out a Rating 65 1200-metre contest at Te Aroha on Sunday. The mare had finished second in four of her five attempts this campaign with Marsh keen to see her pick up a victory as a reward for that consistent run of form. Apprentice jockey Kozzi Asano positioned his mount nicely in midfield before angling out widest in the long Te Aroha home straight where El Noir produced a determined finish to gun down race favourite Notabadphelan (Proisir) with Red Inferno (Ifraaj) back in third after a titanic struggle in the final 300 metres. "She deserved that as she has been close in every race this time in," Marsh said. "She's not overly big, but she is very strong and is a good scrapper when it turns into a dogfight. I said to Kozzi before the race that the key was for her to get plenty of cover before having one shot at them and I thought he did that to the letter. It makes for a good start to the new season as we finished with a win at Rotorua yesterday (She's Apples) to round a great year as well."

Kauri earns first win

Twenty-two-year-old apprentice Liam Kauri had his first career winning ride aboard the Gail Temperton-trained Candy Cross (St Reims) at Otaki on Saturday. Kauri is the son of former jockey and trainer Paddy Kauri and has overcome a number of setbacks over the past two years as he battled to get his riding career underway. By his own admission he wasn't that interested in horses, despite the family association and he didn't contemplate a career in the saddle until he left school. "I grew up around horses but never actually rode one until I left school," Kauri said. "I wasn't that interested but after a while I thought I might give it a go, so I had to learn how to ride." Trainer Suzy Gordon took the young jockey on at her Foxton base. "Liam came to us a couple of years ago, never having been on a horse, so we started him off by learning to ride a pony," Gordon said. "He took to it well and when he was ready he went up to Lance O'Sullivan and Andrew Scott's stable in Matamata to further his development. Unfortunately, he had a bad accident and broke his leg so once he was all healed up, he came back to us about six months ago and he is now our stable apprentice." Kauri hasn't really thought about his goals for the new season, but knows he wants to build on his winning momentum as quickly as possible. "I've got some good contacts here in Foxton, so I will just be trying to get more rides and win as many races as I can," he said.

JPN: Terzetto bounces back in Queen Stakes

Terzetto (4 m Deep Impact - Raddolcendo by Danehill Dancer) bounced back to form when winning the Queen Stakes (Gr 3, 1800m) at Hakodate yesterday. The four-year-old had won five of her first six starts before a disappointing 14th-placed finish in the Victoria Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) in May, but showed no ill-effects from that performance in winning by a neck from Magic Castle (Deep Impact), while Frankel's (Galileo) Satono Cecil finished the same margin back in third. She is out of Danehill Dancer (Danehill) mare

Raddolcendo, a half-sister to Group 1 winner Loves Only You (Deep Impact) and Real Steel (Deep Impact).

INTERNATIONAL

38 for Kingman

Oriental Mystique (4 f ex Madame Chiang by Archipenko) got up in the dying strides to take the Prix Luth Enchantee (Listed, 2400m) at Clairefontaine yesterday for trainer David Simcock. The filly, a first foal out of Madame Chiang (Archipenko), went off the 21-10 favourite and made stealthy progress from the rear of the field to collar the eventual runner-up Tres Valentine (Fastnet Rock) with Sea Watch (Siyouni) comfortably beaten back in third, justifying her trainer's decision to send her over. The win marked the 38th individual stakes winner for her sire Kingman. She was bred and is owned by Miss Kirsten Rausing and ridden to victory by jockey Mickael Barzalona. Kingman stood at Banstead Manor Stud in 2021 for a fee of £150,000 (approx. AU\$284,000).

176 for Fastnet Rock

A win in the Grand Prix de Clairefontaine (Listed, 2400m) for the Andre Fabre-trained Joie De Soir (3 f ex Highest Ever by Galileo) gave super-sire Fastnet Rock his 176th individual stakes winner yesterday. The third foal by Highest Ever (Galileo), she sat in third position early on under jockey Augustin Madamet before being shaken up to lead with two furlongs to go, stretching three lengths clear of the second-placed Timour (Gleneagles) with Qaiser (Charm Spirit) a further length-and-a-half back in third. The winner is a homebred for Coolmore, whose stallion Fastnet Rock earned 19 individual stakes winners in Australasia last season and will stand at Jerrys Plains for a fee of \$165,000 in 2021.

GER: Palmas impressive in German Oaks romp

On a day to remember for jockey Eduardo Pedroza, the Andreas Wohler-trained filly Palmas (3 f Lord Of England - Peace Time by Surumu) coasted home to a six-length victory in the 163rd running of the Henkel-Preis der Diana (Gr 1, 2200m). Pedroza, who bagged a

Group-race double on the card, had his mount close up on the leaders before taking Palmas (Lord Of England) to the lead two furlongs out and kicking easily clear inside the final furlong. A listed contest winner in her only previous start, the twelfth foal out of Peace Time (Surumu) was a general 9-2 shot to take the step up in class. Easily beaten in second was Isfahani (Isfahan) with Noble Heidi (Intello) back in third place. The filly was bred and is owned by Gestut Etzean. Lord Of England stood for Gestut Etzean for a fee of €6,500 (approx. AU\$10,500) in 2021.

GER: Liberty London takes German Group 3

The Waldemar Hickst-trained Liberty London (5 m Maxios - Ledicea by Medicean) swooped late in the day to take the Fritz Henkel Stiftung-Rennen (Gr 3, 1600m) yesterday at Dusseldorf. Ridden by jockey Eduardo Pedroza, the daughter of Maxios (Monsun) tracked the pace before being delivered with her challenge inside the final two furlongs where she asserted close to home to beat the 11-10 favourite Jin Jin (Canford Cliffs) with Flamingo Girl (Soldier Hollow) back in third. A fourth foal out of Ledicea (Medicean), the mare took victory for owner-breeder Gestut Ittlingen. Maxios stood at Castle Hyde Stud in 2021 for a fee of €7,000 (approx. AU\$11,000).

GB: Back-to-back Queensferry Stakes for Judicial

A welcome return to form saw the Julie Camacho-trained Judicial (9 g Iffraaj - Marlinka by Marju) gain back-to-back victories in the Queensferry Stakes (Listed, 6f) at Chester racecourse yesterday. Having not really shone in his two starts so far this season, the gelding clearly appreciated the return to a track that he likes. Judicial (Iffraaj) stuck on well down the outside of the pack to draw clear inside the final 150 yards to score by two lengths and beat odds-on favourite Dakota Gold (Equiano) with the big-priced Zoetic (Kodiac) in third. Judicial was ridden by usual partner Callum Rodriguez and took the win for owner-breeder Elite Racing Club. Former shuttler Iffraaj (Zafonic) stood at Dalham Hall Stud in 2021 for a fee of £20,000 (approx. AU\$37,000).

FR: Classy Magny Cours takes Prix du Pays d'Auge

Magny Cours (6 g Medaglia D'Oro - Indy Five Hundred by A.P. Indy) gave jockey Mikael Barzalona and trainer Andre Fabre a Listed race double on the card at Clairefontaine when he took the Prix du Pays d'Auge (Listed, 1800m) yesterday. Already a dual listed winner in his career, Magny Cours (Medaglia d'Oro) took the contest from the second-placed Shadwell-owned Raabihah (Sea The Stars) with Celestin (Dabirism) back in third. An eighth foal, the filly is a homebred for Godolphin. Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado) stood at Jonabell Farm, Kentucky for a fee of US\$150,000 (approx. AU\$204,000).

GB: Away He Goes for the Melbourne Cup

British representation is likely to be considerably smaller in this year's Lexus Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) but one stayer primed for Australia's biggest race is Away He Goes (Farhh) after a career-best second in the Al Shaqab Goodwood Cup (Gr 1, 2m) on Friday. Newmarket trainer Ismail Mohammed plans to break new ground by saddling Away He Goes, his first runner in Australia, in the Flemington showpiece. Away He Goes, owned by Khalifa Saeed Sulaiman, is a three-time winner who has only once finished out of the first five in 15 starts, finishing second to Logician (Frankel) on debut in 2019. Mohammed said: "The plan is to go to Australia for the Melbourne Cup, then head back to Dubai for the winter with him. I've never had a runner in Australia, so it's exciting, and I hope we're going to the right place with the right horse. He'll go straight to the big race after quarantine over there. He's come back from Goodwood in good shape. He ran very well and surprised us as we were very worried about the ground. I was watching the race

and two furlongs out he was cruising. I thought 'Oh, come on, this our day', but he ran a great race to finish second. He ran some good races in Dubai in the winter and is lightly raced for a five-year-old. We've always thought he was a good horse and he has just improved with time. He's entered in the Ebor, which is an option, but he's more likely to go to Deauville that week instead."

Lexitonian (5 h ex Riviera Romper by Tapit) provided Speightstown (Gone West) with his 22nd individual elite-level winner as a sire when taking the Alfred G. Vanderbilt Handicap (Gr 1, 6f) on Saturday. A slightly surprising winner at odds of 34-1, the Jack Sistrone-trained entire was hustled away from the stalls to show early speed and lead in the opening quarter-mile, before being headed by the eventual runner-up Special Reserve (Midshipman) and rallying to take the race by half a length, with a further length-and-a-quarter back to Whitmore (Pleasantly Perfect) in third. Jockey Joel Lezcano said of his mount: "This horse is a very good horse. He tries hard all the time. He's the type of horse that needs to be involved, and sometimes he doesn't break all that well and has to stay in the back. He broke well today. Joel tried to get away from me, but when I dropped my hands, he took off again and won the race." A first foal out of Riviera Romper (Tapit), Lexitonian was bred and is owned by Calumet Farm. Speightstown stood at WinStar Farm, Kentucky for US\$90,000 (approx. AU\$122,000) in 2021.

Third for Banbox

The John Servis-trained Leader Of The Band (3 f ex Catsuit by Sir Cat) made it three individual stakes winners for sire Bandbox (Tapit) when he took the Monmouth Oaks (Gr 3, 8.5f) at

Monmouth Park on Saturday. The three-year-old filly staged a prolonged rally from mid-pack, coming home strong to beat the short-priced favourite Edie Meeny Mino Mo (Upstart) by two lengths with Midnight Obsession (Overanalyze) a further length-and-a-half back in third. Jockey Frankie Pennington rode the horse to victory and said: "Today she made a great run late. When the pace was up ahead of me, she felt pretty good and I was sitting there and every time I nudged her she was giving me something so I felt pretty comfortable coming out of the three-eighths turn. She clipped heels a little bit after the break and I was a little further back than I wanted to be but she is such a nice horse, she kept chugging and she got the job done." The third foal out of Catsuit (Sir Cat), Leader Of The Band was bred and is owned by SMD Ltd. Bandbox stood at Northview Stallion Station, Maryland for US\$2,500 (approx. AU\$3,500) in 2021.

11 for Trappe Shot

One Timer (2 g ex Spanish Star by Blame) made it 11 individual stakes winners for Trappe Shot (Tapit) when he took the Victoria Stakes (Listed, 5.5f) at Woodbine on Saturday. The Larry Rivelli-trained gelding made it two wins from two starts as he romped to victory with Twenty Four Mamba (Classic Empire) three and three-quarter lengths back in second and Concealed Carry (Competitive Edge) a further four-and-a-half lengths back in third. One Timer was ridden by jockey E T Baird and bred by St Simon Place Llc. The Spanish Star (Blame) first foal is owned by Richard Ravin and Patricia's Hope LLC and was sold for US\$21,000 to Vincent J. Foglia at the F-Tipton Kentucky Sales in October last year.

US: All Dandy for Essential Quality

Godolphin's Essential Quality (3 c Tapit - Delightful Quality by Elusive Quality) captured the Jim Dandy Stakes (Gr 2, 9f) for three-year-olds at Saratoga racecourse on Saturday. Ridden by jockey Luis Saez, the son of Tapit (Pulpit) endured a wide trip in the five-horse field and after taking it up two furlongs from home, he held off the hard-charging Keepmeinmind (Laoban) in the final 100 yards

with Masqueparade (Upstart) back in third. Jimmy Bell, President of Godolphin USA, said: "This was a hard-fought race. Obviously, he was a little wide but he found a way and overcame what he needed to do to get the job done and that's the mark of a really good horse. When things aren't always your way, they find a way." Essential Quality is a Godolphin homebred trained by Brad Cox. Tapit stood at Gainesway, Kentucky for a fee of US\$185,000 (approx. AU\$250,000) in 2021.

US: Dr Schivel returns with Bing Crosby win

Dr Schivel (3 c Voilence - Lil Nugget by Mining For Money) made a winning debut for new trainer Mark Glatt when he beat his elders to take the Bing Crosby Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) on Saturday. Held up in the rear early on, the colt made good progress mid-way through the race and made relentless headway in the final 100 yards to get up on the winning post to deny the Bob Baffert-trained Eight Rings (Empire

Maker) with C Z Rocket (City Zip) a very close third. Jockey Flavien Prat said: "He broke well, then when we went across the gap, he grabbed the bit. He was running well pretty much all the way around. He was game late—good win." Already a winner at the top-level when taking the Runhappy Del Mar Futurity (Gr 1, 7f) in September last year, the son of Voilence (Medaglia d'Oro) was unsold for US\$37,000 at the Keeneland All Ages sale in 2019. Dr Schivel (Voilence) was bred by William A Branch and Arnold R Hill and is owned by Red Baron's Barn LLC, Rancho Temescal LLC Et Al. Voilence stood at Hill 'N Dale Farms, Kentucky for US\$25,000 (approx. AU\$34,000) in 2021.

US: Cross Border goes back-to-back in Bowling Green

Cross Border (7 r ex Empress Josephine by Empire Maker) secured back-to-back victories in the Bowling Green Stakes (Gr 2, 11f) for trainer Michael J Maker on Saturday. The son of English Channel (Smart Strike) settled in third

for jockey Luis Saez before being urged along turning into the home straight, rallying four-wide before he took over the lead and went away at the finish to beat Rockemporer (Holy Roman Emperor) and Shamrocket (Tonalist), who finished second and third respectively. "He loves it here. This is a special horse that I love riding. He always tries hard," Saez said. "Today, he ran huge. It set up perfect with a good pace. When we came to the top of the stretch, he really gave me that kick and he battled. He always wants to give me everything. It all went according to plan." Cross Border was sold to Aquinnah Ventures for US\$180,000 at the Keeneland September Sale in 2015 before being re-sold to Robert Tiller for US\$10,000 in 2016 and finally to Three Diamonds Farm in 2018 for US\$100,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Sale. The horse was bred by Berkshire Stud and B D Gibbs and is currently owned by Three Diamonds Farm. English Channel stood at Calumet Farm, Kentucky for US\$27,500 (approx. AU\$37,000) in 2021.

Kharisma back to his best

A drop back down to his pet trip saw smart sprinter Kharisma bounce back to his brilliant best on Sunday.

The Mossman (Success Express) five-year-old certainly did not lose any admirers at his first mile test in the Stewards' Cup (Local Gr 2, 1600m) last month when only a one-and-a-half-length third to Mr Malek (Swiss Ace), but he was clearly more at home over the shorter 1200 metres of the \$100,000 Kranji Stakes A race.

Well handled by three-kilo claimer Iskandar Rosman from the widest barrier in the small but select ten-horse field, Kharisma got the gun run, one-out, one-back behind the speeding duo of Fame Star (Twirling Candy) and Makkem Lad (Kuroshio) while favourite Grand Koonta (Dark Angel) was tucked away in the box-seat.

Iskandar made the winning move when he clicked Kharisma up for a cruising run around the fighting pair, but held his fire for a few strides more before turning him loose.

It was a clever piece of riding that killed two birds with one stone – save his mount's energy for that final burst while keeping Grand Koonta under lock and key on the rails.

When Kharisma let rip inside the last 250 metres, James Peters' grey came across heels three abreast. To be fair, he still had enough time to peg the leader back, but Kharisma never stopped, and fell in with a neck to spare from his gallant challenger.

Makkem Lad did a sterling job to still hang on to third place another two-and-a-quarter lengths away, just fending off the three middle-distance performers of the race. Sacred Croix (Savabeel) finished a touch better to claim fourth place another short head away, a neck from Top Knight (Zoustar) in fifth place with Kranji Mile (Local Gr 1, 1600m) winner Minister (Street Sense) sixth another neck away.

Fame Star, who began as the second fancy,

wilted to finish seventh another half-length away, obviously softened up by Makkem Lad's pesky presence on his outside for most of the race.

Kharisma clocked the 1200 metres on the Short Course in 1.10.22secs and has now taken his handy record to eight wins, three seconds and three thirds from 18 starts for stakes earnings that have hit just a tick under the \$400,000 mark for Indonesian outfit Dago Stable.

All his previous seven wins were also recorded over six furlongs, with the first four coming on Polytrack. Though Kharisma has now scored an equal amount on grass now, winning trainer Stephen Gray for one has not brushed aside the all-weather for his classy sprinter, having already targeted the Merlion Trophy (Local Gr 3, 1200m) on November 27 as his main target, but he has not completely shut the door on another tilt at the mile either.

"They were keen in front and that set it up nicely for him today. Makkem Lad overraced and Vlad's horse was the horse to beat," said Gray.

"It was a brilliant ride from young Iskandar.

He also listened to the instructions, which was to come across if he could.

"He made full use of his light weight and he used his common sense. He trapped Vlad, who wanted to come out."

"That reminds me of the day he was in that situation when Lim's Lightning won. Sometimes, the draws can cost you."

"Still, James Peters later told me he didn't think his horse would have picked us up. My horse had the momentum and got the roll on."

"I'm very happy. He keeps stepping up, he's a very good, lovely, tough horse, and coming back from 1600 metres to 1200 metres, it was a very good effort."

"He had two quiet gallops, and he was fit. The race also had good prize-money."

"There's an Open race (Class 1) over 1400 metres in three weeks' time. We can have a go at that, then give him a freshen-up before the Merlion Trophy."

"I don't know about the mile of the Raffles Cup (on September 18). We have to be sensible in whatever we decide."

"This horse just keeps turning up, and he fully deserves to win a Group race one day."

Back-to-back wins for Written Tycoon's Lady

If there is one mare who has without fanfare impressed Kranji at her recent runs, it's Lady Sprintbok (Written Tycoon) who made it back-to-back wins in the \$50,000 Class Four Division One Polytrack race over 1200 metres on Sunday.

Following her maiden win (on turf) back in December, the Written Tycoon (Iglesia) four-year-old was stepped up in grade, but fell a little by the wayside. She was then freshened up, and it would seem the break has done her a power of good.

The chestnut mare had to tough it out from a wide trip for her second win in a similar Class four polytrack race over six furlongs last time out on July 10, but Sunday's slashing victory after she picked her way through an opening added an even more professional dimension to her make-up.

"Danny (Beasley) said to me she showed a bit of courage today when she was asked to go through a gap between two horses," said winning trainer Daniel Meagher.

"There was no issue at all, she just went through, and it was a pretty soft win in the end. I think she has developed into a fun horse to have at the stable.

"I bought her for A\$22,500 at the Inglis Digital (online auction) as a two-year-old and AJ (of AJ's Stable) took over her. Good for AJ as he doesn't have many horses left now.

"He kept this one as she's got a bit of upside, and he's also got Ararat Lady with Timmy (Fitzsimmons) who's, as we know, a very good mare."

The pace was brisk from barrier rise with Boom Shakalaka (Spirit Of Boom) and Samurai Express (Per Incanto) locking horns upfront while Lady Sprintbok (\$13) settled in their slipstream, a couple of lengths astern.

When Samurai Express faded out, clear room came up on the rails, which Beasley needed no second invitation to capitalise on. Lady Sprintbok lengthened up nicely underneath Boom Shakalaka before darting away to a one-and-a-half length win.

Strong N Best (Rock 'N' Pop) steamed home late for second place with Hotshots Slam (Swiss Ace) in third place another half-length

away. Lady Sprintbok clocked 1.10.97secs for the 1200-metre on the Polytrack.

Meagher said that his 19th winner for the season was a bit of a handful at the beginning, but has turned the corner with time and patience.

"She was naughty when she first came, but ex-jockey CS (Chin Seng) Chin rides her every single day, and she has really improved," said the Australian conditioner.

"She doesn't show much in trackwork. She looks like she's just cantering, but she turns it on on raceday."

With three wins and one second under her belt, Lady Sprintbok has now chalked up close to \$100,000 in prize-money for AJ's Stable.

Rocketship scores in Le Grange Quinella

Hot favourite Rocketship (Into Mischief) franked the promising form shown at her first couple of starts to break through for her maiden win in style in the \$75,000 Restricted Maiden (1200m) on Sunday.

Third at her first two starts back in June, including the latest in Novice company, the Ricardo Le Grange-trained and Paolo Mendoza-owned US-bred three-year-old filly by Into Mischief (Harlan's Holiday) came with a nice turn of foot to leave his \$9 backers without any doubt which way the outcome of their investment was heading.

After revealing precious little at his only start, Le Grange's second runner Dragon Tycoon (Written Tycoon) showed remarkable improvement second-up to claim second place. The Written Tycoon three-year-old, who is also raced by Mendoza, enjoyed a lovely cart off Rocketship throughout, and did try to lay a glove on his stablemate inside the last 200 metres, but had to eventually play second fiddle three-quarter length away for a stable quinella.

Steven Burrridge's and Dr Tan Kai Chah's Hippocrates Stable's Oud Wood (Epaulette) turned in his best run in eight starts to date to clinch his first runner-up cheque in third place another one and a half lengths away. At one stage up the home straight, the Hippocrates' yellow and purple checked colours looked in hot contention for victory with the James Peters-trained Dragon Sands (Dragon Pulse)

also sneaking up on the rails, but the pair were outsprinted by Mendoza's with Dragon Sands peaking on his run to finish fifth, beaten a nose into fourth place by Northern Star (Written Tycoon).

The winning time was 1.11.43secs for the 1200 metres on the Polytrack.

"I'm very happy with the win. She showed ability from the start, but she's a young filly who's still growing," said Le Grange.

"She's still doing a couple of things wrong. There's still a lot of maturing to do.

"Jimmy (Wong) told me after the race that she will get more ground - 1400 metres to 1600 metres. She's an easy horse to ride.

"Jimmy gave her a perfect ride behind the speed. When they ran along upfront, Jimmy was happy to sit off the pace and once she saw daylight, she was too good.

"Dragon Tycoon also ran a nice race. First-up, he ran on a soft track and he didn't enjoy himself.

"He improved tremendously today, and he did show improvement at his trial last week (July 21). His dam Baroness Gabriella is a half-sister to Volkstok'n'barrell, Donna Logan's former champion, so I think he'll turn into a nice horse here."

Le Grange also expressed his gratitude towards owners like Mendoza, who is from the Philippines, and took over the horses raced by his late father Rodolfo.

"A big thank you to Paolo. I'm very happy with our quinella today," said Le Grange.

"I have to thank owners like Paolo, who continuously support us by putting money in our racing. Without them, we would have no racing."

Rocketship's earnings have already exceeded the \$50,000 mark with that first success in three starts for Mendoza.

'TIS THE FOALING SEASON

Observing plump, healthy thoroughbred broodmares in the paddock is mesmerising. They carry so much hope in their bellies.

Will it be a colt or a filly? Could it be the nation's next champion racehorse?

Finally, after 11 wondrous months, a foal is born and the breeder's dreams become a reality, with the young horse taking its first tentative steps in a long and challenging journey to the racetrack.

A world-renowned reproductive veterinarian, Dr David Pascoe, who owns and runs the Oakey Veterinary Hospital on Queensland's Darling Downs as well as nearby Plaintree Farms with his wife Heather, has overseen countless foalings.

And, after 44 years in the business, he still gets that magical feeling when a thoroughbred foal first hits the ground.

"I get a huge thrill out of just watching the whole process naturally when you can see everything is correct and going and you watch the foal slide out.

"It might have its back legs still inside but it sits up and whinnies and says 'hello world I'm here' and then to watch the mother turn around and acknowledge and say, 'yep you're mine', it's

amazing to sit back and just watch the beauty of nature," said Pascoe.

Occasionally, in the quiet still of night, he's witnessed some incredible sights.

"Some foals are up and about quickly on their feet. Our record is seven minutes and straight away you think to yourself that the foal has everything going for it to make a racehorse because it's up and at it and within ten minutes trying to canter around the foaling yard. You think, 'wow, that's pretty amazing'.

"But there aren't very many that do that but the ones that do can generally race. Their intelligence and athleticism is there in one little package straight away and then you see some that flop around for 45 mins and say, 'I don't know how to do this'."

During the past week, many Australian stud farms have been sharing imagery of first-born foals on their social media feeds and, just like proud parents, these babies are the apple of their eye.

All legs, and so fresh and innocent, so much lies ahead before they prove themselves as an equine athlete. But, according to Pascoe, an astute judge of horseflesh can tell pretty early whether or not a foal has the physical and mental attributes to make it.

"We basically work on a principle of three weeks, three months and three years. What they look like in those early stages is how they will probably look later," he said.

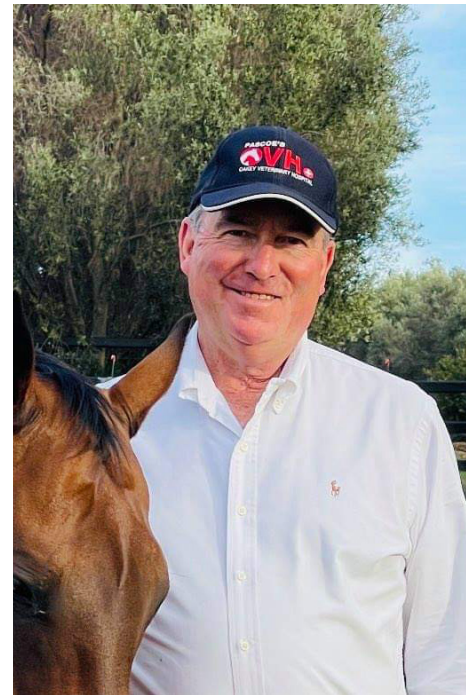
"Many yearlings and two-year-olds look gorky and gangly and not what I saw as a foal but it means that you just have to give them extra time and they will come back to that.

"It's one of those things that you learn over time with knowledge."

The next crucial part of the whole process is how they are nurtured. Not only by their mothers, but eventually humans.

You just need to take one look at the way Pascoe's hand gently and instinctively guides a young foal to see that, after a lifetime spent with horses, this comes naturally to him.

"It's all about whether the foal trusts the

people around it. If people are kind and gentle to them they will see people as a friend and not an enemy. All our own foals when they are weaned would camp in your pocket if they could.

"We want to become their friends and become just another horse in their tribe. It's important to establish those relationships with them and we do that right from the start when they are born," he said.

The art of observation is also key.

"The thing that is important with the newborns is to watch them all the time. If you can keep on top of any illness within one hour or less of it starting then you have a great chance of saving them. People that have stockmanship can do that.

"To me, on a big farm it's the people feeding them who are your front eyes of the whole operation and if they are observant they will pick up those things straight away. They are your first line of defence."

He says watching the foals closely as they get older and more active in the paddock also offers plenty of clues as to what the future might look like.

"From a young age you can see if they want to be alpha horses. We watch our weanlings and who wins the drag races and who doesn't. We recognise characteristics in them.

"One of our fillies used to drag race with the colts and they would bash each other all the way and that's the sort of confidence they need.

"She ended up winning a black-type race and won it coming through a narrow gap on the rail and the caller said you don't often see a filly take a gap like that and go hard.

"Until we split the colts and fillies she always dominated."

Nutrition is also paramount to development and, with the drought now having well and truly broken across Australia, this year's foal crop is set to thrive in a lush natural environment.

"It should set it up pretty well because one of the things you get with green grass is you get plenty of soluble vitamin K in the grass and if they are eating a lot of pasture then your bone density should be good, whereas in a drought it's not."


Ultimately, nature will take its course and genetics, along with the quality of the season and human hands in which a young thoroughbred lands, will go a long way to defining its future on the racetrack.

Win, lose or draw, from the emotion-charged moment a gangly bundle of horse arrives it brings immense joy and hope to everyone from the bleary-eyed person who's been up all night on foal watch duty, through to the breeder and owner.

The possibilities are endless and exciting.

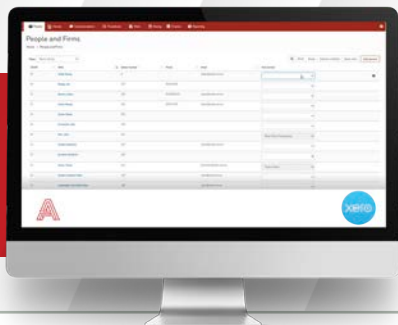

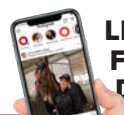
