Wet track conundrum taken out of hands of Wild Ruler's connections

Group 1-winning sprinter to put Randwick record to the test in The Everest

he prospect of a wet track will not deter slot holder Yulong from attempting to achieve Everest (1200m) glory for a second time in the \$15 million race's five-year history despite its chosen contender being noted dry-track sprinter Wild Ruler (Snitzel).

Yulong and Wild Ruler's managing owner Henry Field of Newgate Farm struck a deal to run in The Everest less than 24 hours after the four-year-old entire won the A J Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) at Moonee Valley but the studmaster provided a caveat that he would not run if the track was wet.

Sam Fairgray, Yulong's chief operating officer, yesterday admitted that he and Field were unaware of a rule that prevented connections from scratching from The Everest for any reason other than the horse having a veterinary issue.

The revelation immediately put to bed any talk of skipping the race and instead heading back to Moonee Valley for Friday's Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) with Wild Ruler, who will head to stud next year. *Continued on page 2>>*


"We've seen it before where horses << Continued from page 1 have wanted to be withdrawn and so forth because conditions weren't to suit, but if a horse is right on the day they will overcome those little differences," Fairgray said.

"I guess a race like the Cox Plate is similar where you can't withdraw it because of the state of the track. He'll take his spot. There's going to be plenty of pace on, so the way he likes to settle just off the speed, hopefully the race sets up nicely for him."

Randwick was rated a Heavy 8 late yesterday with bookmakers offering odds of \$34 about the Peter and Paul Snowden-trained Wild Ruler who

At Randwick, his home course, Wild Ruler has had five starts for four wins with his only defeat being a firstup second to Everest favourite Nature Strip (Nicconi) in the Concorde Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) on September 4.

The Concorde performance caught Fairgray's attention but negotiations between Yulong and Field heated up once Wild Ruler won the Moir, his first victory at Group 1 level.

Moir runner-up The Inferno (Holy Roman Emperor) was also selected by the James Harron Bloodstock syndicate after his closing effort.

"I thought it was a very good win at The Valley. I think The Inferno had the momentum to go actually past him at The Valley but Wild Ruler was very, very strong through the line," said Fairgray.

"They will probably be wanting to get off the fence and into the middle of the track and hopefully it will be better ground out there (from barrier 11) and he can reel them in."

Yulong has been a slot holder in The Everest since its inception in 2017 and after three-year-old filly She Will Reign (Manhattan Rain) finished second last in year one, the Yuesheng Zhang-owned breeding and racing empire won the race the following year courtesy of Redzel (Snitzel) who was also victorious in the inaugural running.

In the past two years Redzel (eighth) and Tofane (Ocean Park) (ninth) have been Yulong's Everest runners.

While Wild Ruler is a certain starter at Randwick, Yulong's Group 1 winner Hungry Heart (Frankel) is not.

The four-year-old Chris Waller-trained Vinery Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) winner, who ran eighth in the Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) last start, could be scratched from today's Yulong-sponsored Craven Plate (Gr 3, 2000m).

"It will all depend on the track on whether Chris runs her or not. I think he'll wait for (this morning) to decide," Fairgray said.

"There's other options like the Golden Eagle or coming to Melbourne for the Empire Rose (on Derby Day)."

Wet track to suit Explosive Jack

Connections of last season's Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) hero Explosive Jack (Jakkalberry) are hoping the rain continues to fall in Melbourne ahead of today's Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m). "If the heavens opened up that would greatly improve his chances," Ciaron Maher, who trains in partnership with David Eustace, told RSN927. The son of Jakkalberry (Storming Home) has had two lead-in races, finishing ninth first-up in the Makybe Diva Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) and fifth in the Turnbull Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m). "You would think Caulfield might be a little bit sharp for him but his two runs this prep have been fantastic, he has really got through the line very strongly with both being far from his best distances," Maher continued. Explosive Jack has drawn gate two and will be ridden by John Allen. "I think he will run a solid race again tomorrow and he should be spot on for the Melbourne Cup," the trainer added.

Dee out to add cup to cabinet

The last time Michael Dee was aboard a Group 1 winner it was the \$301 shot Lunar Fox (Foxwedge) in the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington, one of the biggest shock results in Australian racing history. Today he will attempt to win the Caulfield Cup in tandem with \$19 chance Duais (Shamus Award), having partnered the Edward Cummings-trained mare to win the Coongy Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) at Caulfield on Wednesday. "She didn't need to have a gut-buster, that's for sure," Dee said of the Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m) winner. "I

galloped her on the Saturday morning, she galloped well, and I was confident she could win. Although she won, she had to pull out a bit late, but she certainly didn't have that hard run." Duais is attempting to become the first since Ethereal (Rhythm) 20 years ago to claim the Queensland Oaks and Caulfield Cup double. "She loves to relax and gets into a nice rhythm plus she's got a quick turn of foot at the end of the trip," Dee said. "She's a classy mare and she showed that in her three-year-old year. She's very tough, she takes all the work that she's given and she's an out and out stayer."

Port Guillaume given Caulfield Cup all-clear

Ben and JD Hayes will have their first runner in one of the spring majors after Racing Victoria vets passed Port Guillaume (Le Havre) fit to run in the Caulfield Cup. The four-year-old presented with lameness when inspected by RV vets on Thursday, but on reexamination yesterday was cleared to run. The imported galloper was withdrawn from the Caulfield Cup a week out from the race last year after presenting with lameness and was later found to have bone bruising. It was welcome news for the Lindsay Park trainers who liked what they saw from the stayer when sixth behind Nonconformist (Rebel Raider) in the Naturalism Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) at Caulfield on September 18, before running last in The Bart Cummings (Gr 3, 2500m) at Flemington on October 2. "His work at home has been good since and he will love a wet track," Ben Hayes said of the \$81 chance. She's Ideel (Dundeel) and The Chosen One (Savabeel) were also inspected yesterday and passed fit to race.

Allen and Wilson-Taylor reflect on Incentivise ride

Kyle Wilson-Taylor was the last jockey to lose on Caulfield Cup favourite Incentivise (Shamus Award), in an 1800-metre maiden at Toowoomba back in March, and he relishes the memory. The up-and-coming apprentice and his good friend Anthony Allen were Incentivise's main riders when the dual Group 1 winner was learning the ropes under Steve Tregea's watch. "We always reminisce about the horse - going back and forth - with a bit of banter," Allen told RacingQueensland. "I like giving Kyle heat about that loss at Toowoomba. It is good to talk about a horse like Incentivise whenever we can." Incentivise is unbeaten in his eight races since Toowoomba with Brett Prebble now the man in the plate. "To have ridden such a good horse so early on in my career, it is great and some people never get to ride a horse like him," Wilson-Taylor added. "To come and reminisce with Ant, it was great."

Quick Thinker struck down with tendon injury

The Murray Baker and Andrew Forman-trained Quick Thinker (So You Think) has suffered a tendon issue and is out of today's Caulfield Cup. The five-year-old was scratched yesterday morning after the issue was discovered during a check-up. "Unfortunate news this morning, with Quick Thinker found with a tendon issue on morning check-up," Owners OTI Racing tweeted. "He will be scratched from tomorrow's Caulfield Cup. Most disappointing for all connections, including Andrew Forsman and Murray Baker." Quick Thinker's absence opens the way for the Chris Waller-trained Great House (Galileo) to take his place, under a 50 kilogram impost, with a jockey to be named.



Allen gets green light for Explosive ride


A negative Covid-19 test means John Allen has been cleared to ride Explosive Jack in today's Caulfield Cup The Group 1-winning rider missed the Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) meeting on Wednesday after he was stood down in line with the industry's Covid-19 protocols. "Racing Victoria (RV) has this afternoon provided a clearance for jockey John Allen to return to licensed premises and racecourses with immediate effect following presentation of a negative Covid test. This means that Allen is permitted to fulfil his riding engagements at tomorrow's Caulfield meeting," said an official RV statement.

D Day for Turn It Up Tommy

Johnny Get Angry (Tavistock) provided Dennis Pagan with a dream Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) victory last year and now the trainer is looking to continue the fairytale with his latest young stayer Turn It Up Tommy (Tivaci). The three-year-old heads into today's Caulfield Classic (Gr 3, 2000m) after running-on late to finish sixth in the Super Impose Stakes (Listed, 1800m) at Flemington last time. "It's D Day for Tommy on Saturday and he has to lift his game a bit," Pagan told Racing.com, having admitted to being disappointed initially with the gelding's latest run. Turn It Up Tommy is stepping up to 2000 metres for the first time and has drawn gate four. "That's certainly going to suit him, and I think it's getting more into his distance range," Pagan continued. "All the cards have fallen his way this time, so he's got to stand up to be counted, it's as simple as that." Meanwhile, Johnny Get Angry is being pointed towards the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) despite being a long last in the Turnbull Stakes last time. "He seems back to his best, he's had two really good gallops since the Turnbull," Pagan added. "I'm confident that he's going to be back to his best. He's going to the Geelong Cup, so we'll see what happens from there."

Distance to suit Sandy Prince

A drop in distance and reverting to some previously worn headgear are the little changes co-trainers Ben and JD Hayes are looking at



xtreme Flight (Extreme Choice) will shoot for a hat-trick when he takes on nine rivals in a fascinating contest for today's Gothic Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Caulfield, which would maintain a fine stakes-winning record for his dam.

The Anthony and Sam Freedmantrained Extreme Flight has a tidy price tag to live up to, having been purchased by Anthony Freedman for \$340,000 at the 2020 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale. He was offered by Sledmere Stud and is the fifth named foal out of the unraced Abscond (Galileo) - a half-sister to the Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) third Light Up Manhattan (Manhattan Rain) - who has already proven to be a high-class producer.

Abscond's first foal was the filly Invincibella (I Am Invincible) whose 12 wins featured the Tatts Tiara (Gr 1, 1400m) as well as a further four Group 2 wins. Her third foal, Secret Blaze (Sizzling), is Group 2-placed and earned his second stakes win

last month when taking out the JRA Cup (Gr 3, 2040m) at Moonee Valley. Extreme Flight is his dam's fourth offspring to race and third to win.

The quality bloodlines have also produced The Hind (McGinty), winner of the Adelaide Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) and the Geelong Cup (Listed, 2400m) winner Oregon Star (Oregon), suggesting Extreme Flight should run out over a touch farther than his speedy sire, who landed the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at two and the Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) at three.

Extreme Flight posted a solid debut run when a half-length third over 1113 metres at Sale in August but was green when only sixth over 1300 metres at Echuca later that month. He impressed when opening his account by three and a quarter lengths over 1200 metres at Moe the following month and backed up with a length and a quarter score over 1400 metres at Sandown on September 25 and looks set to be a player in stakes company.

to get Sandy Prince (Pride Of Dubai) to stop overdoing things and get back into winning form in the Gothic Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Caulfield today. Sandy Prince was successful at Sandown back in August before having his colours lowered by Forgot You (Savabeel) at his past two starts, latterly when less than a length behind in fourth in the Stutt Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m). The gelding will revert to a Hanoverian noseband this time instead of the crossover he switched to last time. "I think coming back to 1400 metres sets him up nicely," Ben Hayes said. "We've made a couple of little gear changes. We had been playing around a little with his gear and we've decided to go back to his old gear. He's got a nice draw (five) and he's a horse, I feel, that doesn't have to lead, so ridden a little bit differently, I think we can see a different result. He's shown no signs of training off, and he looks the best he has looked for the

Miss Interiors pair aiming for rich double

prep, so I think he deserves a shot."

Miss Interiors (Flying Spur) has proved her merits as a broodmare but she will hit new heights if two of her sons can between them pull off a lucrative double. Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) will aim to kick things off today in the \$15 million Everest (1200m) and on October 30 Aysar (Deep Field) will chase riches in the \$7.5 million Golden Eagle (1500m). Miss Interiors was carrying Aysar when Torreyburn Stud paid \$625,000 for her at the 2017 Inglis Chairman's Sale. "She's a beautiful mare and we expected great things from her, but it's pretty amazing that her first two have done so well," Torryburn Stud manager Melissa Copelin told Racing. com. Home Affairs was an \$850,000 purchase and her third foal, Wilbury (Capitalist), sold to James Harron for \$1.05 million. Her fourth colt, by Dundeel (High Chaparral), is booked in for the Easter sale and she is due to foal again on October 25. "We haven't sex-tested yet, so we are hoping for a filly," Copelin added. Miss Interiors is again booked for a visit to I Am Invincible, which would produce a full-sibling to Home Affairs. "If (Home Affairs) can knock that (The Everest) off or a Group 1, it will be really good for the breeding industry because he'll be a fantastic stallion," she added.

Early Everest speed critical to Berry's crusade

Tommy Berry is aiming to have the deep-closer Masked Crusader (Toronado) stepping smartly from the gates in today's Everest with the rider conscious of the speed up ahead of him. "It's the difference between letting him flop out of the gates and getting him to jump and show a little more speed," Berry told RacingNSW. "We're not going to come out and ride him aggressive by any means. It's not letting him have that first 50 metres of casual speed. He has to be a bit sharper than that." The five-yearold showed he is on target for the Everest with his last-to-first performance in the Premiere Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) when he closed through the final 600 metres in 33.18 seconds to nick the win. "You don't want them to run too fast, it just gets you off the bridle and chasing too far out," Berry said. "It needs to be quick enough that they aren't sprinting home in sectionals that we're not able to make up from behind. If the horses on the speed get an easy time and are able to kick home quick it makes it hard to run them down." Berry is confident his mount has progressed from his latest run, having been set for the Everest a long way out. "There's a good sense of timing about him, he was very good the other day and he's improved a lot since that," the rider added.

Nature Strip firms as favourite

The Chris Waller-trained Nature Strip (Nicconi) received heavy support through yesterday and is the firm favourite for the \$15 million Everest at Randwick today. The seven-year-old was available at \$4.60 at one point but has since firmed into \$3.60, last year's winner Classique Legend (Not A Single Doubt) is a drifter from \$4 out to \$4.80.

Irish Songs gains a start in The Kosciuszko

The scratching of Front Page (Magnus) from the Kosciuszko (1200m) at Randwick today, due to a veterinary issue, has opened the way for the Kurt Goldman-trained Irish Songs (Shamus Award) to take his place in the race. Kerrin McEvoy will ride the six-year-old who has drawn 15 and will shoulder 57 kilograms.

Karacasu to have edge in Rebel Raider

Karacasu (Headwater) must overcome a wide draw in barrier nine of ten and a 60-kilogram impost if he is to land the Rebel Raider Series Final (1200m) at Morphettville today. The Richard and Chantelle Jolly-trained three-yearold has never finished further back than second in his five starts and a win could see him head north for the rich Magic Millions Guineas (LR, 1400m) on the Gold Coast. "He's ready to go," Richard Jolly told RacingSA. "We'll give him plenty of room and hopefully get over the top of them. He's giving weight away to some nice horses, but he's dropping in weight on last time and he's going to be hard to beat for sure."

Pentito on MM Guineas path

A syndicate of everyday Queenslanders plus one Olympian, along with Deagon-based trainer Jason Edwards, are hoping Pentito (Spill The Beans) can deliver in the Lexus Quality (1400m) at Eagle Farm today and set up a tilt at the \$2 million Magic Millions Guineas. Edwards, who has been training for seven years, bought Pentito for just \$15,000 at the 2020 Gold Coast March sales and the gelding broke through last time over 1350 metres at Doomben, under today's rider Michael Cahill. "I normally can only afford to buy one yearling because I don't have a lot of owners," Edwards told RacingQueensland. "I liked Pentito a lot when I first saw him because he had a lovely confirmation and was a good walker. His win second-up was very good and he beat Star Patrol who there's a wrap on: at his previous run he ran second to Devastating at the Sunshine Coast and Tony Gollan has a good opinion of him. If he wins we'll give him a break soon and aim for the Magic Millions Guineas." Pentito is raced by a big syndicate, which includes Olympic weight-lifter Matthew Lydement, who competed at the recent Tokyo Games. "A lot of his owners have been supporters of mine for some time but Matthew is a first-time owner," Edwards added.

Snowdens send big team to Newcastle

Peter and Paul Snowden will send five of their team to Newcastle today and all five will be Morning Briefing - Sponsored by Kia Ora Stallions



well fancied with each contender having drawn between barriers one and six. Among those, the Ka Bling (Capitalist) goes in the Joanne Mclean Memorial (1250m) and Satin Ribbons (Capitalist) who lines up in the Benchmark 64 over 900 metres. "Our best two chances are Ka Bling and Satin Ribbons," Peter Snowden said. "We scratched Ka Bling from the Kembla meeting on Thursday because of the heavy track. I wouldn't like the track on Saturday to be worse than a soft. Ka Bling was very good last start and he will run well. Satin Ribbons is a fast and talented filly and she has good soft track form. We have only given her the one trial and she went great. She won at Newcastle before a spell and the filly draws well on Saturday." Snowden also had a word for another threevear-old, Starmoss (Zoustar), who goes in the OAS Technology 3YO Maiden Handicap (1300m). "Starmoss went better last start and has a chance," he added.

Regalo Di Gaetano strikes at Murray Bridge

A determined, gritty run down the home straight saw Regalo Di Gaetano (6 g Supreme Class - Regalina by Regal Shot) take yesterday's Murray Bridge Gold Cup (Listed, 1600m). The Richard and Chantelle Jolly-trained six-year-old edged ahead inside the final furlong under a and held on by a head from runner-up Classy Joe (Danerich), with a half-length back to Lord Vladivostok (Tavistock) in third. It was Regalo Di Gaetano's second stakes success and ninth win all told.

Pariah filly wins trial

The Gary Portelli-trained Belriah (Pariah) caught the eye at Warwick Farm yesterday morning with an impressive performance in a 740-metre barrier trial. The unraced juvenile was fastest from the gate but soon handed up the lead to sit a close second along the fence, before extending easily down the home straight to pass the post in front under Robbie Dolan, two lengths ahead of Doublesharkattack (Impending) in second, with three and a quarter lengths back to third-placed Freeways (Epaulette). Belriah is from the first crop of the Arrowfield Stud stallion Pariah (Redoute's Choice), who stands at a fee of \$16,500 (inc.

GST), and is out of the seven-time winner Belscenica (Scenic). Portelli purchased the filly at Magic Millions for \$130,000 from her breeder Sledmere Stud.

Rothesay colt sets Seymour breeze-up benchmark

A colt by Rothesay (Fastnet Rock) clocked the fastest time at Seymour yesterday as 21 two-year-olds breezed ahead of the Magic Millions Gold Coast Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale on November 8. The youngster, offered by Nolen Racing as agent, registered a time of 10.20 seconds. The two-year-old, catalogued as **Lot 8**, is the first foal out of the maiden Rhodopis (Real Saga) and is a three-quarters sibling to the seven-time winner Bring It Home Pop (Rothesay).

Byrne pulls out of Golden Eagle

Jim Byrne has decided against travelling from Queensland to Sydney to ride the Desleigh Foster-trained Apache Chase (Better Than Ready) in the Golden Eagle (1500m) at Rosehill on October 30. The jockey would have had to comply with Racing NSW protocols that required he self-isolate in Brisbane for a week before his departure and that he would have to drive to Sydney so as not to risk being infected by a fellow passenger on a commercial flight. Those strict measures, allied to a further two weeks of quarantine in a hotel upon his return to Queensland, were enough for Byrne to change his mind about heading south.

Realm Of Flowers sidelined

There will be no Melbourne Cup for the Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained Realm Of Flowers (So You Think) this year, with the five-year-old mare set for a spell to recover from illness. "Unfortunately, Realm Of Flowers is out of this year's Melbourne Cup due to illness and she requires a spell. She will have a break now and we look forward to having her back in the autumn," said a statement from the stable

O'Brien charged over positive

Danny O'Brien has been charged by Racing Victoria stewards after a horse he trained, Coin Collector (All Too Hard), tested positive to a banned anti-inflammatory medication. Phenylbutazone was found to be present in a pre-race blood sample taken before the five-year-old finished third in a 2500-metre handicap at Moonee Valley on March 13. The non-steroidal anti-inflammatory cannot be in a horse's system on race day. A date has yet to be set for the Victorian Racing Tribunal to hear the charge. The horse has since moved to the Paul Preusker stable.

Holland survives scary road accident

Dean Holland had an unnerving near miss at around 5am on Tuesday morning that left him shaken and his car battered. The jockey was on his way to ride work on Melbourne Cup hope Tralee Rose (Tavistock) when he had to swerve to avoid a truck heading right at him. "He took off my rear vision mirror, which came back and smashed my window, I reckon two more inches and I was brown bread (dead)," Holland told Racing.com. "There were no flashing lights, I couldn't see it, I probably had not even a car width to swerve into. I'm just glad I didn't have my kids in the car with me. I could only see where my headlights go, and that's it."

Kensington meeting moved to Canterbury

Racing NSW has transferred the Kensington Track race meeting scheduled for Wednesday October 27 to Canterbury. As a consequence, the two races originally scheduled over 1400 metres will now be 1250-metre contests; the 1800-metre race will be a 1550-metre affair; and the 2400-metre race will change to a 1900-metre

Pakenham called off

Last night's Pakenham meeting was abandoned after two races due to poor visibility caused by heavy rainfall. Several jockeys who rode in the second race expressed concern with the deteriorating conditions and the majority of jockeys with a ride in race three voted in favour of abandoning the remainder of the meeting. As per Racing Victoria's policy on abandoned meetings, the connections of all horses due to compete in the remaining six races will receive a \$550 compensation fee. Any trainers with



runners affected by the abandonment now have until 4pm (AEDT) tomorrow to nominate their horses for the Geelong Cup (Listed, 2400m) Day meeting at Geelong Racing Club next Wednesday, October 20.

NEW ZEALAND

Robusto smoking ahead of Livamol

The Murray Baker and Andrew Forsmantrained Robusto (Zed) will have her second Group 1 start when she lines-up in the Livamol Classic (Gr 1, 2040m) at Hastings today.

The seven-year-old followed a win in the Avondale Cup (Gr 2, 2400m) at Ellerslie last term with 11th in the Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) at the track a couple of weeks later. She heads in off two runs this term, latterly a third placing over 2000 metres behind today's rival Our Big Mike (Don Eduardo). "She will be pretty well near peak fitness, she probably needed that run the other day at Hastings and she will be a big improver for it," Forsman said. "She meets some of them better off at weightfor-age in this race, but the barrier draw (11) is going to be the awkward thing for her. It is wide open and we were going there hoping if we had drawn a soft draw that she could have got a good run in behind the pace and would have been a strong top three chance. I think she still is, she will just need a bit to go her way."

Richards wishes for more Guineas success

Jamie Richards will produce a bevy of prospects over the next ten days for the New Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Riccarton on November 6 and the New Zealand 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at the same track seven days later. The Te Akau trainer still has 15 in contention for Guineas success, with I Wish I Win (Savabeel), second to stablemate On The Bubbles (Brazen Beau) in the Manawatu Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) last term, getting a key leadup race today in the Barneswood Farm Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Ashburton after he was scratched from Matamata last weekend. "We just want to see him running out a strong 1400 metres. We want to see him hit the line strongly and look like he's looking for a mile at his next start," Richards said. The handler said he was also "looking forward" to seeing Palamos (Extreme Choice) and Pure Imagination (Darci Brahma) contest the NZB Ready To Run Trainers Series 3YO (1300m) at Hastings today. Richards' 1,000 Guineas hand includes Imperatriz (I Am Invincible), The Perfect Pink (Savabeel), Belle En Rouge (Burgundy) and Millefiori (Iffraaj) who could all race next weekend. "Those fillies are progressing well. It has been a difficult spring but I feel like we are getting there now," he added.

Katie Perrie on song for Staphanos

Katie Perrie (Rock 'N' Pop) aims to continue her good record at Arawa Park tomorrow when she contests the Staphanos Classic (Gr 3, 1950m) rather than the Livamol Classic. The Jim Collett-trained seven-year-old has had two starts at the track for a win and a placing in the Rotorua Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) in May. "She has had three runs at Rotorua, and she has won a race and a trial, and been placed at black type. We are just trying to get as much black type for her as we can," Collett said. "I feel the track will be more to her liking at Rotorua than Hawke's Bay and the way they run the race at Hawke's Bay may be a little bit against her because it will probably be a speedily run race." Katie Perrie will jump from barrier two with Lisa Allpress aboard. "The draw is not ideal because she likes a bit of room to work in, she is a big horse. It all depends on how they run it," Collett continued. "If Lisa can get her some room to work in from the 600 metres home than she will have every opportunity."

Te Toki deal falls through

Te Toki (Tarzino) will not be on the move after negotiations to sell to an Australian party fell through. The Simon and Katrina Alexander-trained three-year-old has won both his career starts impressively and had been entered for the New Zealand 2,000 Guineas but is now in a spelling paddock. "We had an offer that was in the too good to refuse category and he came through all the required examinations, but then the person at the end of the chain failed to come through," said Katrina Alexander. The Matamata husband and wife partnership are also part-owners of the \$45,000 Karaka Book

2 yearling purchase. "Time was always going to be his friend and we had already made the decision to not proceed down the Guineas path," she continued. "We kept him ticking over while we were going through the sale process, and now we're very comfortable with giving him a break ahead of making plans for later in the season."

ASIA

JPN: Classic fillies in Shuka Sho clash

Sodashi (Kurofune) and Uberleben will clash for the first time since the latter defeated the former in the Japanese Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) back in June. But, while the 'white wonder' Sodashi, the winner of six from seven starts including the Japanese 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) in the spring, went on to land the Sapporo Kinen (Gr 2, 2000m) last month, Uberleben spent her summer recuperating from a tendon inflammation and has made the last leg of the fillies' triple crown against her trainer Takahisa Tezuka's expectations. "When the hard training started her lungs were still weak and I did question whether she'd be ready in time," he said. "But, with each bit of work, she improved and faster than I thought." Meanwhile, Sodashi's jockey Hayato Yoshida said his filly's mood was tense after her Sapporo win but that she has also strengthened since the spring and "let off some steam" in her work "without letting her switch into top gear." The field also features the Guineas third and recent Shion Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) winner Fine Rouge (Kizuna), the mount of Christophe Lemaire, Andvaranaut (King Kamehameha), successful three times and never out of the first two from six starts, including a win at Grade 2 level over 2000 metres last time.

HK: Wishful Thinker out to defend Premier title

Wishful Thinker (I Am Invincible) will attempt to snare the Premier Bowl Handicap (Gr 2, 1200m) at Sha Tin tomorrow for the second year in succession but the lightly-weighted eight-year-old faces a stiff test from a handful of rising stars. A 44-1 winner in an average field last term for Richard Gibson, this time, under the watch



of his latest trainer Dennis Yip, Wishful Thinker is up against the likes of Sky Field (Deep Field), Courier Wonder (Sacred Falls) and Naboo Attack (Warhead). "I think he's been quite honest but he's just getting a bit older and he always comes from behind, so he needs a bit more luck than other horses but I'm sure he'll do his best," said his jockey, Derek Leung. "He's been good in the mornings, the same as usual but this time he'll carry a light weight which will be a bit different for him." Wishful Thinker, who will carry 116lb, has two runs under his belt this term and was ninth last time in the National Day Cup Handicap (Gr 3, 1000m). "You could see he was a bit one-paced over a 1000 metres because he is getting older, so it's a bit short for him but I didn't think he did anything wrong, he's fit and well so back to 1200 metres now - I hope he'll run better," Leung added.

HK: Football is Super for Ting

Jimmy Ting is looking to enhance his faststart to the new season and will send around a sharp team of five at Sha Tin tomorrow. Among that quintet, Super Football (More Than Ready) steps out for his second run this term and steps up in trip to 1800 metres in the Class 2 Parmigiani Fleurier Excellent Handicap under Zac Purton. Ting suspects the threetime winner will one day flourish over further. "Last start he was a little bit disappointing - I think now the 1600 metres is too short for him, I think he needs to get out to 1800 (metres), 2000 and even maybe 2400 could be suitable for him," Ting said. The New Zealand-bred narrowly missed out on Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) selection last campaign but did manage to snatch an end-of-season Class 2 over nine furlongs. "I hope he can (one day get to 2400 metres), I think he could be a different horse over that trip but his form is better for this start, so I do think he'll run better," Ting added.

SGP: Meagher hopeful Lightning can dazzle

Daniel Meagher believes the reinvigorated Lim's Lightning (Lope De Vega) has the right manners nowadays to handle the step beyond a mile for the first time in the Queen Elizabeth II Cup (Listed, 1800m) at Kranji today. "I'm really looking forward to seeing him over 1800 metres," Meagher said. "Dan (Beasley) can put him anywhere, but ideally, I would love a strong tempo and he can sit third or fourth off it. That would suit him just perfect. His best win was probably with a bit of cover, peel off the leader and sprint home with that good turn of foot of his" The six-year-old has been reinvigorated since returning from a moderate stint in Australia and has won five of his last six races at Kranji, including the Lion City Cup (Listed, 1200m) and the Raffles Cup (Listed, 1600m). "He's a gentleman now compared to what he was. In the past, one little thing would stir him up and he would lose the plot," Meagher continued. "He still reacts to everything, you can't change that side of him, but as opposed to last time, he now goes straight back to his routine. He's a very different horse now. You can ride him wherever you want."

CAMBRIDGE STUD

The Kevin Ryan-trained Franz (2 c ex Gemstone by Galileo) made a winning debut in a mile novice contest at Haydock yesterday to become the sixth individual winner for Cambridge Stud shuttler and first season sire Almanzor (Wootton Bassett). The juvenile won cosily by half a length from the late-closing runner-up Mandobi (Iffraaj), with a further length and a half back to Paradias (Kodiac) in third. Franz was bred by Highclere Stud and Ors Bloodstock and was a 100,000 guineas purchase for Haras d'Etreham and Cambridge Stud at last year's Tattersalls Book 1. His dam Gemstone (Galileo) won at Listed level and was Group 3 placed, and has produced the Listed winner UAE Jewel (Dubawi). She is a half-sister to Karamela (Mastercraftsman), a Group 3 winner in Argentina, and to the dam of Irish St Leger (Gr 1, 1m 6f) winner Sonnyboyliston (Power). It is also the family of Irish 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) winner Bachelor Duke (Miswaki). Almanzor stood the northern hemisphere season at Haras d'Etreham fee of €30,000, while his Cambride Stud fee is \$30,000 (inc GST).

UK: Nathaniel colt set to join Moody

A Nathaniel (Galileo) colt who is a half-brother to a trio of multiple winners is set to join the Peter Moody stable after Roll The Dice Racing and John Foote went to 60,000 guineas (approx AU\$116,800) to land Lot 1328 on the opening day of Book 3 at the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale. Consigned by New England Stud, the colt is out of the stakes-placed Foundation Filly (Lando), the winner of three races, who has had three winners from her five runners to date. Roll The Dice also purchased a Pivotal (Polar Falcon) colt at the sale last year, subsequently named Crux, who was sent to Peter Moody. Turnover of 7,268,800 guineas (approx. AU\$14.14 million), on the opening day was up 43 per cent year-on-year. The average went up by 31 per cent to 28,065 guineas (approx. AU\$54,615), while the median rose by 63 per cent to 16,000 guineas (approx. AU\$31,165). Book 3 was due to conclude last night

FRA: Dual Group 1 winner Victor Ludorum retired to Haras du Logis

Victor Ludorum (Shamardal), the winner of the Poule d'Essai des Poulains (Gr 1, 1600m) and Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere (Gr 1, 1600m) for Andre Fabre, has been retired from racing and will stand at Haras du Logis in Normandy for 2022. Godolphin's homebred was one of three unbeaten juvenile Group 1 winners in 2019 for the late sire, alongside Pinatubo and Earthlight. Sam Bullard, Darley director of stallions, said: "Victor Ludorum was a great credit to the Godolphin team - a homebred Classic winner who was exceptional at two. We're delighted to be standing him in France, scene of all his races. He hails from a particularly exceptional stallion-making family and has every chance of being a great stallion son of Shamardal." Victor Ludorum's fee will be announced at a later date.

Group 1-winning partnership Ellerton and Zahra to go their separate ways

ictorian owner-breeder David
Moodie will side with Mathew
Ellerton and leave his large
racing team in the care of the
Flemington-based trainer when he and
Simon Zahra end their long and successful
partnership later this year.

The trainers yesterday announced that they would go their separate ways after more than two decades of working together despite seemingly enjoying a strong start to the season including a stakes-winning double at Caulfield last week and Group 1 victory earlier in the year.

The news may have come as a shock to some of Ellerton Zahra Racing's clients but there has been murmurs behind the scenes for a number of weeks about the pending dissolution of the training partnership, which is set to come into effect on December 1.

"After over 20 years together and a lot of hard work to build the EZR brand I'd like to wish Simon all the best in his new endeavour, I couldn't have done it without him," Ellerton said in a statement.

"We've been through a lot of highs throughout the journey and long may it continue for us both.

"I'd also like to thank our ownership group and our loyal staff who have put in so much over so many years."

Zahra added: "It's with a heavy heart that Mat and I after 22 years have agreed to go our own way to further our training careers. I'm very proud of our success and the team we created together at EZR. On the back of that I am excited as to what the future brings and success for owners."

The pair prepared Kiki Express (Sepoy) to win the Debutant Stakes (Listed, 1000m) and Dirty Thoughts (So You Think) to land the Northwood Plume (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield last Saturday and they have their Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Zoutori (Zoustar) in the Moonga Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) and the Moodie-owned General Beau (Brazen Beau) in the Caulfield Sprint (Gr 2, 1000m) today.

Moodie, who is also a partner in the Ellerton Zahra Racing training business, confirmed that Ellerton would take sole charge of his horses when the break-up comes to fruition.

Ellerton has worked for Moodie since the mid-1990s and they enjoyed Group 1 success in 2000 with sprinter-miler Black Bean (Raami) and have had a steady stream of high-class horses since then including dual Group 1 winner Casual Pass (Snippets) in the early to mid-2000s.

"The horses that Contract Racing and Hesket (Bloodstock) are involved in will end up with Mathew if this reaches its conclusion, which it should. There is still a bit of water to flow under the bridge yet (such as organising stabling)," Moodie said.

"It is important to note that it is business as usual until the first of December and then they will go their own ways, which hopefully will be a positive for both of them."

Syndicator First Light Racing, who won the 2018 Wakeful Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) and VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) double with the Ellerton and Zahra-trained Aristia (Lonhro), has vowed to support both trainers when they start operating their independent stables.

"We have had a great association with them for ten-plus years, so we want to support both of them," First Light's Tim Wilson said.

"Obviously the boys are going to continue training together until December 1, so we have got six weeks to work closely with them to determine who is best suited for each horse.

"I have had preliminary chats with them, but they've got a lot going on themselves, so we will just use the time we've got to map the right path.

"They have both been great trainers in partnership and they have been great trainers in isolation before, so I am confident there will be limited disruption and in the next six weeks we'll plot the right path."

Training from Flemington, Ellerton and

Zahra had expanded the number of horses they had in work by taking on the stables previously occupied by Leon and Troy Corstens after they moved into the on-course complex previously used by the now Ballarat-based Tony and Calvin McEvoy.

Zahra could end up taking on those boxes with Ellerton remaining in EZR's main, larger on-course complex.

Last year, prolific owner Moodie, a former Racing Victoria chairman, brought his racing team back under one umbrella to be trained by Ellerton and Zahra rather than spreading them around to various stables as he'd done for a number of years.

In more recent times Moodie's Contract Racing and Hesket Bloodstock signed a deal with the US-owned Spendthrift Australia to sell a 20 per cent share in 26 yearlings for them to syndicate through its Myracehorse. com business. They will be trained by Ellerton but Moodie has no affiliation with Myracehorse other than sharing in the ownership of the horses he bred and sold down a portion of.

Ellerton and Zahra, who are first cousins, officially formed a training partnership in March 2010 with their first runner Cool Diva (Ice Point) winning at Sandown and, little more than three weeks later, the pair won the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) with brilliant filly Crystal Lily (Stratum).

Together, they have won 837 races, six of them at Group 1 level, Zoutori the most recent to fly the flag at the highest level for the stable.

Zahra briefly trained in his own right in 2008 and 2009, while being an assistant to Ellerton, during a stint in which he prepared talented sprinter Let Go Thommo (Laranto) to win the 2008 Carlyon Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) and the following year's Bletchingly Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m).

In the first piece of a new series on breeding to race, Jo McKinnon looks at the impact of today's Kosciuszko at Randwick, which features nine homebreds in the \$1.3 million contest

here can be no greater thrill than winning a race with a horse you own but victory always tastes that little bit sweeter when it's one you have bred yourself as Laurel Oak Bloodstock principal Louis Mihalyka can well attest.

Mihalyka has bred and raced numerous high-class horses over the years in Australia with Handle the Truth (Star Witness), the raging favourite in The Kosciuszko (1200m) at Randwick today, the latest of them.

"At the end of the day, you love racing good horses, and the satisfaction, if it's one you bred, is a bit like watching your kid play well at sport because you have had a hand in the breeding.

"There's a bit of extra something about it, you get a little burst of pride," said Mihalyka.

Handle the Truth, has won the popular syndicator and his band of 26 owners nine races from 31 starts and earned more than \$1.3 million in prize-money for them.

Under the guidance of astute Canberrabased trainer Keith Dryden, Handle the Truth won the second running of The Kosciuszko in 2019 and also ran fourth in the race last year.

Winning Canberra's National Sprint (Listed, 1400m) in March this year also rates as one of the six-year-old gelding's most notable achievements on the track so far.

Mihalyka, who also bred and raced dual Group 1-winning sprinter Rebel Dane (California Dane), places Handle the Truth right up there as one of the best horses he's ever plotted the production of.

"We have a very good strike-rate at that and this one would be the second-best behind Rebel Dane that we have ever had," he said.

Handle the Truth, whose clever name comes from the famous line delivered by Jack Nicholson in the courtroom scene of the hit 1992 movie A Few Good Men, is the second foal out of Bernadini (A.P. Indy) mare, Assertively.

Trained by Joe Pride, after just three lacklustre starts she was retired as a maiden.

"We had this very good looking filly by Bernadini but she was dead slow so I decided to keep her for one particular mating to Star Witness because it in-breeds to Audrey Joan," Mihalyka continued. Assertively's first foal, also by Star Witness, enjoyed a far less illustrious career, having failed x-rays as a yearling before being sold at the Inglis Scone Sale for just \$2,000.

That outcome never deterred Mihalyka who was convinced the cross would eventually deliver something special.

"Anytime you can get Prego and Lion Hunter in a pedigree it will work well."

Eventually, along came Handle the Truth to prove the theory.

"Handle the Truth pedigree wise was very low key but it was a special mating we wanted to try.

"We got lucky in the middle. He had clean x-rays and we put a syndicate together and earmarked him for Keith (Dryden)."

Handle the Truth's journey didn't get off to the most positive of starts. As a fresh, wayward youngster he decided to take off after track work one morning. He scaled a fence in a bold attempt to take himself back to the stables and in doing so threw jockey Brendan Ward, who suffered a broken pelvis, and was sidelined for three months.

Selling down shares in him also proved challenging in those early days.

"We had terrible trouble selling shares in him but when he had his first jump-out suddenly the word got out around Canberra and a lot of Keith's clients and people I told jumped in straight away and he was filled within a day after that," Mihalyka explained. "From the time he went racing, he was always talented."

Today, Handle the Truth will line up for the third time in The Kosciuszko. This year he was the first horse selected by slot holders and he's been a pre-post favourite for the race for more than a month.

Not only will he be a great flag bearer for the Laurel Oak brand at Randwick today, but he's also an inspiring story for those that opt to breed to race.

With increasingly exorbitant prices being fetched for yearlings these days, Mihalyka believes taking this type of long-game approach to getting a racehorse will become more

"It's become a necessity because sales have become so difficult," he said. "The rise and rise of the prices at the sales keep going unabated."

Handle the Truth is one of nine home-bred horses that will line up in The Kosciusko this year with the others being Art Cadeau (Artie Schiller), Ice In Vancouver (Vancouver), Island Bay Boy (All Too Hard), Nadaraja (Redoute's Choice), Mr Hussill (Husson), Ceasefire (Panzer Division), Patino Ruby (More Than Ready) and Sunrise Ruby (Casino Prince).

Melbourne-based lawyer Susan Zeitz, who is the brains behind the creation of talented Albury-trained mare Sunrise Ruby, says it's these types of horses and their stories that will inspire owners who breed to race.

"It gives hope to the people that have been trying, or all of us really.

"Who would have thought that when Sunrise Ruby went up to Mitch Beer as a two-year-old that we would be here in The Kosciuszko in only her second prep?" said Zeitz.

While Sunrise Ruby has been somewhat of an overnight success, her breeder and part-owner hasn't. She's been breeding thoroughbreds for 15 years.

"I started by accident as we all do," she said.

"I inherited a mare from a friend and went down the slippery slope of being obsessed. Ten years ago I thought I would try and get more serious and breed better quality.

"It's really hard to get horses into the sales so I decided to breed to race."

Zeitz is a self-taught pedigree buff and ferociously studies genetics.

"I read the Ken McLean books from cover to cover and read what Tesio did and read all the books I can get hold of," she continued.

"I love working out what bloodlines I think might work and then I will ask other people. I have some rigorous debates with friends about stallions. I like to start with proven stallions."

So far, the most successful mating outcome for her mare Scarletta (Distant Music), who she plucked out of the Inglis Melbourne August Thoroughbred Sale for \$25,000, has been the exciting filly Sunrise Ruby.

"Casino Prince was a no-brainer and I always believed in the dam."

Scarletta's grandam is the blue hen Scandinavia (Snippets) also the grand-dam of the legendary Black Caviar (Bel Esprit) and so hailing from that family it's probably no surprise that Sunrise Ruby possesses above-average talent.

Zeitz couldn't be prouder of the mare who has now won four of her six race starts.

"It's as much about saying that's a horse I bred and it's competing at that level." she said. "I'm just proud she's got that far and the mere fact she's been picked by someone with a slot is a huge plus. If she places or better I will be thrilled beyond belief.

"It would be amazing, it would feel like a vindication of the breeding plan."




