Fairhill Farm's O'Donnell on cloud nine after Pierro filly fetches \$400,000

Too Darn Hot, Toronado and Blue Point colts also find favour at Inglis Australian Weanling Sale

ike O'Donnell was sporting a million dollar smile after day one of the Inglis Australian Weanling Sale, having raked in more than \$1.7 million at the Sydney foal sale where his Fairhill Farm operation set a new stud record price of \$400,000.

The popular expatriate Kiwi breeder, who along with his wife Di runs NSW property Fairhill

Farm, sold the two highest-priced weanlings at Riverside Stables yesterday, with his Pierro (Lonhro) half-sister to Group 2 winner Fiesta (I Am Invincible) going to growing thoroughbred enterprise Trilogy Racing.

Run by Jason and Mel Stenning with the assistance of Caithness Breeding's Sean Dingwall, the \$400,000 Pierro filly could be reoffered at a yearling sale next year but her residual value would also provide the group with the option to retain her. *Continued on page 3>>*

<< Continued from page 2 "For us, being the number one draft pick, we were happy to pay for her. We had to go a bit further than we hoped, but at the end of the day she was the one we wanted," Dingwall said.

"From a Pierro perspective, I think she's the best Pierro I've seen, she had more strength than a lot of what I see from a Pierro perspective and that gave me a lot of confidence.

"We love the stallion but it is always hard to find the horse that you like by him. She's also a half-sister to a Group 2 winner (Fiesta) and she's a mare who has only just gone to stud, so there's upside in the pedigree."

The filly, the ninth foal out of five-time winner Now Now (Danehill Dancer), has a two-year-old sister named Coleraine who is raced by O'Donnell.

"Now Now has been very good to us, we actually bought her off Coolmore and they sold her at Newmarket, we bought her and raced her on and won another three races for us and she's been very good to us," O'Donnell said last night.

"We have a two-year-old full-sister in training with Peter and Paul Snowden. Let's hope this one is as good as we think the other one is and we're very comfortable selling her."

Meanwhile, the Stennings' Trilogy Racing has burst onto the scene in the past 12 months in a big way, becoming a key member of the Newgate Farm-China Horse Club colts syndicate, as well as investing heavily in their own bloodstock portfolio.

"Obviously we have got a plan around that. You can't do much if you don't have horses," Dingwall said of Trilogy's spending spree.

"We knew there'd be a big burn early and we are coming to the end of that now. We'll buy a few mares to get a rounded group of horses and then we'll see where we end up."

<< Continued from page 3 The leading vendor after day one, Fairhill Farm's 20 weanlings to sell on the opening day for a combined \$1,768,500 helped go some way to satisfy the demand of buyers, but Inglis Bloodstock chief executive Sebastian Hutch suggested that demand outstripped supply of quality foals.

"The competition for nice foals was nothing short of extraordinary and the number of vendors who got results which exceeded their expectations was really taking and a really satisfying part of the day," Hutch told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"In the case of foals that were in the lower quarter of market or people who got a bit too aggressive with their reserves, the market exposed those horses a bit, but the clearance rate improved throughout the day. As has been the case this year, it will continue to improve.

"Buyers found horses who they feel can take prominent rank in important sales next year or be good racehorses - there were a number of horses bought for end-use as well."

Overall, with 137 lots catalogued for today's session still to sell, the 2022 weanling sale aggregate of \$8,650,000 exceeded last year's one-day sale of \$8,438,000, while the average was up 15 per cent year on year, rising to \$50,882. The median was last night at \$30,000, up \$6,000, while the clearance rate stood at 74 per cent.

Fairhill Farm's O'Donnell has in recent years sold his foal crop as weanlings rather than split them up and offer some to the market as yearlings and buyers recognised that with the pre-sale interest in his draft.

"To my way of thinking, you've got to be one or the other. We present everything and that's very important," he said yesterday.

"Buyers know that what is at the sales complex is what we've got. There's nothing retained. They're all on offer and I think that's important.

"It's been organised chaos. (On Tuesday) there wasn't a minute spare and we did another 70 cards today, which is phenomenal alone, but prior to that, we've done 2205 individual parades. It's enormous, there's been massive interest.

"We were shocked, to be honest. It was quite extraordinary, really."

The second top lot sold by the O'Donnells was a colt by first crop Darley shuttler Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) who made \$320,000 to the bid of Segenhoe Stud's Peter O'Brien who bought the star colt in conjunction with a group of prominent Australasian industry figures who intend to resell him next year.

The colt is a half-sister to the Coolmore-owned last-start Twilight Glow Stakes (Listed, 1400m) winner Lady Of Honour (No Nay Never) and the sixth foal out of Majesty (Fastnet Rock), herself a sister to the stakes placed Kincara Miss.

"The horse is a magnificent type, a great mover and from a great farm, so for us he was a no-brainer," O'Brien said.

"This fella will be right up there (with the other foals on the farm) when he comes back to Segenhoe. He's as good a foal as I've seen all year. At the end of the day we expected he'd make around \$300,000, so we had to go a little more but we're delighted to get him."

O'Brien is an unabashed fan of Too Darn Hot, a champion two- and three-year-old colt in Europe who is also out of a champion mare in Dar Re Mi (Singspiel), herself related to a host of high-end stakes winners in Europe and the UAE. He stands for \$44,000 (inc GST) again this coming season.

"His pedigree's just off the charts. Between Segenhoe mares and clients' mares I think we're the biggest supporter of his and I think we've got 15 mares back in foal to him and have nine going back to him this year as well," he said.

"We're big fans. If all of them are like this fella (Lot 242), it's a no-brainer really."

The O'Brien-led syndicate earlier went to \$300,000 for a colt by Swettenham Stud stallion Toronado (High Chaparral), the sire of Group 1-winning sprinters Masked Crusader and Shelby Sixtysix.

Sold by Bell River Thoroughbreds early in the session as Lot 10, the colt is out of Ain't She Smart (Smart Missile), an unraced half-sister to the dual Listed winner Ain'tnodeeldun (Dundeel) and a daughter of two-time stakes winner Ain'tnofallenstar (Starcraft). *Continued on page 7>>*

<< Continued from page 5 Ain't She Smart was purchased by Hunter Valley Bloodstock carrying the Toronado colt in utero for \$140,000 through an Inglis Digital sale in June last year.

"He was a beautiful colt, we really like the stallion, he is very mature and one of the best movers at the sale. We thought we had to strike early as we think the market will be very strong for the good ones," O'Brien said.

"We had to pay a bit more than we thought, but that's the way it is. He is a big, strong horse, so he will either be (reoffered) at Magic Millions or Easter, one or the other, and we will see how he grows out."

Toronado, whose fee has increased to \$88,000 (inc GST) for the 2022 breeding season, has also enjoyed success with his progeny in Hong Kong, being the sire of last Sunday's Queen Mother Memorial Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) winner Senor Toba and eight other winners from just 12 starters.

"(The stallion) has got a lot of young, progressive horses in training and I think he'll get hotter and hotter and hopefully we can ride the wave with him," O'Brien said.

"The Toronados have sold very well this year and you wouldn't get a better looking one than that fella, so hopefully he can be up there with the big guns."

O'Brien added: "A group of friends got together to form a syndicate, we ended with a short list of five and we've got two of them – both who will be presented as yearlings at select sales next year – so we're leaving happy."

Bell River's James Ferguson, whose team was overrun with parades on Monday and Tuesday at Riverside Stables, agreed that Toronado, who is currently ninth on the Australian general sires' table by progeny earnings, was a sire on the rise.

"The sire is on fire and he is going better than I thought he would be inside the past 12 months, the market's red-hot and the thinking was to take the money while we can," Ferguson said.

"At the same time I hope Peter O'Brien and his team get a good result out of him because we're all in the game to make a bit of coin at the end of the day, so hopefully they get the result, too."

The spectacular sales ring result did not surprise Ferguson, who added: "We thought that was where we thought he'd land, between \$200,000 and \$300,000, and it was just a matter if there was going to be two judges on him (at that level).

"The team at Inglis have got the people here, as they do at every sale, so it is a good result all round."

Blue Point colt finds favour

In a further endorsement of the Darley shuttle stallions at yesterday's sale, the first southern hemisphere-bred weanling to be offered at public auction by Blue Point (Shamardal), a champion European sprinter who won four Group 1s, also made an immediate impression with Australasian buyers after the Rifa Mustang-bred colt sold for \$290,000 yesterday.

Offered on Mustang's behalf by Sledmere Stud as Lot 214, Newgate Farm stud manager Jim Carey won out for the colt, going to \$290,000 to buy him after the bidding opened at \$220,000, which immediately put the horse on the market.

"He's a very straight forward, quality colt and he'll come back here to a sale next year," Carey said.

"He's got plenty of upside, being out of a young, running Not A Single Doubt mare. He's off a great farm and it's great to get a colt of that quality to sell through Newgate next year. He's the first Blue Point I've seen and he's a really nice colt."

The son of Blue Point is the third foal out of the stakes-placed juvenile winner Lady Loire (Not A Single Doubt), who was raced by the colt's breeder Mustang. Blue Point will stand for \$44,000.

Smith strikes for son of So You Think

Victoria's Rhys and Chloe Smith of Kulani Park were also active on day one, purchasing two weanlings to retrade at next year's yearling sales, headed by a son of this season's leading stallion in Australia, So You Think (High Chaparral) for \$225,000.

The colt, sold by Tyreel Stud as Lot 72, is the third foal out of threetime winner Choux Diva (Thorn Park), herself a sister to five-time Group 1 winner Jimmy Choux and a half-sister to another Group 1 winner in Miss Wilson (Stratum).

"He just looks like a racehorse, he's got a good pedigree, his family sells well, I love So You Think, so that was enough for me," Rhys Smith said.

"You always hope that there is (improvement in them), but you never know, but he does look like he will continue to improve."

Smith won't be rushed into making a call on where the So You Think colt or the \$85,000 All Too Hard (Casino Prince) colt he purchased (Lot 150) will be sold next year.

"We have been an under bidder on a couple here already, so you have to pay more than what you want otherwise you're going home with nothing," he said of yesterday's market.

Day two of the Inglis Australian Weanling Sale starts at 10am where the buyer appetite is expected to continue before tomorrow night's starstudded Chairman's Sale of elite mares.

A proven source of stakes winners during his years standing at Widden Stud, Your Song has sired 177 winners of over \$22million in prizemoney including 14 stakes horses headed by Group 2 winner Brave Song and Group 3 winners Gem Song and Miss Exfactor. The Group 1 scorer also sired his fifth individual stakes winner yesterday when Frankie Pinot won the Wangroom Handicap (Listed, 1200m) at Warrnambool. His other winners this season include metropolitan scorer Frosty Rocks, a winner of over \$600,000, as well as Lyrical Girl, She Can Sing and Rhythmic Pulse.

Ilovethiscity's fee announced

Group 1-winning sire Ilovethiscity (Magic Albert) will stand the 2022 breeding season at Noor Elaine Farm for a reduced fee of \$6,600 (inc GST). Winner of the ATC Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), Ilovethiscity has

been making headlines of late after his son King's Consort won the \$1 million Showdown (1200m). Ilovethiscity has proven to be a strong producer of stakes class runners with the likes of El Dorado Dreaming, King of Hastings, Ilovemyself, Chapel City, Moonlover and stakes-performed Pippali and Savoie all making their mark. 

"I honestly can't believe it. I can't thank the connections and Tony and Calvin enough," Lloyd told Racing.com. "This horse means a lot to me. I've had three wins and two seconds on him now. He's a special horse for me. I could hear the crowd roaring halfway down the straight. It was great." Frankie Pinot is the first foal out of winning Sebring (More Than Ready) mare My Last Fling, who has a yearling Written By (Written Tycoon) filly and a weanling All Too Hard (Casino Prince) colt. She was covered by Doubtland (Not A Single Doubt) last spring.

Queensland next for O'Shea juvenile

John O'Shea is likely to send Shalailed (Shalaa) to Queensland next after the improving colt scored a first win yesterday at Canterbury, despite not enjoying the heavy conditions. The son of Shalaa (Invincible Spirit) had just enough left in the tank to hold on from the latechallenging Kandos Cosmos (Stratum Star) in the TAB Plate (1200m) as the testing ground brought stamina into play. Group 2-winning mare So You Assume (So You Think) will make her return to the racetrack on Saturday when she lines up in the Robert Sangster Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Morphettville. The Shane Nichols-trained daughter of So You Think took the Stocks Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at Moonee Valley during her last campaign but hasn't been seen since contesting last year's Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m). "So You Assume's in good order," Nichols told Racing. com. "She trialled a bit fat the other day. She is in a serious 1200-metre race Saturday, but her rating sits where it's difficult at that level for her at 1200 metres. She'll also come up to Brisbane, there's a couple of nice mile mares races for her coming up in the future." Stablemate Brazen Song (Brazen Beau) will join the mare in the 1200-metre feature in Adelaide after galloping alongside her earlier this week. "She worked with Brazen Song, who's going around in the Queen Of The South in Adelaide and Brazen Song worked out of her skin, probably as well as she's been all prep, so So You Assume knew she had a work partner and they both worked terrifically well," Nichols said. "Brazen Song is probably as well as she's been. A mile's a bit far for her but she did run third in a half milliondollar mile race on Oaks Day last year."

Zaaki team seeking QLD bonus

Connections of Zaaki (Leroidesanimaux) will be hoping that the All-Star Mile (1600m) winner can repeat his feat of 12 months ago and win both Saturday's Hollindale Stakes (Gr 2, 1800m) and back up in the Doomben Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) to snare a \$200,000 bonus provided by Racing Queensland. Annabel Neasham is confident about her stable star's chances heading into this weekend's Group 2 contest. "It certainly helped entice us to run him in that race because we could have probably just gone straight to the Doomben Cup," Neasham told Racing.com. "He was only just beaten in a Queen Elizabeth and now coming back to a Group 2 against less-experienced horses than he has been racing against." Zaaki did a final piece of work at Warwick Farm on Tuesday morning and will arrive at the Gold Coast tomorrow morning for the start of his Queensland campaign. "This was his first win so it'd be nice if we could go backto-back," Neasham said. "Probably a stronger field than he came across last year, but he's a very consistent horse and I couldn't be happier so I see no reason why he shouldn't run another big race. He's a genuine weight-for-age horse who's won a lot of Group 1s and I see no reason why he can't keep going with the form he's shown his last few starts."

Huetor to take on Zaaki in Hollindale

Promising French import Huetor (Archipenko) will face his biggest task to date when he tackles Zaaki in the Hollindale Stakes. The Paul and Peter Snowden-trained gelding will be aiming to earn a crack at the Doomben Cup, which is also a target race for Zaaki, on May 21. "I just want to see where he measures up and how far away from those horses he is," Peter Snowden said. "If he is close to them, knowing there is improvement to come, I will keep going the way I'm thinking. If he gets beaten a long way, we can go to Plan B." Huetor scored a hattrick of wins over the summer and proved he was in good form when returning with a firstup third behind Our Playboy (Sebring) over 1400 metres at Randwick on April 16. "He had no right to do that. He is not a seven-furlong (1400m) horse in a million years so the fact he has gone that well conveys what we've been thinking for a while, that he's above average," Snowden said.

Bay to tackle some of Australia's finest

New Zealand mare Coventina Bay (Shamexpress) will have the opportunity to take on some of the best horses in Australia when she lines up in the Hollindale Stakes. The daughter of Shamexpress (O'Reilly) finished runner-up in the Thorndon Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) in January before winning the Herbie Dyke Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and Bonecrusher Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) in her native country. She was also second to Imperatriz (I Am Invincible) in the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) on her latest outing but her trainer Robbie Patterson feels she could easily have won that day with more luck. "After she ran second in the last Group 1, a couple of days later she had a blowout of her heel, so she had an infection in there when she raced, so that would have been niggling her a bit," Patterson said. "It has been a bit angry since. We changed the shoes on her and I think that was aggravating as well. I got the farrier in vesterday and he changed the shoes around and she worked a lot better today (Thursday). She has settled in great. She travelled well and she has done everything right. She is a seasoned campaigner now."

Rock aiming to provide Dabernig with Cup win

Tom Dabernig is hoping that Angel Rock (Rock Hero) can provide him with a first Warrnambool Cup (Listed, 2350m) victory since becoming a solo trainer. Furrion (Camelot) gave Dabernig, along with then training partners David and Ben Hayes, their sole victory in the Listed race in 2019 and Angel Rock will bid to add to that success, and her recent Terang Cup (2150m) victory, when she steps out today. The daughter of Rock Hero (Fastnet Rock) has been a real talking point this preparation, beginning her campaign with a win in a Benchmark 58 at Geelong in November, and following that up with wins at Warrnambool, Moonee Valley and Terang, while also placing at Caulfield and Flemington. "She's won the Terang Cup which

Maher also on the Cup hunt

After finishing second in last year's renewal with Heart Of Puissance (Puissance De Lune), Ciaron Maher has sent Group 2 winner and Group 1 placegetter Grandslam (Moyboycharlie) to contest this year's Warrnambool Cup in the hope that he can gain a first success in his hometown feature. Maher has put together a long-range plan with fellow local Colin McKenna in order to have the son of Myboycharlie (Danetime) primed for today's Listed event. "It's been the plan for a while," Maher, who trains in partnership with David Eustace, told Racing. com. "He had a long break and I just wanted to run him in the VOBIS race at Caulfield rather than the Easter Cup, thinking he might get in a bit better on the weights and it's worked out pretty well for him. First time out to the 2300 metres, I think he's in the right sort of head space, a bit older and more mature. He used to be a bit aggressive as a colt, now a gelding he should be right to go." Grandslam, who is rated \$1.80 favourite with bookmakers, will be ridden by Jamie Kah.

Second Cup win the target for Moroney

Michael Moroney will be bidding for a second win in the Warrnambool Cup as he sends two last-start Group winners to the feature contest. Kiwi-bred pair Milford (Savabeel) and Nerve Not Verve (Shocking) will tackle the \$300,000 race, one that the stable won in 2007 with Sarrera (Quest For Fame). Nerve Not Verve won the Chairman's Quality (Gr 2, 2600m) on his latest start at Randwick on April 2. "We weren't in the Sydney Cup so we decided to have this run before going to the paddock for the spring,"

Moroney told Racing.com. "She's a pretty tough mare, nothing fazes her, and the more you do with her, the better she is. She has become that way after being a bit frail, that's probably par for the course for a lot of them, but she's turned into a tough mare. We can't fault her." Meanwhile, Milford nosed out Holbien in the \$200,000 Easter Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) at Caulfield on April 16. "He's got to step up to this trip quickly and handle the wet, they are the two things that are a question mark," Moroney said. "He's thriving and doing things well. He's getting better and better and he will be an interesting runner in the Cup as well."

Gosford date before Doomben 10,000 for Shelby

The recent weather forecast for Brisbane next week has Danny Williams hoping that The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) winner Shelby Sixtysix (Toronado) can sneak a spot in the Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m). The son of Toronado (High Chaparral) will contest the Takeover Target Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Gosford this weekend and has drawn the outside barrier in 16. However, Williams is hopeful that Shelby Sixtysix can produce a solid performance and one that would have him spot on for the Doomben 10,000 just a week later. "We were looking at the weather for Queensland next week and they're forecasting a lot of rain leading into Saturday," the trainer said. "I'm contemplating going to Gosford and seven days later running in the Doomben 10,000. There's a lot of questions to be answered before we go up there and one of those is, would he definitely get a run? He is just lacking recent racing. I know he only ran a fortnight ago, but he has only had the two runs in five weeks and it's not the routine I would have liked. (Barrier

16) makes it very difficult around a track like Gosford that suits on-speed horses. He hasn't got the speed to cross them. We will just have to see how it pans out."

Crosshaven given Archer target

Lindsay Park will have a first runner in north Queensland this weekend when Crosshaven (Smart Missile) lines up in the inaugural running of The Archer (1300m) at Rockhampton on Saturday. The Archer race is modelled on the successful The Everest (1200m) and has a \$440,000 prize-money pot, with \$275,000 going to the winner. The Ben and JD Hayes-trained son of Smart Missile (Fastnet Rock) could potentially remain in Queensland for the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) at Eagle Farm next month. "It's the first time the stable will have a runner up there," Ben Hayes said. "It wasn't something that was originally on our radar until we got some interest." Crosshaven heads into the race on the back of a last-start fourth behind Cherry Tortoni (Night Of Thunder) in the Golden Mile (Listed, 1600m) at Bendigo last month and Hayes said the four-year-old had trialled nicely between outings. "He trialled up super and goes up there in peak order," Hayes said. "If he wins then we'll set him for the Stradbroke, but there are a number of other suitable races up there for him as well."

Ridge aiming to go one better in Wagga Cup

Randwick-based trainer Mark Newnham is hoping that Spirit Ridge (Nathaniel) can go one better in tomorrow's Wagga Wagga Gold Cup (Listed, 2000m). The seven-year-old finished second in last year's renewal behind Inverloch (Fastnet Rock) before then going on to win the Premier's Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) at Eagle Farm, a victory which was also his most recent success. "I thought he was a bit unlucky last year in the Wagga Cup and we always wanted to go back to try and win the race," Newnham said. "The horse is spot on for the 2000 metres and having raced at the track before is a bonus." Spirit Ridge will be ridden by stable apprentice Tom Sherry and was a last-start fourth in Caulfield's Easter Cup.

Clarken happy with Derby candidate Harleymoven

Harleymoven (Foxwedge) is set for a date with the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) after pleasing Murray Bridge-based trainers Dan Clarken and Oopy Macgillivray with his recovery after placing in the Chairman's Stakes (Gr 3, 2020m) at Morphettville last weekend. Jumping from barrier 12 of 15, Harleymoven settled in last place on the back of a good pace before finishing well down the centre of the track to be beaten less than a length in second. "Harley has pulled up fantastic," Clarken said. "On Sunday morning he'd absolutely demolished everything we fed him, he went for a swim and had a roll and seemed to be in really good order. This morning he had a little bit of work on the treadmill and he seems in a really good spot. You wouldn't imagine you're going to get that tempo in a Derby. If he gets the chance to travel and then let go at the end of the race, I imagine he's going to be hard to beat."

Artorius begins Ascot preparation

Artorius (Flying Artie) took his first step towards his trip to Royal Ascot when he took in an easy trial at Balnarring yesterday morning. The winner of last year's Blue Diamond Stakes ran second when asked for very little, with his next trial set to be more of a test. "He'll trial down the straight with Nature Strip and Home Affairs in a couple of weeks, that'll be the Friday and he'll fly out a few days later," Sam Freedman, who trains the colt with his father Anthony, told Racing.com. The son of Flying Artie (Artie Schiller) will depart on June 1 and be stabled at Newmarket ahead of his target race, the Platinum Jubilee (Gr 1, 6f) on the final day of Royal Ascot on June 17, where he is set to be ridden by former British champion jockey Jamie Spencer. "He'll be there for two-and-ahalf weeks before the race, which is plenty of time and, all going to plan, be fit and well and not have to do too much," Freedman said. "He'll probably just have to do one piece of work and then run in the Platinum Jubilee."

Waller plans to split sprint stars

Chris Waller yesterday said he is looking to run his Ascot-bound sprinting stars in separate races at the royal meeting in June. Nature Strip (Nicconi) and Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) figure prominently in the early betting for both the King's Stand Stakes (Gr 1, 5f) on the opening day of the meeting and the Platinum Jubilee Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) on the closing day. Waller said that while final plans are still to be confirmed he was looking at running Nature Strip in the King's Stand and Home Affairs in the Platinum Jubilee.

Swanky causes huge upset

Many punters were left in shock at Murray Bridge yesterday after \$151 chance Swankytoff (Toorak Toff) caused a massive boilover in a 2000-metre handicap. The Nicole Irwin-trained gelding settled nicely and took up the lead inside the final 100 metres, scoring by more than a length over the Neva Doubt Us (Not A Single Doubt). The victory was the nine-year-old's first since June 2020 and came off the back of a 47-length defeat at Clare last month.

Bowman gets his maiden 'Bool winner

Champion jockey Hugh Bowman scored a first winner on his maiden visit to the Warrnambool May Racing Carnival when he rode the Colin and Janice McKenna-owned Flash Flood (Night Of Thunder) to victory yesterday. "It was great to be here, I've had a lovely week," Bowman told Racing.com. "I've enjoyed riding a little heavier than my minimum weight, so I've enjoyed the festivities and met lots of lovely people down here. It's just a great racing community. It would have left a sour taste to have left without a winner but to win in Colin and Janice's colours is very special. To win in any colours is special but to be down here with them, riding for them, it means a great deal. Ciaron (Maher) was very confident, Col said that this was their best chance of the week, although I hope Jamie (Kah) is in there ready to go because they've got high hopes for Grandslam in tomorrow's (Warrnambool) Cup."

Quirindi transferred to Muswellbrook

The Quirindi meeting scheduled for Monday has been transferred to Muswellbrook after Racing NSW stewards yesterday inspected the Quirindi track and deemed it unsuitable for racing. As a result, the following race distance amendments can be found here.

Robinson targets Riccarton feature

Lance Robinson feels that the weather could play a large factor in deciding which of his duo could have the best chance of winning Saturday's Great Easter Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Riccarton. Robinson trains the two highestrated runners nominated for the contest, Live Drama (Ghibellines) and Khimar War (Sweet Orange), and said both have trained well since their last outing at Riccarton on April 23, where Khimar War scored a one and a half length success in an open 1200-metre event on a Good 3 track, while Live Drama finished sixth, less than three lengths behind her stablemate. "The track's currently a Soft 5 but we don't have any rain predicted this week so it might be a good track again if it's not watered," Robinson said. "Khimar War really likes the firm footing, whereas Live Drama would probably like a little bit of cut in the ground. In saying that, a Good 3 track in autumn usually has a little more cushion than a Good 3 track in the middle of summer. I'm not sure what the top weight is going to be, but she (Live Drama) carried 60.5 kilograms last start and it's tough for a mare to carry that much. I feel like Khimar War has also been a little high in the handicap, and his last start was the first for a while that he's been on a good weight for him."

Furlong to have three runners at historic meeting

Christchurch-based trainer Anna Furlong is a strong supporter of the Riccarton all-weather

track and has admitted she would love to saddle a winner there on opening day today. Furlong and training partner Shane Kennedy will send three runners to the inaugural Polytrack meeting, Petty's Legacy (Sweynesse) and Feelin' Fancy (Rip Van Winkle) in the Two Rosses Beckett & Murdoch 1600 and debutant Lady's Legacy (Highly Recommended) in the Paradigm Civil Maiden (1200m). "I'm really looking forward to it. There are going to be horses that will definitely suit it and ones that we'll find out don't. It's just going to be a matter of let's see what happens," Furlong said. "A lot of trials on it have been quite strung out. There have been horses that have won from the back and others have won from the front so I don't think there will be a bias but it will be interesting to see how it plays out. As a training surface, it's amazing. We love it. It's great for the young ones; it's great for all of them really. We haven't had any issues so we're more than pleased."

Firsts for Smith and Hannan at Ruakaka

Yesterday's meeting at Ruakaka will live long in the memory for local trainer Darren Smith and apprentice Kelsey Hannan who both landed their first ever winners when Tazimoto (Tarzino) struck. Having jumped only satisfactorily, the son of Tarzino (Tavistock) was gathered up by Hannan and found a good position throughout the race before running away in the straight to score a length victory over Vegas Strip (Shocking), with a further length back to Pizzazz (Vadamos) in third. "It was awesome to get that first win," Smith said. "After he came home well in his last start (to finish third) at Avondale, we were reasonably confident with him heading into today. Kelsey rode him really well. She had a smile ear-to-ear after the race. It was awesome to share the win with her. We know Kelsey from up here when she was working for Kenny Rae."

SGP: Logan keen on consistent King Arthur

Australian-bred gelding King Arthur (I Am Invincible) will attempt to build on his solid record on the Polytrack when the four-yearold lines up in Sunday's Class 3 race over 1000 metres on the all-weather. A winner of five of 11 races on the surface, King Arthur has only finished out of the frame once in 11 runs on the Polytrack. "He's a beauty and so honest it's hard not to make him a favourite in the stable," his trainer Donna Logan said. "His race record speaks for itself – especially on the Polytrack – and while he has some weights to carry against some good horses this Sunday, 1000 metres suits and he will give his all."

348 for Galileo

Nearly a year has passed since Galileo's (Sadler's Wells) death but - as in life - Coolmore's sire phenomenon is still breaking records. That trend came to fruition yet again when he surpassed the great Danehill's (Danzig) 347 individual stakes winners when Thoughts Of June (3 f ex Discreet Marq by Discreet Cat) provided him with his 348th individual stakes winner when she held on well in the Cheshire Oaks (Listed, 1m 3.5f) at Chester yesterday. Trained by Aidan O'Brien, who was winning the race for a record seventh time, and ridden by Ryan Moore, the grey Galileo filly was sent to the front from the gates by her jockey and gradually wound up the gallop, kicking clear at the home turn and holding on well from the 5-4 favourite Above The Curve (American Pharoah) to win by a neck. Typewriter (Gleneagles) was a further three and three-quarter lengths back in third. "She's a really nice, uncomplicated filly," Moore said of the winner. "She was going an extra furlong and a half on easier ground and we thought it would suit her well. The step up in trip and the easier ground [were the key]. She's a big girl and she's getting better." The third foal out of the Grade 1-winning Discreet Cat (Forestry) mare Discreet Marq, Thoughts Of June, who carries the colours of her breeders Moyglare Stud, is a sister to the winner Florence Camille. Thoughts Of June is now as short as 10-1 for the Epsom Oaks (Gr 1, 1m 4f) on June 3.

349 for Galileo

There was a feature-race double on the Chester card yesterday for Aidan O'Brien and Ryan Moore, as well as the legendary Galileo, after Changingoftheguard (3 c ex Lady Lara by Excellent Art) ran out an impressive winner of the Chester Vase Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 4.5f). Providing the late Coolmore stallion Galileo with his 349th individual stakes winner, the colt made all, kicking clear on the turn for home, to register a comfortable six and a half length win over Godolphin's odds-on favourite New London (Dubawi). There was a further six lengths back to Savvy Victory (New Bay) in third. "He's similar to her (Thoughts Of June) and stays very well," Moore said. "Wayne [Lordan] liked him when he won at Dundalk last time and he's obviously improving. You never know which way they'll go from two to three, but he's going the right way now." Bred by Ben Sangster, Changingoftheguard is the third foal out of the Grade 2-winning Excellent Art (Pivotal) mare Lady Lara, who herself is out of a winning sister to the Listed winner Edinburgh Knight (Selkirk) and half-sister to Listed winner Nightbird (Night Shift). Changingoftheguard is as short as 8-1 with the northern hemisphere bookmakers for the Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) on June 2.

Currie posts memorable Sha Tin double after injury battle

lated after the latest twist in a rollercoaster debut Hong Kong season, Luke Currie enjoyed a remarkable Sha Tin double for John Size yesterday to seal an inspiring return from injury.

Likening victory aboard standby starter Touch Faith (Outreach) in the Class 5 Lau Fau Shan Handicap (1200m) to the emotion of major race success, Currie completed a 467-1 double for Size when Amazing Teens (Darci Brahma) prevailed in the Class 4 Mai Po Handicap (1650m).

"I feel like it's the biggest race I've ever won in my career, I'm that happy. To come back from injury and stay here, it's been really hard," Group 1-winning Currie said after Touch Faith's win, referencing a trial fall in February which left him hospitalised with a fractured vertebra.

Sidelined for 18 meetings after Pride Of Eight's (Pride Of Dubai) saddle slipped at Sha Tin on February 4, the 40-year-old's mishap contrasted vividly with the perfect start he had made to his Hong Kong stint with victory at his first ride on Miracle Victory (Astern) for David Hayes on January 30.

Out of action until April 10, Currie then contested 28 races after resuming – and filled the placings on only one occasion before taking the mount on Touch Faith, who was promoted into the field following the scratching of Lumen Baba (Zoffany).

"You need the luck. It's a starting block again for something that I hope gets bigger," Currie said before then combining with 11-time champion trainer Size and Amazing Teens.

"It's great. I had no expectations. Having a couple of rides for John Size, I was quite excited and hoped they would run well. One of them (Amazing Teens) wasn't drawn well (barrier 14) and the other (Touch Faith) was lucky to get a run.

"I definitely didn't expect to be walking home with two winners. I've been back riding for only a month – but a month is a long time in racing without a winner and it does help the mindset a lot. I will get out of bed a lot easier tomorrow morning."

An animated Size was clearly delighted

with Currie's display aboard Touch Faith.

"I know that he's (Currie) there and he rides 119lb and he's strong enough for a horse like this and I was looking to give him an opportunity to ride and when I had a look to see who didn't have a ride, I chose him," Size said.

"Well, he couldn't have ridden it any better. It was a beautiful ride. The horse jumped well and that helped but from then on, he had him travelling beautifully in the run. He looked like a winner a long way from home. The second horse (General Trump) might have just got out of stride and it favoured us.

"He (Touch Faith) hasn't shown any form on the dirt track but his track work is quite good on it, so when he got into the race and the gate (3) was very nice, we thought he might run well."

All three of Amazing Teens' wins have come on Sha Tin's all-weather surface.

Blake Shinn posted his first Hong Kong win in tandem with Tony Cruz when Brave Power (Declaration Of War) narrowly claimed the evening's sole contest on turf – the Class 5 Lam Tei Handicap (1400m).

"It's a real privilege, an honour to ride a winner for a legend of Hong Kong racing," Shinn said. "I haven't had a lot of rides for Mr Cruz – you could count them on one hand. He always greets me politely at trackwork, but rides are hard to come by.

"You have to work hard and ride well to earn your opportunities. It's nice to get a ride and reward him with a winner."

Cruz (53 wins) cemented his grip on third place in the trainers' championship behind Frankie Lor (68) and Size (67) with a treble, which was crowned by Berlin Tango's (Danisli) success in the Class 2 Yuen Long Handicap (1650m).

A Group 3 winner in the UK for Andrew Balding in 2020, the gelding had contested 15 races in Hong Kong without success until last night's breakthrough under a rails-hugging ride by Karis Teetan, who earlier combined with Cruz to win the first section of the Class 4 Nam Sang Wai Handicap (1200m) with veteran Lady First (Zacinto).

Paul O'Sullivan believes Spontaneous (Unencumbered) has "found his niche" after the gelding made a successful debut on dirt by snaring the second section of the Class 4 Nam Sang Wai Handicap (1200m) under Jerry Chau.

"I might have been a bit late in getting him onto the dirt," O'Sullivan said. "He trialled on it well and, even though he might have been flattered a bit by how fast they went in the first half of the race, he might have found his mojo."

The New Zealander savoured a double when Apache Pass (War Chant) landed the Class 3 Tin Shui Wai Handicap (1650m) before Ka Ying Master (Snitzel) shouldered top weight of 133lb in defying 11 rivals to clinch the Class 3 Tuen Mun Handicap (1200m) under Harry Bentley for Benno Yung.

IT'S IN THE BLOOD

Trevor Marshallsea's in-depth pedigree analysis

t's well known how success in breeding hinges on family connections. And now some such linkages - of the human kind - have led over several decades to a new stakes winner, in Adelaide last weekend.

Around 1980, then-emerging breeder David Hains looked north, way north, and imported the Danish Oaks winner Love Song (Warpath), to this day one of only five entries in the Australian Stud Book with "DEN" beside its name. The bold move led to one of the most successful female families in Australian history, the Scandinavia line that produced Black Caviar among many other stars.

In 2007, Wayne Pepper, bloodstock advisor to Paul Sweeney of Bellagio Lodge in the Gold Coast hinterland, struck out on a rare path far to the east. He acquired another Oaks winner, Loving New (Choctaw Ridge). She was only the third Brazilian import to Australia among a list that now numbers just eight, and she became the taproot that led to Saturday's Chairman's Stakes winner Jungle Magnate (Tarzino).

The SA Derby-bound three-year-old gelding comes from the Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr stable and has the former all over him. Price trained his sire Tarzino (Tavistock), Australia's Champion Three-Year-Old Colt of 2015-16, who's starting to fire with Group 3 winners Jungle Magnate and the twice Group 1-placed Gypsy Goddess from his first crop. Price also trained Jungle Magnate's dam The Love Of Money (Casino Prince), whose two bush runs suggest she's better on genes than ability.

You'll find common ancestors between Love Song and Loving New but the family ties in this case involve Pepper's sireline, from his late father Neville, who ran Kingston Farm for

"We were looking for mares for Bellagio all the time but it became harder to buy decent ones here at a good price," Pepper tells It's In The Blood. "But we'd bought a Chilean Group 1 winner out of the Easter broodmare sale a

little earlier, for a reasonable price, so I started looking around."

With help from Jane Henning's Pedigree Dynamics, Pepper and Sweeney tracked down Loving New, a then six-year-old. Not only had she won the Grande Premio Diana - aka the Brazilian Oaks - she'd claimed another Group 1 in the Cidade Jardim Grande Premio Barao de Piracicaba, (the 1,000 Guineas) over 1600 metres, and was Brazil's Champion Three-Year-Old Filly in 2004-05.

"I liked that she'd won an Oaks," Pepper says. "Oaks mares usually make good broodmares. And I remembered how when dad was running Kingston Farm they imported Love Song, a Danish Oaks winner and placed in a Scandinavian Oaks from back in the day.

"Brazil was a relatively new field to plough. And a lot of people question the South American form. But I was of the opinion that Group 1s are pretty hard to win no matter where they are. I'm pretty sure you couldn't just rock up in Brazil with any old thing and win a Group 1."

And some South Americans had shone

in Australia. Hussonet had come from Chile five years earlier. He'd sired multiple Group 1 winners in the Americas, had made a strong start in Australia, and was about to boom through Weekend Hussler. (He'd also sired Husson, who'd won three Group 1s in Argentina and would come to Australia to produce toptier winner Lucky Hussler, and Host, a triple-Chilean Group 1 winner brought to Australia to produce the Latino-sounding Eduardo.)

Such success suggests South American form can translate well to Australia. And Pepper had noted "quite a few Brazilians and Argentinian horses" had performed and produced well in the US as well.

Back then, Pepper inspected only photos from Henning of Loving New, and her new filly at foot, and considered her "a good type with good bone, and the foal was a good enough type".

"You couldn't buy a Group 1-winning mare here for less than a million. We paid US\$300,000 for her, and I thought that was good value. We were paying AU\$400,000 for Listed winners here."

After Loving New's arrival via the US, Pepper and Sweeney would later have more good news. That first foal of hers, Questing New (Romarin) also won the Grande Premio Barao de Piracicaba, in 2009. (She'd make it three generations of performers in that race by throwing Xic New (Refuse To Bend). She only managed second in the Piracicaba but won another three-year-old fillies' Group 1 instead, over 1800 metres).

Loving New started here by throwing Dark Matter (Stratum). Described by Pepper as "an absolute belter". Shipped to Singapore as a \$140,000 yearling, he won four times and was stakes placed there before winning the Meydan UAE 2,000 Guineas Trial, one of two wins he notched in Dubai, before a fruitful spell racing in Malaysia.

Loving New next threw Hinkler (Flying Spur), a Sunshine Coast maiden winner who was "too big", Pepper says, before a selling-off from Sweeney led to the Brazilian mare being bought by Patinack Farm, for \$250,000, in 2010.

"We bid on her, but we knew Patinack would keep going," says Pepper, now with Aquis Farm.

Patinack had sent Loving New to the Argentinian Husson and yielded First Crush, the dam's only stakes winner from eight named foals in Australia, taking the Listed Grafton Cup of 2018. Loving New then threw The Love Of Money, later bought for \$100,000 by Gerry Harvey upon Patinack's spectacular collapse, which is how she ended up at Westbury Farm, New Zealand. Jungle Magnate, her first living

foal, was bought by Price at Karaka for \$75,000.

Pepper says he's waiting for Loving New's only subsequent filly All Too Rio (All Too Hard) to bob up at a broodmare sale one day. In the meantime, he was "tickled pink" to see his Brazilian's descendant win black type last Saturday.

Loving New, meanwhile, was bought from the Patinack mess for \$180,000 by Jeremy Kessell's Wall Street Thoroughbreds. She's now 20, resides at Riversdale Farm in the Hunter, and - after five straight misses - is now in foal to Coolmore sire Churchill (Galileo).

"She's looking great for her age, and she's a beautiful mare to deal with,"Riversdale's Nick Hodges says. "If she copes well with everything she could go back in foal, but we're aware she's an older mare, and we'll look after her."

What perhaps grabs the eye most about Jungle Magnate's pedigree is the direct female line to French blue hen, La Troienne (Teddy, 1926), one of those supremely strong paths of mitochondrial DNA which comes through eight mares. The first was La Troienne's champion US daughter Black Helen (Black Toney, 1932), and the seventh, Loving New.

Westbury general manager Russell Warwick said one of the attractions in the mating was that Tarzino's damsire is Zabeel (Sir Tristram). He has Teddy seven times in his ancestry, and while La Troienne is absent, she's there three times in The Love Of Money's pedigree: once at the bottom, and via two daughters of Buckpasser in Casino Prince's bloodlines -

Sex Appeal and Spring Adieu. Zabeel has also worked well over Casino Prince's damsire Last Tycoon.

Attraction also lay in the six repetitions of British blue hen Selene (Chaucer, 1919) - who's twice in Zabeel's pedigree and once in Loving New's - and in the triplication of Secretariat's dam Somethingroyal.

Westbury's former outstanding but ill-fated stallion Gold Brose was in-bred to Somethingroyal's dam Imperatrice (Caruso). Somethingroyal appears three times in Jungle Magnate's pedigree. Her son Sir Gaylord is in the top half in Zabeel's sireline, and in the bottom through Casino Prince, and via Secretariat as the damsire of Loving New's sire Choctaw Ridge - a crucial factor since Secretariat was better as a broodmare sire than a sire.

"A lot of the things we've done with Tarzino genetically is try to replicate what's worked with Zabeel," Warwick says. "So we've concentrated on the La Troienne, and the Selene, and those sorts that have worked well.

"And we know a bit about in-breeding to Somethingroyal/Imperatrice thanks to Gold Brose. The opportunity to do it through Tarzino has returned here."

Warwick says Tarzino is "off to a great start" with his oldest progeny three, having accelerated in recent months to now have 15 winners from 45 runners. Jungle Magnate was his first winner - as a June two-year-old - which runs against predictions now being fulfilled by his autumn three-year-olds.

"If you'd asked what would you expect of Tarzino, you'd say he won't get two-year-olds, would need a bit of luck to get spring three-year-olds, but from Christmas on you'd expect his three-year-olds to come out of the woodwork. And that's what's happening," Warwick says.

"Now, we're seeing every week or two there's a good Tarzino coming out. He had a three-year-old (Tazimoto) win his maiden (at Ruakaka yesterday) over 1200 metres. The first thing you'd say is they shouldn't be doing that. That's very encouraging."


