Demand for yearlings continues apace on record-breaking day in Perth

Playing God colt realises \$330,000 as local buyers dominate during red-hot Book 1 session of Magic Millions sale

A colt by Playing God (Blackfriars) put a late West Australian stamp on Book 1 of the Perth Magic Millions sale as the nation's rampant yearling boom continued unabated yesterday, snatching top billing as the fifth-last lot of the day for a record \$330,000.

In a session otherwise dominated by eastern-state sires - a Russian Revolution (Snitzel) filly and a So You Think (High

Chaparral) colt long held the peak price at \$320,000 - Willaview Park's Lot 174 fell after a spirited bidding duel to bloodstock agent John Chalmers, who declined to reveal his successful client.

Shortly after, Perth trainer Adam Durrant ensured four youngsters reached the \$300,000 threshold when he went to that figure for the second time in the session, buying the day's penultimate lot - a colt by another Hunter Valley stallion in Deep Field (Northern Meteor).

Only one yearling surpassed \$220,000 at the corresponding sale last year, a \$325,000 Russian Revolution colt who held the WA sales record until yesterday's red-hot trading session.

Following similar dizzying jumps in eastern sales this year, the average price leapt by almost a third on last year's figure, rising from \$68,546 to \$90,777. The median sprung from \$51,250 to \$70,000, with 141 lots grossing \$12.8 million - up from \$8.9 million last year - albeit at a slightly lower clearance rate of 85.54 percent, compared with 86.67 percent.

Magic Millions' Perth manager David Houston described it as 'a super day'.

"It was unbelievable really. The locals really stumped up today and bought some lovely horses. It's great for Western Australia that's for sure," he told ANZ Bloodstock News, adding locals had more than held their own amid a diverse buying bench.

"We did have some competition from the east but they got blown away by the locals, which is sensational for us really. To have the average up by \$23,000, in a little place like this, it's amazing."

Playing God, Darling View stud's \$16,500 stallion who won Ascot's Kingston Town Classic (Gr 1, 1800m) in 2010 and 2011 and was placed in four Melbourne Group 1s, had a previous top lot of \$200,000 for a filly sold at this sale 12 months ago.

That personal best for the sire - best known for another Kingston Town Classic winner in his daughter Kay Cee - was smashed yesterday when his impressive brown son out of WA Oaks (Gr 3, 2400m) winner Moodometer (Pricelessly) struck a day-one blow for local stallions, with Chalmers winning a tense bidding battle.

"I didn't think he would make that much," Chalmers said. "My client, who I had on the phone, put a limit on him, and we finished up extending that limit, but he's the horse he wanted and I'm sure he'll be happy with it."

"He's a big, long, scopey, staying-type colt. His mother won an Oaks, so there's every chance this horse is going to get ground, and he's got a full-sister who's already got black type (Listed-placed Mood Goddess), so we know the cross is working."

Willaview Park's Clare Williamson said the colt had shattered the farm's expectations, emerging as a star lot on arrival at Swan Valley.

"To be honest he was not the pick of the draft until we came up here. But you bring him out of the box and he's just got a presence about him," Williamson said.

"You could see people were wowed by him. He's had people come back four or five times. We knew he'd make in excess of \$100,000 but nowhere near \$330,000."

Durrant was the day's top buyer with 12 lots at a gross of \$1.52 million, ahead of rival trainer Simon Miller, who took home 12 lots for \$1.22 million.

Western Breeders Alliance was top vendor with 13 lots sold for \$1.22 million at an average of \$93,846, slightly ahead of Yarradale Stud (12 lots for \$1.14m) and Amelia Park (six lots for \$1.12m).

So You Think topped the sires' averages for more than three lots

sold, with four yearlings selling for an average of \$175,000. Magnus (Flying Spur) averaged \$155,000 through three lots, Toronado (High Chaparral) \$126,250 through four, while Playing God averaged \$118,846 through 13.

The day's equal-second price was found early in Lot 29, with \$320,000 reached for the Russian Revolution filly offered by WA powerhouse Amelia Park, bought by Mark Pilkington in conjunction with his Seymour Bloodstock partner Darren Thomas. The eastbound filly is the first foal of WATC Champion Fillies Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) winner and Melbourne Group 2-placed mare Samovare (Savabeel).

"She was well recommended by many at the sale as a scopey filly that should love a mile at three," Pilkington told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"She's from a high-class racemare we tried to buy prior to her winning the Champion Fillies Stakes at three. And Russian Revolution has sired a couple of high-class fillies in recent times. He looks the goods."

Pilkington said a trainer would be found once the ownership group was settled.

"She's a BOBS filly, which probably explains the number of Sydney-based trainers who have rung to put their hat into the ring," Pilkington said.

Amelia Park manager Sarah Brown said the farm was delighted with the price.

"We're stoked, especially considering it's hard to sell big-priced lots in the Perth market and there's not eastern states traffic over here," she said.

Adam Durrant matched that price by buying Lot 86, Lynward Park Stud's So You Think colt out of Black In Time (Blackfriars), a multiple city-winner up to 1400 metres and a sister to WA stakes winners Impact Rating and Full Reign.

The colourful Durrant revealed 'the best colt in the sale' was bought for a syndicate involving some enthusiastic newcomers.

"There are some new guys involved and they weren't really going to let him go," he said.

"If I was buying him on spec I probably would've pulled out a bit earlier. But the boys were pretty keen to get him. Lucky he was about Lot 100, they'd had a few beers, and they weren't pulling up.

"He's a great cut of an animal. Even though he's a So You Think, I don't think he's going to run far. I think 1400 metres will see him out possibly. He'll be on the sprinting side like his mum."

Durrant also struck late by buying Lot 177, a colt by Deep Field out of Melbourne city-winning Lonhro (Octagonal) mare Ms Mazetti, the dam of three winners from three runners.

"He was a standout. Worth every bit of it," Durrant said. "He's an athlete, a proper horse, and fingers crossed he's got a heart inside."

Dan Love's Mega Holdings paid the fifth-highest price of \$270,000 for the only lot by first-season sire Trapeze Artist (Snitzel), a colt offered by Dorrington Farm's Rob Crabtree through the Willow Dale Farm draft.

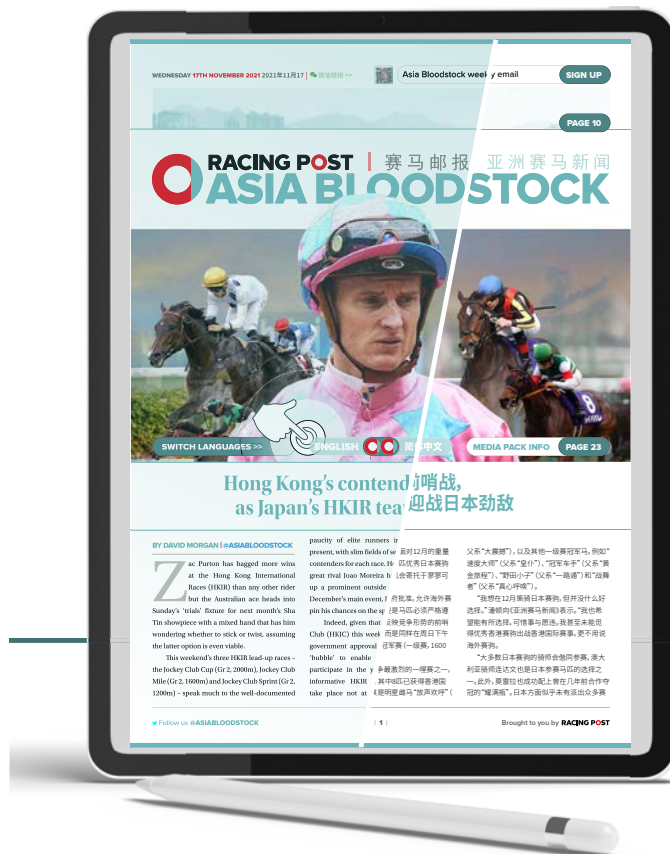
He is the first foal out of Group 3-winning Perth sprinter Kiss Bang Love (Demerit).

Simon Miller paid \$250,000 for a filly by Nicconi (Bianconi) out of Amelia's Love (Blackfriars), herself the daughter of Blue Diamond Prelude (F) (Gr 3, 1100m) heroine Card Queen (Final Card), and said he'd been fortunate to follow the yearling's progress through his frequent visits to Amelia Park for spelling and pre-training purposes.

"When she was a weanling I loved her, and I've just watched her evolve along the way and she's furnished into what I thought she'd be," Miller said.

"She's probably more of a three-year-old, a lot of stretch and scope, but she's got all the right things Nicconi does. They're strong and they're athletic."

<< *Continued from page 5* Trainer Vern Brockman went to \$230,000 to secure Amelia Park's filly by surging sire Toronado out of the stakes-placed three-time winner Europa Point (Rock Of Gibraltar), who is from the same family as Fangirl (Sebring) and Special Harmony (Spinning World).

That figure was matched by a Magnus filly out of city winner Fromm (O'Reilly), the dam of dual Perth Group 3 winner Battle Hero (Stratum), who was bought by Bavcon PL from the Scenic Lodge draft.

West Australian Hall of Fame trainer Neville Parnham kicked the sale

off with a bang, going to \$200,000 to snare Lot 2, a daughter of So You Think offered by Yarradale Stud. She is the second foal of Nordic Gem (Swiss Ace), whose dam Rose Of Dane (Danehill) was a stakes winner in Melbourne as well as being Group 1-placed in Perth.

Blue Diamond favourites handed wide draws

Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr got their wish during yesterday's Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) draw as Jacquinot (Rubick) drew barrier ten for Saturday's feature contest. Price said on Monday how he hoped to be drawn away from the inside after the son of Rubick (Encosta De Lago) ruined his chance in the Blue Diamond Prelude (C&G) (Gr 3, 1100m) with a poor start before then being stuck to the inside rail throughout. "It was very important to us," Kent Jnr told Racing.com. "We were hoping for barriers ten to 12 and it worked out beautifully. Drawing wide was the key for us. We wanted to draw outside barrier ten as we are resigned that he'll be in the second half of the field and that's fine as that's where he balances up. It'll give him room to use his massive stride and just hopefully he can get away clean. He's been sticky (in the gates) before but nothing like last start but we don't think it'll happen again." Jacquinot's likely rival for favouritism is the unbeaten Lofty Strike (Snitzel), who also drew wide in barrier 13. Over the last decade there have been five winners that drew in the outside section of the field, including Written By (Written Tycoon) from barrier 15 in 2018 and Earthquake (Exceed And Excel), who also drew barrier 15 four years earlier.

Freedman happy with Daumier draw

Godolphin colt Daumier (Epaulette) drew near the inside in barrier five, a position that co-trainer Sam Freedman feels will suit the son of Epaulette (Commands), who was third in the Blue Diamond

Prelude last time out. "It was a nice draw for him," Freedman, who trains in partnership with his father Anthony, told Racing.com. "He has shown speed out of the gates but I would think that with the blinkers on over 1200 metres, we might let the speed go and try and settle behind the pace. With speed on our inside and outside, it should give Mark (Zahra) a lot of options and we are hopeful that he can get the right run throughout and give him his chance. I did think that Lofty Strike had done nothing wrong. I know Jacquinot has been very impressive but Lofty Strike seems to do everything right."

Sandhu content with outside pitch

Julius Sandhu was less enthusiastic about Lofty Strike's barrier draw, as the son of Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) was handed barrier 13, but was content with the fact he is berthed on the outside. "It's a couple out from where I would prefer to be," Sandhu told Racing.com. "But he is on the outside and that I am comfortable with. My worry would have been if he had drawn one or two as he's a big-striding horse and he needs some room. He's probably going to get a similar run that he got in the Prelude, although it will be a bigger field and he might need to get rolling a bit earlier. He galloped super this morning and I am quite happy with the way things are. The barrier draw is the barrier draw. We will just deal with it. I am going to back Jamie Mott to give him a peach of a ride. He's ridden him a treat at his previous two starts and I hope there's nothing different (on Saturday)."

English Riviera primed with Caulfield gallop

The Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained English

Riviera (Deep Field) has been prepared specifically for this weekend's Blue Diamond, leaving nothing to chance. The two-year-old was sent to Caulfield from the stable's Ballarat base yesterday morning for a gallop in order to get another look at the track ahead of the juvenile feature. The daughter of Deep Field (Northern Meteor) has placed on both outings to date, running second behind Lofty Strike on debut at Flemington before finishing third to Revolutionary Miss (Russian Revolution) on February 12. John Allen replaces Mark Zahra and the pair will jump from barrier four. "She's had a run here, but I thought another trip down the highway and another gallop would be good for her," Tony McEvoy said. "She went far too hard in the Prelude, so we won't be doing that in the Blue Diamond. They ran, from the 1000 metres to the 600, something like 20.6 seconds and that is not conducive to finishing your race off, so John will ride her sensibly. The two fillies that ran second and third that day, to do that at the start and be there at the end, that was incredible."

Zahra set to partner Ruler in Oakleigh return

Mark Zahra will once again team up with the Snowdens in a bid for Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) success, four years on from their memorable win with Russian Revolution (Snitzel) in 2018. The trio will renew their association with Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) winner Wild Ruler (Snitzel) and the four-year-old left Zahra impressed after a recent gallop at Caulfield. "His work was really good, the further he went, the more he improved," Zahra told Racing.com. "I reckon he worked well enough to run a very good race on Saturday." The son of Snitzel has a strong first-up record, having

finished in the top two in all five of his seasonal debuts, and Zahra is confident that fitness won't be a problem once again on Saturday. "He didn't have much of a puff at all when he came back in," the jockey said. "Obviously, the Snowdens are very good trainers and I think they've targeted this race for a little while, so he's set and ready to go. There's always a heap of pressure in it, so you've got to have a horse that's got a little bit of speed so you can be somewhere in touch. He won't be too far away. I think he's the perfect sort of horse."

'Fit' Allen confident in Marabi

Ben Allen feels he is the fittest he has ever been as he prepares for the ride on Marabi (I Am Invincible) in the Oakleigh Plate on Saturday. Allen is still seeking his first Group 1 success and will ride a light 54-kilograms aboard the Ciaran Maher and David Eustaced-trained mare. The 22-year-old jockey has been hard at work changing his diet in the last month, as well as turning to fitness guru Ron Johnson for further support. "I'm the fittest I reckon I've ever been, I'm walking around a lot lighter than I have been for a long time in my career, probably my only regret is that I never trained with him earlier, to be honest," Allen told Racing.com. "The food he's got me eating is just keeping me really healthy and clean and the training I'm doing, I'm really benefiting from. I feel great." Marabi is the current \$2.50 favourite with bookmakers for Saturday's feature after her victory in the Australia Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) last start. "She always steps up to the plate when she steps up in class, she still seems to blow them away and she's a mare that just keeps on rising," Allen said. "Just her blistering pace that she can show early on in a race and the speed she can hold, she seems to just break their hearts and kick away, she just really can sustain a good gallop, which a lot of horses struggle to do."

Tofane targets Orr-Futurity double

Mark Zahra will bid to guide Tofane (Ocean Park) to a top-flight Caulfield double as the pair head for the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) on Saturday. The son of Ocean Park (Thorn Park) scored first-up win in the C F Orr Stakes (Gr

1, 1400m) on February 12 and Zahra was on a tight schedule to catch a flight to Los Angeles that night for the Superbowl the following day so was therefore unable to enjoy the success properly. "I came home a little tired, but it was definitely worth it," Zahra said. Tofane will be chasing a fifth Group 1 success this weekend and Zahra has said that he will wait to see how the mare jumps from the barriers as to how he will ride the race tactically. "She's always been a horse that we thought would be better with a bit of cover, but she was good in front, however I'm not sure what we're going to do this week," Zahra said. "We'll have a look at the field, but she's shown now that if you want to go forward, she can. She's a bit older now and a bit more settled."

Smith aims to Pocket Mile start through Blamey

Warrnambool-based trainer Lindsey Smith has admitted he will aim to get Corner Pocket (Toronado) into the All-Star Mile (1600m) via a 'win and you're in' race. The talented gelding stretched his unbeaten record to eight on the bounce with an impressive victory in the Elms Handicap (Listed, 1400m) at Flemington on Saturday and the trainer is now set on sending the son of Toronado (High Chaparral) to the Blamey Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at Flemington next month. "He'll go towards the Blamey Stakes now. I owe it to the people who own him to have a throw at the stumps don't I?," Smith told Racing.com in relation to the All-Star Mile. "He seems to be good, I didn't nominate him (for the All-Star Mile) because I always underestimate him. He may not be good enough to win the Blamey to get into the All-Star Mile, but some of those horses will be going in it and he beat them yesterday. No one could deny him a chance to have a go at the Blamey and then the All-Star Mile if he happened to get in it, obviously if he doesn't win it (Blamey) then we go in a different direction. He's one of the few that come race day on comes game face, he's got a tremendous will to win."

Sargent hopes for Four Moves bounce back

John Sargent is hopeful that his dual-Group 2 winner Four Moves Ahead (Snitzel) can

bounce back from a poor effort in the Light Fingers Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) ten days ago when she heads for the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick on Saturday. Sargent believes that the daughter of Snitzel's run was too bad to be true and that there were genuine excuses for her below-par performance. Running from a wide barrier and racing keenly in front, the filly eventually faded late on to come home in 13th, beaten over seven lengths under Nash Rawiller. The three-year-old will look to bounce back against a similar field in this weekend's \$500,000 contest. "We tried the blinkers on and it just didn't work, so we're taking them off," Sargent said. "Now the rain has arrived it should suit her and hopefully we can change it around. She loves the wet and she's worked well this morning. Obviously she'll have to improve to beat Espiona and Fangirl, but she's come on from the run and I'm really happy with her."

Mascot likely to bypass All-Star Mile after missing out

Flying Mascot (Tavistock) is likely to skip the All-Star Mile after failing to make the top ten in the voting leaderboard. The Tom Dabernig-trained mare had been prominent in the voting but failed to make the final cut when voting closed last weekend. "It's one of those things, she is only lightly raced and doesn't really have a profile yet," Dabernig told Racing.com. "There is always next year and we won't rule out that we can't get in this year. If the Blamey wasn't going to come up all that strong for whatever reason and I thought she could win we might go there." The daughter of Tavistock (Montjeu) will now head for the Mannerism Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) this weekend after making an excellent return to action when narrowly beaten by Probabeel (Savabeel) in the Bellmaine Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) on February 12. "I'm never one to not like winning but I was pleased all the same," Dabernig said. "I have been confident she is up to that level and I think she showed that against one of the best mares. It gives me confidence we are heading in the right direction. At 1200 metres she was always going to be a little vulnerable and she's going to be better again at 1400-1600 metres."

Icebath after wildcard

Brad Widdup still remains hopeful that his star mare Icebath (Sacred Falls) can grab a spot into next month's All-Star Mile. The daughter of Sacred Falls (O'Reilly) finished runner-up in last year's Golden Eagle (1500m) before winning the inaugural running of the \$2 million The Invitation (1400m), yet would need a wildcard entry to make the field for the \$5 million contest. "The target will be the Doncaster," Widdup told Racing HQ. "She was nominated for the All-Star Mile and there are still a couple of wildcards to go there. A high-class mare like her, they are letting sit on the shelf a bit so they probably need to be having a look at her. There is plenty of racing in Sydney and we will look at something like the Coolmore (Legacy) or George Ryder." The five-year-old mare will line-up in the Guy Walter Proven Thoroughbreds Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Randwick on Saturday after finishing sixth first-up in the Apollo Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at the same course earlier this month. "She is in good order," Widdup said. "She had a nice, solid hit-out first-up. We kicked her off over 1400 metres and she took no harm out of that at all. She is ready to go, is very well and has been ticking over very nicely."

Home Affairs leads Newmarket nominations

An autumn re-match between Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) one-two Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) and Nature Strip (Nicconi) remains a possibility after champion trainer Chris Waller entered both horses in the first round of acceptors for the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m), which this year will take place at Flemington on March 12. Other acceptors include fellow Lightning Stakes runners Swats That (Shamus Award), Masked Crusader (Toronado), The Astrologist (Zoustar) and The Inferno (Holy Roman Emperor).

Payne targets carnivals after first winner in Queensland

After only recently training her first winner from her new base in Queensland, Michelle Payne is now looking at a potential interstate win with her German import Arabica (Starspangledbanner). The daughter of Starspangledbanner (Choisir) was purchased

half-way through last year in partnership with Ernest and Ronda Clarke, and was an eight-length victor at Mulheim on her second career start in June. "She's a few weeks away from a trial," Payne told Racing.com. "She gives me a good feel but we haven't tested her yet and are just letting her acclimatise. I could take her to Sydney or Adelaide for the Queensland carnival so we will just see." As is the trainer's confidence in the filly, Payne is planning on being back in the saddle for Arabica's Australian debut. "I'm planning on getting back in the saddle," Payne says. "I am ramping back up again now and getting ready to ride again and hopefully to ride Arabica. I'm not far from hanging up the boots but I am going to enjoy the time I have left."

Mount Gambier set for raceday return

Mount Gambier racecourse is set to return after having had close to four years battling turf issues and having not hosted a race meeting since June 14, 2020. Former Murray Bridge track manager David Shepherdson was appointed in an attempt to save the course and after a \$3.3 million redevelopment, he says the track couldn't be in better shape as they gear up for their meeting today. "I wasn't here with the issues previously, but they had 90 per cent poa (grass weed), it took over the whole track - that's been addressed and there wouldn't even be one per cent of it now," Shepherdson told Racing.com. "She's nice and thick, nice and lush, hopefully they bound over it like a cloud. It's got a sand profile, it's like no other track in this state, they don't actually break through, even on a Good 4 they don't really rip out divots. All I've been doing is mowing it so there's a bit of give underneath, it should be just perfect, I hope."

'Poorly worded' rule could see lesser sanction

Trainer Francis Finnegan could escape with a lesser penalty despite pleading guilty to two charges the Victorian Racing Tribunal heard yesterday. The anomaly has arisen after VRT Judge John Bowman, alongside VRT member and former Racing Victoria chief steward Des Gleeson, voiced their inability to locate

a specific rule which states a horse must be identified by their registered name in jump-outs. Finnegan is contesting two charges relating to providing false or misleading evidence and information ahead of No Frontiers (Super Easy) winning at Bairnsdale in May 2020. The Cranbourne-based trainer has pleaded guilty to two charges relating to misconduct.

Gosford abandoned

Gosford's meeting scheduled to take place today has been abandoned after the track was deemed unsuitable for racing due to the presence of surface water following the recent rainfall.

Warwick Farm race change

Following the abandonment of today's Gosford card, Racing NSW announced an amendment to next Wednesday's Warwick Farm card with the 1600-metre Maiden Handicap now open to older horses.

NEW ZEALAND

Hasabro set for Group 1 tilt

Hasabro (Savabeel) will get his chance at elite level when he heads to Otaki on Saturday to line-up in the WFA Group One Classic (Gr 1, 1600m). The gelding has been in fine form since joining Andrew Carston's stable last year, winning four of his seven starts, including the White Robe Lodge (Gr 3, 1600m) earlier this month. "I can't fault him at all, he has done a really good job, capping off with the White Robe last start which was his main target," Carston said. "We have looked where we could go from there and this race fits in nicely. He deserves his crack at a Group 1. It is weight-for-age and he is getting to a stage now where he is high enough in the handicaps here, so weight-for-age suits him. I am happy with my horse and he deserves his chance." Carston is unsure what the future holds for Hasabro after the weekend, but said he has options on either side of the Cook Strait. "We will be guided by how he runs on Saturday," he said. "There are no plans with him as yet, but there are plenty of options for him in both islands."

Williams banking on lightning striking twice

Having made a winning start to his career last month, Desert Lightning (Pride of Dubai) will have a crack at black-type level in Saturday's Matamata Slipper (Gr 3, 1200m). "He'll have a go there and his first time left-handed so we thought it would be a nice race for him," said Peter Williams, who trains Desert Lightning in partnership with his wife Dawn. While Desert Lightning was at long odds at his first appearance, the result was far from surprising to connections. "He was good and he was a bit green and still is, but the result was definitely not a surprise – he's always showed us ability," Williams continued. "Covid buggered us up a bit with him and when we did have him ready to race we had to turn him out, it's just been a few little things that held us up. Having said that, a bit more time hasn't hurt him either." Desert Lightning was a \$150,000 New Zealand Bloodstock Yearling Sale purchase out of the draft of Little Avondale Stud, who will offer his half-brother by Per Incanto (Street Cry) as **Lot 330** at Karaka next month.

Black-type goal for Asathought

Lisa Vaughan is on the lookout for black-type success for Asathought (So You Think) after the mare's victory in Saturday's Invercargill Gold Cup (2600m). Raced by her breeders Willie and Karen Calder, Asathought is already valuable as she is a half-sister to Advantage (Fastnet Rock), the multiple Group 1-winning mare who sold for \$4.1 million on New Zealand Bloodstock's Gavelhouse Plus platform last year. To date, the five-year-old Asathought has won five of her 24 starts but her best effort in black-type races is two third placings. Vaughan said she had three black-type races in mind this autumn – the Valachi Downs South Island Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Riccarton on March 26, the Riverton Cup (Listed, 2147m) at Riverton on April 16 and the Canterbury Gold Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) at Riccarton on April 23. "I know the Breeders' Stakes is probably going to be too short over a mile, but she can go those fast sectional times so if she starts better, you never know how she might go after a freshen up," Vaughan said.

ASIA

HK: Romantic Warrior out to reaffirm status

Hong Kong Classic Mile (Listed, 1600m) winner Romantic Warrior (Acclamation) is out to confirm his status as the leading contender for this year's Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) with victory in this weekend's second leg of the Classic Series, the Hong Kong Classic Cup (Listed, 1800m). The Danny Shum-trained son of Acclamation (Royal Applause) took the opening leg by half a length ahead of reopposing rival California Spangle (Starspangledbanner), to remain unbeaten in five Hong Kong starts. "Of course, it is in the back of our minds that he is stepping up in distance again but he's a progressive horse – I galloped him on Saturday (19 February) and he went really well, he is in good shape and I think the distance will be ok because he can relax and he has a nice turn of foot," jockey Karis Teetan said. Shum was similarly positive on Romantic Warrior's chances of seeing out the increased distance and also saddles Gorytus (Footstepsinthesand) in Sunday's feature at Sha Tin. "We'll give him (Gorytus) the chance and I think he'll run well," Shum said.

HK: Fa Fa chases Classic Cup

Trainer Frankie Lor has elected to give Fa Fa (He's Remarkable) his chance in the Classic Cup as opposed to protecting a sizable lead in the DBS x Manulife Million Challenge. The four-year-old had won four times this season at Happy Valley to earn a 60 to 48-point lead ahead of tonight's finale. Lor will be targeting a third win in the Classic Cup after he won the event in 2019 with Mission Tycoon (Written Tycoon) and last year with Healthy Happy (Zoustar). "Last time, he returned to Sha Tin for the first time in a long time for the Hong Kong Classic Mile and he was also interfered with in the straight, so I think a little bit further should be better for him – 1800 and 2000 metres," Lor said of Fa Fa. The trainer will also send out Money Catcher (Ferlax) for his third run in Hong Kong, and of the New Zealand Group 2 placegetter, he said: "Last

time he ran really good, that's why I still have confidence he will run well again – especially over 1800 and 2000 metres. In New Zealand he stepped out over 2400 metres, but I think that's a little bit long for him – 2000 should be better for him."

HK: Shinn relishing Group 1 wins

Blake Shinn is delighted his hard work and persistence is paying off after riding his second Group 1 winner of the season on board Russian Emperor (Galileo) in Sunday's Hong Kong Gold Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) at Sha Tin. "A lot of people would have given up by now with what I've had to endure," Shinn told Racing.com. "But I'm a pretty resilient person. I knew the journey that was ahead of me. It's being realistic about what's ahead of me and I was prepared to put in the hard yards. I believed in myself and I believed I had the talent to achieve results like we have done this season. I've had to refine my riding and my skills. I've had to work hard physically and mentally. It's basically like starting out again when you come to Hong Kong. It's a rebuilding phase. But we've put in the hard work and I've got a lot of support behind me. I can't be any more thankful to the people that have stuck by me."

SGP: Clements looking forward to Heartening Flyer stepping up in trip

Michael Clements believes the best is still to come from his Kranji Mile (Listed, 1600m) hopeful Heartening Flyer (Excelebration). The five-year-old made a promising return to action when finishing second over 1400 metres last month and he is due to have his first try over a longer trip in a Kranji Stakes A race over 1600 metres on Saturday. "He is stepping up to a mile for the first time and we are pretty excited about this," said Clements of Heartening Flyer, who won a barrier trial under race-partner A'Isisuhairi Kasim last Thursday. "We've always been wanting him to get this distance and he will get it. It was a good run last time, but he is better over 1600 metres. He won his recent trial and has maintained his good condition."

INTERNATIONAL

UK: Murphy banned for 14 months

An independent judicial panel has ruled Oisin Murphy will not be able to re-apply for his riding licence for 14 months – backdated to December 8 – after the three-time champion jockey accepted he was guilty of all five charges brought against him by the British Horseracing Authority. Murphy appeared at High Holborn yesterday morning to face two charges in relation to breaking Covid protocols in September 2020, and two failed tests for alcohol in May and October of 2021 – as well as one overarching charge of “acting in a manner which is prejudicial to the proper integrity, conduct and good reputation of the sport”. Murphy was given three 11-month suspensions for the two Covid breaches and conduct prejudicial to the reputation of the sport, all to run concurrently, along with a £31,111 fine, while he was given ten days for what amounted to a second alcohol positive for his test at Chester on May 5 and a further 90 days for his third such positive recorded at Newmarket on October 8, totalling an additional 100 days. He can return to race-riding on February 16, 2023.

US: Medina Spirit disqualified from Kentucky Derby

Last year’s Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) winner Medina Spirit (Protonico) has been stripped of his title after the stewards in Kentucky finally reached a resolution to the long running saga over a post-race sample taken from the late colt. Both the test, and a subsequent split sample, indicated the presence of the corticosteroid betamethasone, prohibited at any level on race day in the state. Medina Spirit’s Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert was suspended for 90 days and fined \$7,500, in addition to losing his record seventh win in the race. Baffert’s suspension, pending an appeal, will run from March 8 through to June 5. With the stewards’ decision in place, Mandaloun (Into Mischief) is declared the winner. All other runners are moved up one spot. The changes give Juddmonte, trainer Brad Cox, and jockey Florent Geroux their first Kentucky Derby win.


KSA: Boss set for Saudi swansong

Three-time Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m)-winning rider Glen Boss is set to make

a one-off return to competitive action in Saturday’s STC International Jockeys Challenge in Saudi Arabia. Boss, who announced his retirement in November told Racing.com: “I’ve ridden in a lot of countries around the world, but I have never been to Saudi, so it’s just something that I thought, ‘Well, that’s pretty exciting, going to another part of the world, and see how they do things.’ I never say never to anything because we don’t know what the future holds, but if they never asked me to come over there, I wouldn’t be riding.”

UK: Trainor named employee of the year at GSSSA

Paddy Trainor was crowned the 2022 Employee of the Year at the British Godolphin Stud and Stable Staff Awards on Monday evening. Trainor, a qualified industry coach, was announced as the recipient of the Employee of the Year award in recognition of his 23 years of service to Johnston Racing. The work rider also took home the Rider/Groom award earlier in the evening. Dulcie West of North Farm Stud picked up the Stud Staff award.

McEvoy-Mitchell Racing to close historic Adelaide stable

An era in South Australian racing has ended with six-time champion Adelaide trainer Tony McEvoy announcing the closure of his historic Kildalton Park base at Angaston, the former revolutionary Lindsay Park complex established by Colin Hayes.

McEvoy, a former head trainer for Lindsay Park after following on from the Hayes dynasty of Colin and sons Peter and David, bought the Barossa Valley property from the Hayes family with his business partner Wayne Mitchell in 2010.

But having trained out of two interstate bases for several years - the last two in partnership with son Calvin - McEvoy on Tuesday announced his stable would consolidate its operation to centre solely on its Ballarat yard, in the latest high profile move out of South Australian racing.

McEvoy, whose stable has 155 horses on its books, said the move was an emotional but practical decision, with he and wife Jo having

had a 40-year connection to the Angaston property.

"It has been a wonderful 12 years, but life is all about change, and I look forward to the next chapter," McEvoy said in a press release.

"Jo and I love the Barossa Valley, but the reality is we need to now find a new home in Ballarat.

"The fantastic opportunities offered by Victorian racing, with its prize-money and Super VOBIS scheme, are too good to pass up."

Mitchell said Kildalton Park - which has been on the market since last June - would cease operations after the Adelaide autumn carnival.

"It is not a decision we have taken lightly, or made overnight," Mitchell said.

"There has been a lot of money invested into the new Ballarat stable and it is imperative to keep the winners coming.

"It is a business decision to close Kildalton Park.

"The stable will still have a regular presence

in South Australian racing, it is just the horse will be floated from Ballarat instead of Angaston."

The decision represents another key defection from South Australia to Victoria, with the move east having been undertaken by other leading industry figures in recent years, including Philip Stokes, jockey Jamie Kah, and the Hayes family themselves.

Patriarch Colin trod a new path for Australian trainers by setting up Lindsay Park in 1965, inspired by seeing similar set-ups in the UK. The famous farm has been home to some of the greats of Australian racing over five decades, including Dulcify (Decies), Special (Habituate), Zabeel (Sir Tristram) and At Talaq (Roberto).

With 600 metres of Murray River frontage, the 108-acre Kildalton Park has features including a 1200-metre sand track, a 3,000-metre trotting trail and 12 undercover stables.

The McEvoy stable celebrated Adelaide training premierships in 2012, 2013 and the past four seasons.

Hopes high at expanding Cranbourne as Group 1 targets loom large

The Cranbourne training ranks have swollen in quantity and quality in the past 12 months, with the arrival of leviathan outfits and household names relocating from Caulfield.

Despite the recent influx, long standing Cranbourne horsemen Enver Jusufovic and Julius Sandhu have been the flagbearers for south-east Melbourne's excellent training facility over the past two weeks.

While neither are yet household names or leviathan in stature, both Jusufovic, born in Footscray of Bosnian and Slovenian heritage, and Sandhu, from Bangalore in India, have been ensconced at Cranbourne since well before the moves of Maher-Eustace, Price-Kent and Grahame Begg et al, and their training talents have been handsomely advertised in the past fortnight by the unbeaten Pinstriped and Lofty Strike respectively.

Meanwhile, Robbie Griffiths - as local to the area as you can possibly be - is enjoying a resurgence in partnership with a young man from South Africa, Mathew de Kock.

Griffiths and Jusufovic have long been connected, while the latter also has some connection with the relative newcomer, kindly offering boxes to Sandhu at one stage of his fledgling training career in his adopted home. The two also excel in other sporting domains with Jusufovic a very good, if temperamental, golfer while Sandhu is more than highly proficient with billiard cue in hand.

Pinstriped's win in last Saturday's Group 3 C S Hayes Stakes was remarkable given his trainer's level of metropolitan success, while it was a first stakes win for the man universally

known as EJ. Even his phone message says 'you've called EJ'.

This makes me laugh as I recall a mutual friend berating - in good humour - EJ for listing his website as enverjusofovic.racing. "Nobody will be able to google that. Why didn't you go EJ Racing?," the friend said.

Lofty Strike's Group 3 Blue Diamond Prelude win was also a first stakes success for Sandhu. The Group 1 Blue Diamond Stakes now beckons this Saturday, while the holy grail for Pinstriped comes the following week in the Group 1 Australian Guineas.

"I think we've had to stand up," Jusufovic says in reference to the changing face of Cranbourne, his recent success and that of Sandhu.

Other longer term tenants, including Griffiths (and de Kock) and Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young, who settled at Cranbourne in 2016, have also enjoyed good recent form.

"The competition's pretty intense here now," he says before adding, in typically deadpan EJ fashion, "and it's busier. Like bloody Bourke Street but it's all good. It's a magnificent centre which is only going to get better, I think, with more voices and more prominent voices having their input.

"It's an exciting time for me leading into a Group 1, as it is for Julius, who's got some good stock and who's doing a very good job with them.

"It's busy but far from overcrowded," says Griffiths, who's spent his life in Cranbourne and surrounds.

"It's been carefully managed. We've known for five years about the closure of Caulfield and some long-standing trainers here who retired were not replaced. It's all positive. The influx of trainers brings a whole new world of growth, potential clients and opportunity."

Griffiths, not without autumn aspirations himself as King Magnus prepares for the All-Star Mile and Halvorsen the Newmarket, jokes that Cranbourne 'can take over the world.'

"It's a very strong training centre now with a couple of the most powerful stables in the country and depth across the board," he says.

"It's great to see EJ with a good horse and Julius (Sandhu) has given his horse a really good prep and hopefully he can go close in the Diamond."

Jusufovic pre-trains for Griffiths and de Kock and their 'new' stables are adjacent in what was phase one of the redeveloped training centre.

"We're next door neighbours by design. That was the plan from the start with Cranbourne CEO Neil Bainbridge wisely allowing us ownership of the design of the stables," Griffiths says.

Pinstriped's success has been timely after a difficult 12 months for Jusufovic with on-going staff issues, a problem common to many smaller stables, and the loss of several promising horses. Stakes-performed mare Miss Albania and promising filly Jenniferenti have been taken from his care to other trainers.

"Happens," he says matter-of-factly.

Worse were the deaths of Leilani Final winner Lindhout and promising gelding Roebling.

Jusufovic says: "I lost them in the space of a week. Lindhout developed colic and then septicemia after a wind op. I thought she was a Group 3 horse. She had an amazing will to win. Roebling had a paddock accident. Something penetrated the hoof and coffin joints. It was quite sinister."

The difficulties of attracting staff to a smaller operation exacerbated by Covid-enforced absenteeism, and no international arrivals of potential workers, have also presented challenges.

"Last Wednesday, for example, I had 28 horses to work, including some pre-trainers for Robbie and Mat with just me, two other staff and one track rider. We finished at 11.30. We're under a fair bit of pressure most of the time but the horses still get maximum attention," he says.

It's that pressure, he says, which has adversely affected his golf when I ask if the description of him as 'temperamental' on the golf course was fair?

"Only of late," he concedes. "I've walked off a few times recently. Probably only managed nine holes in my last five rounds. With the pressure we're under I probably just haven't been in the right space for it (golf)."

The pressure valve had only a very slight release after last Saturday's win.

He continues: "I was relieved but very tired. Think I had half a glass of beer after the presentation, went home and had a couple of fried eggs and a glass of milk before an early bedtime."

You fancy it might be a touch more exuberant should Pinstriped claim the Guineas.

Jusufovic acknowledges it's some challenge for his horse to progress from a debut, heavy track Moe maiden win to Group 1 success at just his fourth start but remains optimistic after the Street Boss gelding resolutely overhauled the Busuttin and Young-trained front-runner Pascero last Saturday with the Snowden's Caulfield Guineas runner-up Captivant and Pascero's stablemate Forgot You closing late to finish third and fourth respectively.

"He's done everything right and he came

through Saturday's race very well. Captivant and Forgot You will meet him better at the weights but, in my view, weights don't mean everything. You'd be more concerned that a horse like Captivant is peaking on (Australian) Guineas day but hopefully we're doing the same," he says.

Jusufovic had not laid a hand on a horse before beginning his racing journey with fellow Cranbourne trainer Greg Eurell. Some years later, it was exactly the same story when now leading West Australian trainer Simon Miller approached Griffiths.

Griffiths, too, has had some challenges especially after surgery for a brain aneurysm in 2019.

"The business took a hit after that. We had plenty of loyal clients but obviously some investors are likely to be timid if the boss is out of action but we've been reinvigorated on many fronts, not the least of which was Mathew (de Kock) coming on board," he says.

"Clients are now keen to invest in the future we're building together. Three years of good buying - we're only one down with Mat on board - will have us very excited about our niche in the market place and we've got a really good cross section of two-year-olds this year who can provide a platform for future success."

They include last Saturday's debut winner Fission and last-start Moonee Valley winner Berry Bubbly along with Yaki Ishi, a colt by Maurice and half brother to Griffiths' ill-fated 2015 Blue Diamond Preview winner Burnstone, who debuts at Pakenham on Thursday night.

Sandhu followed his brother, who incidentally went to school with Hong Kong trainer Caspar Fownes, into racing and learned his craft with legendary Indian trainer Aris David before moving on to Dubai with Kieran McLaughlin and working with Mick Kent when he first arrived at Cranbourne.

Jusufovic and Sandhu probably remain Cranbourne's best-kept secret with betting markets still largely not reacting to the quality of their horses or their capability. That will change soon enough, I suspect.

Pinstriped was a 'silly' \$5.50 last Saturday after a herculean lead-up win at Moonee Valley. Lofty Strike is a similar quote to win the Blue Diamond after winning the Prelude at \$10.

"He'd be 6-4 favourite for the Diamond if he were trained by Godolphin or us or one of the other big stables," rival trainer Wayne Hawkes said last week. Not to jinx Julius, I trust.

Sandhu has won three races, at good odds, with promising stayer The Awesome Son who was winless in campaigns for Chris Waller and Annabel Neasham. With the backing of owner Paul Lofitis, he is beginning to make quite an impact.

I think he knows how to get a quid. He certainly knows his angles.

"I got to a reasonably good level, won a few state championships," he told Matt Stewart and I in a recent radio interview in reference to his snooker and billiards skills.

He proceeded to tell the story of winning two or three competitions, each worth \$700 in the space of a few weeks, in a Box Hill pool hall soon after arriving in Melbourne.

"That was until it was made quite clear I wasn't particularly welcome to come back," he said.

Sandhu is hopeful Lofty Strike won't be snookered by drawing 13 in Saturday's Diamond.

"The barrier draw is the barrier draw and we'll deal with it and I'll back (jockey) Jamie (Mott) in. Hopefully he can get a similar run to the Prelude, although he may have to get rolling sooner given the bigger field and be there to accelerate from the 400 (metres)," he says.

"He's a big-striding horse so drawing out is probably better than drawing one or two. He'll lap up the 1200 (metres), he's mentally strong and his will to win is probably his greatest asset."

Perhaps those prickly pool players can get their money back this weekend?

Whyte to again test the European-breds' Classic credentials after Emperor's Gold display



Douglas Whyte has put his faith in the European breed as a superior product when it comes to races over a mile plus in Hong Kong, but only when given the time and patience to flourish in what is a harsher, more alien racing arena to the open pastures they are accustomed to.

That judgement reaped rewards for the champion jockey-turned-trainer, when his Russian Emperor (Galileo) led home a stable one-two in Sunday's Hong Kong Gold Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) to deliver the biggest win of Whyte's second career, one that followed quickly on

from a first Group 1 success with Stronger (Not A Single Doubt) in the Centenary Sprint Cup (Gr 1, 1200m) last month.

Whyte saddled the only two European-bred horses in the weekend's ten-runner Group 1 event at Sha Tin, with Russian Emperor proving to be a dominant force, finishing four and a quarter lengths ahead of Savvy Nine (Anodin), as the pair dealt another blow to champion racehorse Golden Sixty (Medaglia D'Oro), who toiled in the softening conditions to finish five and a half lengths adrift of the worthy winner in third.

China Equestrian Association updates 2022 fixture list

Following an earlier announcement on the tendering invitation for the 2022 fixture plan, the China Equestrian Association (CEA) published an updated 2022 fixture plan with the tenders approved in a press release on February 17.

Among the ten equestrian disciplines listed in the plan, showjumping, as one of the three equestrian disciplines in the Olympics, is still the most frequently held event.

While for many years, horseracing was

traditionally the second most popular event after the Olympic equestrian events, with about ten racedays in one season, there are only three racedays listed in 2022, namely one Grand Prix Raceday and one Championships Raceday applied for by the Hubei Province Wuhan City Sports Bureau during the October Racing Festival and one Open Tournaments Raceday applied for by the Inner Mongolian Hohhot City Horse Racing Association on June 4.

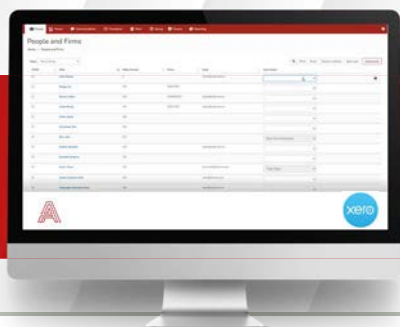
HK: Stud deal in the offing for Stronger

Douglas Whyte confirmed to Asia Bloodstock News that studs were circling to secure Hong Kong Centenary Sprint Cup (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Stronger (Not A Single Doubt) for stud duties for the next breeding season. The five-year-old entire picked up his first elite-level success in last month's incident-packed Group 1 contest, adding a third win to his record in Hong Kong. Whyte is preparing the son of Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice), who was a AU\$1.05 million yearling, for the Chairman's Sprint Prize (Gr 1, 1200m) in April. "There has been interest in Stronger," Whyte said. "There has been contact from two stud farms and several others interested in him. That's very promising because I think he's bred well and he's a lovely, well natured horse. So I think he's got all the credentials to make for a stallion should someone want to take a chance on him. If he was a hand taller he'd probably be a multiple Group 1 winner by now, but what he lacks in height he makes up for in heart. He really doesn't know how to run a bad race, he's probably been unlucky on three occasions."

JPN: Cafe Pharoah defends February Stakes crown

Cafe Pharoah (5 h ex American Pharoah - Mary's Follies by More Than Ready) claimed back-to-back victories in the February Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Tokyo after bursting clear of the field to win Sunday's running of the Grade 1 by a clear two and a half lengths. The five-year-old son of US Triple Crown-winning Coolmore shuttler American Pharoah (Pioneerof The Nile) joins Copano Rickey (Gold Allure) as just the second horse to win the race twice. The Noriyuki Hori-trained Cafe Pharoah defeated last start Negishi Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) winner T M South Dan (South Vigorous), with best three-year-old filly Sodashi (Kurofune) a half-length further back in third. "Mr. Hori and I went over the tactics before the race and everything went as planned," said jockey Yuichi Fukunaga.

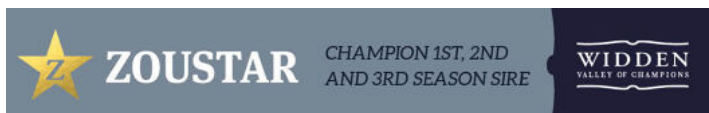


