

OTI seek juvenile success with Blue Diamond contenders

Elderberry and colt out of South African mare line-up at Sandown today, as Henderson targets mares from African country

The familiar white, navy and yellow-hooped silks of OTI Racing may be more renowned for their prowess in racing cup contenders and older horses that boast an element of stamina, but in each of today's Blue Diamond Preview races for the two-year-old colts and geldings (Listed, 1000m) and fillies (Gr 3, 1000m) at

Sandown, the prominent syndicators have strong contenders in both races for precocious juveniles, with each horse sourced from polar opposite ends of the buying spectrum.

In Altruist (Snitzel), who takes his place in the colts and geldings version of the Preview, OTI looked to the glitz and glamour of the Inglis Easter sale to make a rare foray into the yearling market and purchase the Arrowfield-consigned \$400,000 colt, the most expensive of only a handful of yearlings *Continued on page 3>>*

<< *Continued from page 2* the operation has ever signed for at public auction.

In Elderberry (Bolt D'Oro), the hope is the filly will replicate where OTI have found bargain success before - the paddocks of what was formerly Spendthrift Farm.

US-based operation Spendthrift has now disappeared from Australian shores altogether, and, while not yet lost entirely to Australian breeders, the Mick Price and Mick Kent Jnr-trained Altruist is from a waning influence of South African bloodstock, being out of five-time South African Grade 1 winner Carry On Alice (Captain Al).

"We were stimulated to look at [the colt] initially by some friends in South Africa, being out of a brilliant South African mare," OTI Racing's Terry Henderson told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"The long and short of it is that after Mick Price had a look at it, the [clients] in South Africa were quite keen on it, and I had a couple of guys here who were interested in a nice colt. So, we bought it and we thought it was pretty well priced at the time.

"It was slightly on the smaller side, quite a short little Sherman tank kind of thing. But he's actually grown into quite a nice horse."

Debutant Altruist is a \$15 chance for today's Preview, having jumped out impressively at Sandown a fortnight ago, tracking the leader to the line under a strong hold from Blake Shinn.


The colt's deep-rooted black type South African pedigree is a feature of what Henderson and OTI Racing are seeking out in a bid to find value in what has become a ferociously strong domestic market, targeting well credentialed fillies and mares to send north to be covered to southern hemisphere time.

OTI landed their first winner in South Africa only earlier this month, as Grade 1 winner Under Your Spell (Capetown Noir) landed a 1400-metre race at Kenilworth - a victory she may not have been afforded if Henderson had earned his way.

Under Your Spell was due to be taken north and to a date with superstar sire Frankel (Galileo), but for quarantine and export issues saw her grounded in the southern hemisphere.

For Henderson, the South African breed is one that is severely undervalued by the Australian and global bloodstock market, a factor that led him to securing both Under Your Spell and his promising two-year-old Altruist.



<< *Continued from page 3* Over the last decade, just 11 horses have been imported to Australia from South Africa, with issues surrounding an outbreak of African Horse Sickness in 2011, compounded by the recent Covid-19 pandemic, making the exportation of horses to Europe near impossible in the decade since.

The breed has found success in Australia through horses such as Group 1 winner In The Congo (Snitzel), who is out of South African Grade 1 winner Via Africa (Var).

“Some people are set against them, but that seems surprising to me because they’re usually quite tough horses,” Henderson said.

“There’s very much value in horses with South African pedigrees in the southern hemisphere.

“I spoke to Mike de Kock about this. He’s of the same view, he’s really looking forward to the day that he can get horses out of South Africa and get them to Australia, in far easier fashion than what we can get them there at the moment.

“They’re in the same hemisphere and we don’t have the same acclimatisation issues, and they’re pretty tough horses.

The way they train them is tough,

and they race on pretty good tracks so they’re firm track horses. There are a lot of aspects about buying horses out of South Africa that are positive.

“There’s no doubt the quality, more generally, is better in Australia or France and the UK and Ireland, but the good ones out of South Africa are good horses and we’re very open to buying more of the better credentialed mares over there.

“If we think a mare has the physical characteristics and a good race record to look like that it’s going to make a nice mare, and with a nice page too, we’ll certainly look at it seriously.”

Elderberry, meanwhile, is the \$6 second favourite for the fillies equivalent of the Blue Diamond Preview having won each of her two jump-outs under the care of Anthony and Sam Freedman.



Lady Laguna

She is by one-season Spendthrift shuttle sire Bolt D’Oro (Medaglia D’Oro), and the OTI team are hoping to replicate the success of Lady Laguna (Overshare), a two-time juvenile winner and placegetter in the Sweet Embrace Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) and Percy Sykes Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m), who was picked out of the paddock at Spendthrift a year prior to Elderberry.

“The filly has a completely different origin [to Altruist]. Spendthrift were looking to reduce their stock holdings, and they invited us out there to have a look at the horses in the paddock,” Henderson recalled.

“We’ve turned up with three or four of those horses that are going to be city class.

“I’m sorry that they’ve sold, and that opportunity has now gone by, but they were very much opportunistic buys. We bought several fillies, all with reasonable pages, and that’s how we ended up with Elderberry. We all went up there and basically bought them as if we were in a supermarket.”

The filly will be ridden by Ben Melham, the pair jumping from barrier five in the 13-runner race.

“She’s worked very well. Anthony said she was a nutcase when she first arrived down with them, but she’s got a lot of talent. She’s quite hard to assess, but she’s one of the faster two-year-olds we’ve got,” Henderson said.

“She had a jump-out down at Mornington where she came from behind and rounded them up.”

INGLIS

Named Nescaffier, the Matthew Dunn-trained son of Lope De Vega (Shamardal) won a trial with ease at the Beaudesert on January 16, and will be kept under wraps for a potential JJ Atkins Plate (Gr 1, 1600m) campaign. He was passed in as a yearling with a reserve of \$300,000.

"It looks a very impressive horse. He had his first trial last week and won easily. He'll have another jump-out next week and then it'll be off to the races

"He's bred a little more stoutly but looks like a horse, as many of these good middle distance horses do, that would sprint very well.

"We've avoided the glamorous sprinting two-year-old races because he'll only get better as we approach the end of the season."

The first foal out of the unraced Baileyya (Cacique), herself a half-sister to Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Fiorente (Monsun), there is a half-sister to Nescaffier by Pierro (Lonhro) that will sell under the Twin Hills Farm draft at this year's Inglis Easter yearling sale. The star-studded catalogue also features a full sister to Altruist within the Arrowfield draft.

Team Freedman to have four in Preview for the females



Anthony and Sam Freedman FREEDMAN RACING

Anthony and Sam Freedman will send four horses to contest the Blue Diamond Preview (F&M) (Gr 3, 1000m) at Sandown today, as they bid for a third consecutive Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) win, and their fourth in the last five years. Ode To Joy (Written Tycoon) will be the only Freedman horse with experience to tackle the Group 3 contest, having run to be third over 1000 metres at Flemington on her debut. Bolt D'Oro (Medaglia D'Oro) filly Elderberry; \$300,000 yearling De Sonic Boom (Spirit Of Boom), and Zoustar (Northern Meteor) filly Right To Party, will also join Ode To Joy in today's event. "We saw Ode To Joy and she was good on debut, she was a bit stiff and in hindsight we probably should've led on her and let her run along," Sam Freedman told Racing.com. "She'll benefit from that experience and she'll be a lot wiser for that. Of the first starters, I think Elderberry is the most natural-running two-year-old, she's pretty fast and she's trialled up very nicely twice. De Sonic Boom has had three trials - her first trial was good, her second trial wasn't as good, so we trialled her again, so she was very good at her third. Right To Party may end up the nicest of the four but she's

probably going to be a three-year-old type and she may well end up out to six or seven furlongs. She'll definitely be a horse to follow in the spring."

Freedmans also with duo for colts and geldings Preview

The Freedman training partnership will also have \$500,000 yearling Goodes (Written Tycoon) and Godolphin blueblood Fire Follower (Harry Angel) running for them in today's Blue Diamond Preview. "Goodes only trialled on Friday, so it's a quick turnaround, but he's had a good week so far and we'll continue to monitor him," Sam Freedman told Racing.com. "The plan is to take our chance from a good gate - he's a horse that's shown good speed and he's a natural two-year-old, so we think he'll be pretty professional up on the speed. Fire Follower is a little different and we'll probably let him balance up. His trials have been good and he's going to be a nice horse in the making but he's still a little bit green, so we'll let him balance up and hit the line."

Waterhouse looking for first Blue Diamond win

Hall of Fame trainer Gai Waterhouse is hoping that Aditi (Exceed And Excel) can take the next step towards becoming her first Blue Diamond Stakes winner when she runs in today's Blue Diamond Preview (F&M) at Sandown. The Rosemont Stud-owned daughter of Exceed And Excel (Danahill) has enjoyed a long spring break since finishing runner-up in the Maribyrnong Trial Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Flemington on October 1. "She [Gai Waterhouse] really got her way in the spring," Rosemont Stud principal Anthony Mithen told Racing.com. "After she ran second in the

Maribyrnong Trial at Flemington on debut, I wanted her to go to back [to Flemington] for the Ottawa Stakes over the carnival and I just thought Gai would be up for it. But she was adamant she needed the paddock and some spring grass. She said we could win an Ottawa Stakes in the spring, but then we wouldn't be able to win a Diamond or Slipper in the autumn because you are simply running out of time to get them ready. Gai staked her reputation a bit and all things are pretty positive. She's won both her jump-outs. We've booked Jamie Kah and we're all pretty excited. If we can run well there on Thursday, we will be in the picture somewhere."

Moody with five Preview runners

Pakenham-based trainer Peter Moody will be another trainer to have a full-frontal assault on today's two Blue Diamond Preview contests at Sandown, saddling-up five across both races. Amigo (Snitzel), a \$975,000 purchase, has drawn barrier six for his debut and will be ridden by Daniel Stackhouse. "He's a beautiful colt, he's trialled up really nicely and he's shown us really nice ability at home," assistant trainer Katherine Coleman told Racing.com. Fellow colts Capmala (Lonhro) and Scorsese (Written By) will join Amigo in the Blue Diamond Preview (C&G). "[Capmala] wanted to overdo things a little bit early days, but he's settling a lot better now, so he might be a colt that takes a little bit of racing before he figures out what it's all about, but he's shown us nice ability," Coleman said. "[Scorsese] had a really good education so far; he's trialled up nicely and shown us nice ability." The yard will also have well-bred filly Sensical (Zoustar), a \$950,000 yearling buy and the daughter of

Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) winner Karuta Queen (Not A Single Doubt), and fellow Zoustar filly Ginger 'N' Pink running in the Blue Diamond Preview (F&M). "[Sensical has] proven to be pretty versatile in her jump-outs so far," Coleman said. "I think whatever she does early on in her career, she's probably going to improve upon later down the track. [Ginger 'N' Pink's] a lovely filly that's improved as we've gone deeper into the preparation and she's developed and strengthened up as we've gone along and each gallop, she's got better and better."

Beriman's potential 'pleasant' problem

Cranbourne-based trainer Jackie Beriman is hoping that her filly Furoshhi (Street Boss) can show enough to warrant a spot in the Blue Diamond Stakes when she tackles today's Blue Diamond Preview (F&M) at Sandown. The juvenile daughter of Street Boss (Street Cry) has made a sole start so far in her career, running to be second in a 1000-metre contest on Cranbourne Cup Day behind Remedies (Sepoy). "She's not nominated for [the Blue Diamond Stakes]. If she showed enough to say we'd go down that path, we would look at paying the late fee," Beriman told Racing.com. "She's a really nice horse. Not that big but she's quite strong. She's the ultimate professional filly to train. There's a lot of unknowns there - horses from big stables. She's a nice filly and even if she could run a place, it's a big thing for a small stable like ours. A Stakes placing would be a big thing for us. We've lost some nice, young horses to bigger trainers and hopefully she can do something for us to get noticed."

Stokes with Group 1 goals for duo

Three-year-old pair Climbing Star (Zoustar) and Watadeel (Dundeel) will be set Group 1 targets by their trainer Phillip Stokes, as they kick off their autumn campaigns in the Manfred Stakes (Gr 3, 1300m) at Sandown today. A maiden winner on debut, Climbing Star then went on to finish second in the Fillies Classic (Gr 2, 1600m) at Moonee Valley on just her second start. "I've always had time for her," Stokes told Racing.com. "She was just needing

Morningside celebrate first winner off the farm

Morningside Stud, managed by Will Rowsthorn, landed the first winner off the new set up on the property from a horse the farm had bred, reared and sold when Fistoffury (Dundeel) won the two-year-old maiden at Pakenham yesterday evening.

Morningside was rebranded following the sale of sister property Woodside Park, previously owned by Will's father, Mark, with a focus on boutique mares and breeding.

Under its new guise, the Nagambie-based farm consigned its first draft at the Inglis Melbourne Premier Sale last year, from which Fistoffury was sold to Hawkes Racing for \$150,000, with the colt by Dundeel (High Chaparral) now racing in the colours of high profile owner Rupert Legh.

"We're very excited. After the recent months we've had here down in Victoria, the whole area suffering some pretty bad floods, it's nice to get a two-year-old winner at this stage in the season. For us, it's just so special, we really enjoyed that," Will Rowsthorn told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"When we had Woodside, we were a fairly big player in Victoria with Written Tycoon and five or six stallions at the farm.

We changed direction a few years ago and decided to focus on the mare side of it and aim at the top end. I think this is just a sign of where we want to go.

"Fistoffury was consigned under the first Morningside draft that we presented and heading towards the Melbourne Premier sale again this year is pretty exciting."

Morningside will offer 12 yearlings at this year's Inglis Premier Yearling Sale, including two colts by Dundeel, two fillies and a colt by Written Tycoon (Iglesia), as well as two colts by Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible).

"It's a nice group of horses that are all in Book 1 and very even and it's great to sell two horses by Dundeel off the back of today's win," Rowsthorn said.

"The aim for Morningside is to be in that top 20 per cent of any sale we go to and this is a step in the right direction.

"We've got roughly 30-35 mares. We want to get to around that 40 mares mark but we're trying to buy at the top end, so it will take time before we get there. We've got some big name mares whose progeny will get to the sales and command attention."

Among the mares on the farm is \$1 million buy Rubisaki (Rubick), who is in foal to Written Tycoon for her first cover, and Ludisia (Frankel), a \$650,000 Inglis Chairman's buy, who produced a filly foal by Kingman (Invincible Spirit).

to get on top of the ground. To go from winning a maiden to running second in a Group 2 is a big effort, so she's got good ability and I'm really looking forward to this prep. She's come back in super order. She's stronger and she's had a couple of trials leading into this and we're really happy with her. We haven't got her fully screwed down or anything, we're hoping to get her to the Guineas. This is a starting point, she'll be finishing it off well, then she'll have another run into the Guineas." Watadeel could also be heading for the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and has not been seen since running home well to grab fourth in the Carbine Club Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Flemington on October 29. "He's a really nice horse," Stokes said. "He will be running on late again; I think he's going to be better once he gets further up in trip, and he could potentially be a Derby horse in the making. Does he go to South Australia? We'll see, but we'll aim him towards the Guineas, he's going well."

Starry Legend on point for Sandown test

Starry Legend (Zoustar) will make his second start for the Archie Alexander stable when he lines up in the W J Adams Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Sandown today. One of six horses that Alexander has in training for Hong Kong owner Bon Ho, the four-year-old finished third in a Benchmark 84 contest over 1000 metres on his debut for the yard, following a move from US trainer John Sadler. "The other day it didn't help that he had Najem Suhail annoy him, sitting at his girth," Alexander said. "If he didn't have him there, he might have settled a bit better, but he's going really well. It's unfortunate and it's probably just the way he is, but if he could just learn to relax a little bit more, I think he would be able to offer a little bit more at the end. I think the main problem is his barrier speed is so good. I don't think the first couple of hundred metres is the problem. He just jumps so well and he's quick away, whereas others take warming up. We're not giving up on him by any token as he's run and won some good races by leading, so you don't want to change it up too much. So, I think we'll leave him alone for now, but it would be nice if he relaxed a bit more."

Pal D'Oro the best of Maher's chances

The in-form Pal D'Oro (Medaglia D'Oro) will lead a three-pronged attack by Ciaron Maher and David Eustace in today's John Dillon Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Sandown. The five-year-old has won two of his last three outings and is a \$4.20 chance to make it three from four today. "He doesn't show you much on the track at all, but race day's where it counts," Maher told Racing.com. "He seems to be in super order, hard fit, and he'll run a good race." The training partnership will also have Normandy Bridge (Le Havre) and Subconscious (Tapit) joining Pal D'Oro, with the former - a French import - making his first start for close to a year and only second in Australia. "Normandy Bridge, I've got a lot of time for that horse," Maher said. "He's had a long time off, he'll improve off the run, probably wants a bit of cut in the ground, but he's a lovely horse. He was gelded and just needed a bit of time. He had a small injury that we just had to wait for, but he seems in good order now and he trialled up well." Maher is expecting an improved effort from Subconscious after his first-up tenth in the Chester Manifold Stakes (Listed, 1400m). "Subconscious will improve a lot condition-wise and is still very much on the up, will run an improved race but probably wants this run as well," he said.

Silver Tycoon to run at Sandown

Having spent many weeks attempting to prevent Silver Tycoon's (Fighting Sun) slow barrier trait, Nathan Dunn watched on as the now four-year-old once again made a slow start, doing extremely well to finish sixth, beaten just under four lengths, on his debut outing over 1400 metres at Cranbourne. "I thought he had ability, but he had had four jump-outs in five weeks and I thought he needed the paddock. He then made up 12 lengths and you don't do that at Cranbourne," Dunn told Racing.com. Since that outing, Silver Tycoon has won three of his next four races, including his last two, and will be bidding for the hat-trick when he tackles a 2400-metre handicap at Sandown today. "He's

been a surprise packet. He's doing it through ability, not his race smarts. He's still coasting, not savaging the line or fully lengthening. He hasn't worked out his killer punch," Dunn said. "We may as well test the waters and see whether we are a 2400-metre horse, maybe even a 3200-metre horse."

Outlandos on seven-day back-up

Having finished half-a-length behind winner Sky Lab (Real Impact) in the Magic Millions Trophy (2200m) at the Gold Coast last Thursday, John Sargent expects Outlandos (Dissident) to enjoy a seven-day back-up as he tackles today's Australia Day Cup (Listed, 2200m) at Warwick Farm, a race that has been dropped back 200 metres in trip. "We were finishing very strongly [in the Magic Millions Trophy], obviously, and if it had stayed at that distance, he would have been hard to beat," Sargent said. "It's a good race for him every year and I knew he'd run well. I saw this race and these older stayers tend to back up very well. He's done very well and I think he has improved a bit since his last run. He should run a very nice race and a bit further will suit him."

King's Gambit to resume in Canonbury

Current \$6 Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) market leader King's Gambit (I Am Invincible) will make a first appearance since his debut win in October's Debutante Stakes (Listed, 1000m), when he lines up in Saturday's Canonbury Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Rosehill. "He's in good shape. He trialled well and we've been happy with his work since the trial," co-trainer Peter Snowden said. "He is meeting, not a big field, but what looks a pretty slick field. There are some sharp horses there, so we will get a good read on where he's at, at the moment and work out where best to go with him." The son of I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) will be ridden by James McDonald and is the \$1.40 favourite. "The really good ones have a demeanour to match their ability," Snowden said. "They're sensible, they're tractable, they're good to work with and that's why you can get the best out of them. This fellow, so far he is ticking those boxes."

Forbidden Love ready to find best form

Randwick-based trainer Michael Freedman is hoping that star mare Forbidden Love (All Too Hard) can replicate previous seasons by saving her best efforts until the autumn. The five-year-old's only placing in the spring of 2021 came when third in The Invitation (1400m), before she managed to score three wins the following autumn, including the Canterbury Stakes (Gr 1, 1300m) and George Ryder Stakes (Gr 1, 1500m) last March. Having not placed in five starts this spring, the daughter of All Too Hard (Casino Prince) will aim to turn her form around when tackling Saturday's Expressway Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Rosehill. "Trials are one thing and races can be very different, but it was encouraging to see her do it and want to do it," Freedman said. "The previous year she had a bit of an indifferent spring and then came out and really found her form in the autumn. We're hoping that is going to be the same scenario this time around." Forbidden Love will be aiming to go one better than her second to Overpass (Vancouver) in the corresponding race 12 months ago and is the \$2.60 second favourite behind Godolphin colt Golden Mile (Astern). "Golden Mile is the boom young horse but they've got to be able to come back and show they can do it at weight-for-age, as opposed to set weights against their own age groups," Freedman said. "But he is obviously a very promising young horse and he will be the testing material."

Golden Slipper placegetter to debut for new stable

Nick Ryan is hoping that his latest stable acquisition, Mamaragan (Wandjina), can regain the winning thread when he makes his debut for the Randwick-based yard at Moonee Valley on Saturday. The now five-year-old, who also finished third in the 2020 Golden Slipper Stakes, has not scored since making a winning debut in the Skyline Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m). Ryan is hopeful a familiar face in rider Blake Shinn can give him every chance of getting back into the winners' enclosure this weekend. "Blake's known him before we got him and he's done a lot of work on him this prep and seems to think

he's going well, but he is certainly going to improve from the run," Ryan told Racing.com. "He is very low-rated for a horse of his quality, so if we can get him back anywhere near that form, we might have a bit of fun going through his grades again. We are going to go to the races still learning a bit about him, his jump-outs have been good and he is a big, grouse horse who worked well here this morning but had a big blow, so I think he is going to improve. Mind you he is a horse with Group ability running in a Benchmark 70, so who knows?"

Dunkel eyes Launceston Guineas

Dunkel (Dundeel) began a trip to Tasmania on Tuesday evening as his trainer Patrick Payne prepares him for tomorrow's Launceston Guineas (Listed, 2100m). Having ridden the son of Dundeel (High Chaparral) in all four of his outings, including an impressive last-start success, Harry Coffey will again be onboard as the three-year-old bids to become the first Victorian-trained horse to win the Listed contest since Darren Weir's Wolfendale (Astronomer Royal) in 2018. "It looks a nice race for him and set weights looks ideal," Payne told Racing.com. "I like him, we can't get carried away being off-season, but what I do like is he is very strong the last 100 metres and it's hard to find a horse like that. I always thought early doors the Tassie Derby, but the Guineas he is ideally weighted and I reckon Launceston is a lovely layout of a track so we are keen to get down there."

All-Star Mile receives 81 nominations

A total of 81 horses have been nominated for the fifth edition of the All-Star Mile (1600m), set to be run at Moonee Valley on March 18. Entries for the \$5 million race closed yesterday, while late nominations, incurring a \$2500 fee, can be made until Monday. Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Gold Trip (Outstrip), owned by 2021 winners Australia Bloodstock, is among the 11 horses entered from the Ciaran Maher and David Eustace stable; while Ben and J D Hayes have six entries, headed by Mr Brightside (Bullbars), and Peter Moody has

five, including I Wish I Win (Savabeel) and Chain Of Lightning (Fighting Sun). Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr have I'm Thunderstruck (Shocking) heading up a trio of entries, while Tuvalu (Kermadec) is Lindsey Smith's sole representative. Last year's winner Zaaki (Leroidesanimaux) is again nominated along with Annabel Neasham-trained stablemates Mo'Unga (Savabeel), Laws Of Indices (Power) and My Oberon (Dubawi); while the Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained Alligator Blood (All Too Hard), who finished tenth in 2020 when trained by David Vandyke, will once again attempt to make the race. New Zealand's two entries are Group 1 winner La Crique (Vadamos) and Aegon (Sacred Falls).

Stafford's Lad on Adelaide Cup trail

Dan Morton is confident that his stayer Stafford's Lad (Demerit) can be a real contender in this year's Adelaide Cup (Gr 2, 3200m), after the durable son of Demerit (Lonhro) finished runner-up behind Buster Bash (Trade Fair) in the Perth Cup (Gr 2, 2400m) earlier this month. "He will go around in Perth on Saturday week to give his legs a run around," Morton told The Races WA. "It will be a short and sharp campaign. He'll then run in the Lord Reims Stakes at Morphettville in February. That race is two weeks before the Adelaide Cup on March 13. He's a ripper this bloke and I'm super keen to see him run over 3200 metres. I think he's a genuine stayer and I wouldn't be going over there to Adelaide for nothing."

Stablehand outed for ten years

Former stablehand Shane Gardiner has been banned for ten years after Racing Victoria stewards found he had been committing 'corrupt and fraudulent actions'. The charges date back to June 2020 where, on three occasions, Gardiner was found to sell shares in racehorses that he had no ownership interests in. Gardiner confessed to the fraudulent sales in March 2022, saying he needed the money to fund a gambling addiction, but stewards have been unable to further contact Gardiner since July 2022.

Fireburn nominated for All-Star Mile

Last year's champion two-year-old Fireburn (Rebel Dane) has been given a nomination for the All-Star Mile by her trainer Gary Portelli. The Golden Slipper Stakes winner won five of her seven starts in her two-year-old campaign, but failed to win in three outings in the spring, with her best effort being a fourth-placed finish in the Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m). "She trials at Warwick Farm on January 30 and will kick off her preparation in the Light Fingers Stakes at Randwick over 1200 metres on February 11," Portelli told Racing.com. "It will depend on how she comes up. We've all got to dream and we've got to qualify and be good enough. She'll tell us first-up how she's going. If we look like we're a chance to get there, we'll work out a program to get there, but for the moment I'm concerned about winning first-up and I'll take it from there. My job is to have her in good order. There's a lot of prize-money on offer so it will be a matter of the best pathway for her."

Ringmaster tops Inglis Digital January Late Sale

Three-year-old gelding Ringmaster (Zoustar) became the equal-third most expensive racehorse ever sold via Inglis Digital as he topped the Inglis Digital January (Late) Sale yesterday. Offered by Newgate Farm and partners, the Michael Freedman-trained son of Zoustar will next race in Hong Kong after selling to CF Lee, a client of Inglis' Hong Kong representative Alan Ho, for \$435,000. Only Ranch Hand (Fastnet Rock) (\$600,000) and Coastwatch (Fastnet Rock) (\$500,000) have sold for more in the racehorses' section of the Inglis Digital Platform. "My client is yet to decide on a trainer, we are still in discussions there, but he's a lovely horse who I'm sure will be a success up here in Hong Kong," Ho said. "He's an exciting acquisition and we're thrilled to get him. The Hong Kong owners will go wherever there are good horses to buy and there are always good horses on Inglis Digital, every sale. As Michael Freedman said, this horse was unlucky to get some wet tracks in the spring which hurt his chances but on firm tracks in Hong Kong, I expect he will be very popular." A book of strong results took the Inglis

Digital January (Late) Sale gross to \$3,354,850. Entries for the February (Early) Sale are now open and will remain so until next Wednesday, February 1. Already confirmed for the sale is the John O'Shea-trained, stakes-winning four-year-old Bend The Knee (Snitzel). To enter, click [here](#).

The late Sir Patrick Hogan will be honoured by New Zealand Bloodstock at the opening of the 97th National Yearling Sales Series with a commemorative ceremony dedicated to the legendary studmaster, breeder, racehorse owner and devoted family man. NZB have invited all buyers, vendors, media and general public to attend the tribute, set to be held at 10:45am on Sunday in the sale auditorium, immediately before the commencement of selling on Day One of Book 1. The commemoration will also be broadcast live to viewers around the globe, straight after the Karaka 2023 Day One Preview Show, streamed from 10:15am. Selling will begin in its usual time slot at 11am after the tribute.

Rogerson happy with Sharp 'N' Smart

Graeme Rogerson feels that three-year-old Sharp 'N' Smart (Redwood) can serve it up to his older rivals when he tackles the Thorndon Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at Trentham on Saturday. The son of Redwood (High Chaparral) won the Gloaming Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) and Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) in Sydney, before being spelled following a runner-up effort in the Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m). "He's been working very well and it's a good field and a big ask first-up against all those proven milers, but I think class will take him a long way," Rogerson said. "He's developed and is stronger now. It will be interesting and if he can beat La Crique I'll be very happy. He's going to have to give her a start and a beating at a mile, but he's got to have a run somewhere to get him ready for a middle distance." Sharp 'N' Smart will again face his elders when lining up in the Herbie Dyke Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), before a

crack at the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) and a return to Australia. "He will be having five races and, as long as everything goes right, our aim is to run in the AJC Derby and back him up in the Queen Elizabeth [Stakes]," Rogerson said. "Hopefully, we will be going back to Melbourne in the spring with him for the Cups."

Desert Gold Stakes pair for Bary

Hawke's Bay-based trainer John Bary will saddle-up both Best Seller (Wrote) and Sequoia Star (Redwood) in Saturday's Desert Gold Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) in the hope that they can prove themselves to be New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) contenders. Best Seller ran to be third first-up over 1200 metres at the same track earlier this month and Bary is expecting to see plenty of improvement. "The run the other day was just okay, but the track was very sticky," Bary said. "Speaking with Sam Spratt and Jonathan Riddell afterwards, they felt it was probably closer to a Heavy 8, they just couldn't get their feet out. I had been a bit light on her and she went in on one exhibition gallop. I gave her an extra gallop on Saturday at home because she has been doing really well. She was on the course proper again on Tuesday just to keep it up, and it was really top-notch work. She is really well and ready to rumble." Bary also has Oaks plans for Sequoia Star, even if this weekend's trip may be on the short side. "She has done nothing wrong and is probably looking for 2000 metres-plus right now. She is bred for that. Blinkers go back on, she had them on when she won," he said. "The next two runs were just educating her more and keeping her up to the mark. They have been nice runs against older horses. I think over the mile they might be a bit sharp for her. Get her to 2000 metres and she is one that will definitely see out 2400 metres, and her main aim is the Oaks."

ASIA

SGP: Lim hoping for more success

While trainer Richard Lim already has two winners under his belt in the new racing season, he is hoping to keep the momentum going on Saturday. Last-start winner Faithful Leader

(Super One) spearheads another 12 horses for Lim in the 12-race Kranji meeting on Saturday, and he hopes that the same horse and jockey combination could get the job done again in the \$50,000 Class 4 race over 1000 metres. "I thought he won well last start and he looks a good chance again," Lim said. "[Apprentice jockey] Akmazani [Mazuki] rode him well, so there's no reason not to put him back on. The

[four-kilogram] claim will help again and he's working well, so he's definitely one of my better chances." Lim also has two maidens that should be competitive, Groovy (Swiss Ace) in the \$75,000 Restricted Maiden Division 1 race over 1200 metres and King's Gambit (Capitalist) in the \$20,000 Maiden race over 1600 metres, but suggests the pair will both improve with racing. "Groovy has a bit to learn," he said. "He placed

on debut over 1200 metres and was competitive at his last start but I think he will need longer to win. Same for King's Gambit. He's still learning a lot at trackwork and has more to offer. He's very nervous so I have to put earmuffs on this week - that might help - and it's not a strong field. [Jockey] Ronnie [Stewart] will ride them both. He's an experienced rider and that will help them while they are learning."

KARAKA SIX OF THE BEST

Here, in lot order, is a look at some of the hot lots at this year's Karaka Yearling Sale.

Lot 40

B f - Dundee - Ardeche

The Eight Carat (Pieces Of Eight) family is one of New Zealand's most famous, with - at last count - at least 35 stakes-winners and 89 stakes wins coming from descendants of the great mare, Verry Elleegant (Zed) and Melody Belle (Commands) among them.

And this filly from Cambridge Stud's 40-strong draft presents the chance for buyers to tap into the family in a powerful way, with New Zealand's Broodmare of the Year in 1995-96-97 coming in straight along the female line, as the fifth dam.

Out of the stakes-placed Ardeche (Dehere), and by surging sire Dundee (High Chaparral), the filly is a three-quarter sister to Mongolian Marshal (High Chaparral), a Group 3 winner in New Zealand and Listed victor in Melbourne.

Second dam Diamond Like (Danehill) won at Listed level and produced two stakes winners in Forever Loved (High Chaparral) and Zephyron (Zabeel), while third dam was the superb Cambridge product Tristalove (Sir Tristram), joint top filly of the 1993-94 Australasian 3YO Classification, who won two Group 1s in the Sires Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) and Australasian Oaks (Gr 1, 2000m).

"This is a great opportunity for someone looking to buy into the Eight Carat family," says Cambridge's head of sales and nominations Scott Calder.

"She's a three-quarter sister to a Group 3 winner, and bred on the same cross as Castelvechio, in Dundee over a Dehere mare.

"So she's a stand-out from a pedigree aspect and just a great type, with a huge amount of quality about her; not overly big, but with a really good depth of girth. So, people might wonder why we're selling her! But we've been

lucky enough to keep the last two daughters of Ardeche, so we're happy to give someone else the opportunity.

"A lot of people have been seeing the benefits of buying a well-bred filly, from the residual aspect, and this is a great chance in that regard. One of the themes of the Magic Millions sale was that, especially for syndicators, people can buy a filly and be confident that regardless of what they do on the track, they can have great value as broodmares later on. And of course, if you do get a good one, their value can go through the roof."

Lot 337

B c - Super Seth - Mary d'Or

Renowned breeder Lib Petagna's Elsdon Park has made great strides since setting up on the former Valachi Downs property last year. They're excited about their 16-lot draft in Book 1, and especially this strapping colt by Caulfield Guineas winner Super Seth (Dundeel).

He's from a strong French family, out of a dual stakes-placed mare in Mary d'Or

(Verglas), a full-sister to Stormy River, winner of four stakes races to 1600 metres including a Group 1, and a three-quarter sibling to Silverware (Silver Frost), winner of five stakes races including at the top tier.

The grey Mary d'Or has had six winners from six to race, including Australian-bred

pair Frosted Gold (All Too Hard), a triple stakes-winner in South Africa up to Group 2, and Sunshine Mighty (Murtajill), a Listed winner in Macau.

This late-August colt is set to continue the buzz around Waikato Stud's first-season sire Super Seth,

whose seven Magic Millions lots sold at an average of \$231,000, with a peak of \$450,000.

While any first-season sire comes with the

unknown quantity tag, Super Seth's ability to leave his mark has impressed many seasoned judges.

"You definitely want to see a first-season sire stamp their stock," Elsdon's general manager Kerrie Cox says. "When they do, it's like you see the strength of the genetic qualities coming through, rather than have a sire whose stock might be a bit all over the place. You look at the Savabeels - they're all peas in a pod, plus they can run well as well.

"Super Seth has certainly done it with his first crop. Anyone you talk to says they can pick the Super Seths from a mile away: big, strong imposing types, and very forward.

"And this colt is certainly a typical Super Seth. He's strong, very muscular, and looks like he would get up and go nice and early. He's got a beautiful temperament, and he's just a very striking, good-looking horse, and one who's been very nice all the way through. Some yearlings can go through a bit of a rough stage, but he's been on the up all the way along."

Lot 424

B f - Proisir - Piazza

Tough six-year-old gelding Riodini (Proisir) has been one of the top handful of trans-Tasman success stories of recent years. After a Group 3 win and Group 1 placing at home, the gelding joined the Waterhouse-Bott team in 2020 to become a million-dollar winner, with two Group 1 placings, followed by his breakthrough victory in the \$1m The Gong (1600m) at Kembla Grange last November.

Now, Rich Hill Stud offers his three-quarter sister, a filly who's struck the farm's owner John Thompson as a stand-out specimen.

She's by the stud's NZ general sires' table runaway leader, Proisir - sire of outstanding sprinter Levante and her burgeoning stablemate and winner of November's New Zealand 1000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), Legarto, among others - the filly has been catching the eye of many keen judges at Karaka this week.

"She's very much in the mould of the good Proisir fillies like Levante and Legato - strong bodied, they all have that very quick look about them, and the same colouring as well," Thompson says.

"And this one is just a beautifully balanced filly, very correct, a nice, medium-sized type, and for a filly born on November 14, it's quite amazing how well-developed she is. But perhaps the thing that most stands out is her great attitude. She's got great intelligence about her, she's taken everything in her stride, and she's settled into things so well at the sales complex."

The filly has the potential to succeed over some distance, with her dam Piazza, a four-time winner up to 2000 metres, being by Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) winner Sir Percy. Piazza herself is a full sister to Hawke's Bay Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m) winner Sir Andrew, with their four-time winning dam Biennale (Royal Academy) also throwing three-time winner Giardini (Heartbreak), dam of Riadini.

Lot 505

Br c - Per Incanto - Sharvasti

Little Avondale's "Italian Stallion" Per Incanto (Street Cry) continues to excel, as another three winners in Hong Kong this week attest - and the stud has high hopes that this colt will be another of his star performers.

Per Incanto, American-bred, but having shone on the tracks of Italy, has had his name put up in lights by a host of sprinter-milers recently, including last year's dual Flemington 1200-metres Group 1 winner Roch 'N' Horse, and star Sydney sprinter Lost And Running.

This Danehill-free colt brings the promise of extra distance, being out of Avondale

Gold Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Sharvasti (Montjeu). Some mightn't remember that cup win, coming as it did in 2006, by a dual Group 1-placed mare born in 2002. But the fact she's now 20 is definitely no cause for concern, according to Little Avondale's Sam Williams.

"It's worth remembering that from Per Incanto's first crop, his two star-yearlings at Karaka were out of mares who had them at age 19 in Cent From Heaven, and at 22 in Sound Lover," Williams says.

Cent From Heaven's (Centaine) colt was Dal Cielo, who won the ARC Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), and Sound Lover's (Stylish Century) was Magnum, an NZ Listed winner who became a top performer in Singapore, with four wins and three Singapore Listed placings.

"They were both really nice horses out of older mares," Williams says. "I just think it shows that Per Incanto is such a versatile, pre-potent stallion who manages to upgrade mares. But also, I don't believe in the old mare syndrome. Some good mares are always good mares.

"And I think this colt is superior to those two. He's a magnificent horse; he's got a great walk, great attitude, fantastic muscle definition, and he just looks like a racehorse. He's one of my favourites and one of the obvious lots of the sale."

Lot 515

B f - Tazzino - Showileo

It's a basic rule of thumb: New Zealanders go to Australia for their speed, while Australians cross the Tasman for stamina.

This filly looks the archetypal example from the latter category: a daughter of a Galileo (Sadler's Wells) mare who has the potential to continue VRC Derby (Gr 1, 2500) winner Tazzino's (Tavistock) early knack of siring Classic horses, according to Westbury Stud's Russell Warwick.

"She looks an Oaks filly through-and-through," Warwick says. "Tazzino's had a South Australian Derby winner (Jungle Magnate) and a Queensland Oaks winner (Gypsy Goddess) from his first two crops, and this filly looks like she'll be in that sort of mould when she becomes a three-year-old.

"She's got a lovely head on her, she's athletic, and for those who know how to train a staying filly - and to look after them, and visualise what they're going to be like when they're three - she's a great specimen.

"A lot of Australian trainers are not coming here to buy speed horses. They want nice horses who can get up and run a trip, hopefully for a Derby or an Oaks. This filly's pedigree and her type suggest she can do that."

The filly is from an immensely strong female family with a distinct staying bent. Dam Showileo, by the all-time-great Galileo, was only placed, but has produced four winners from five foals to race including Showbeel (Savabeel), winner of Trentham's Desert Gold Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m).

And the filly's second dam was the outstanding Showella (Lord Ballina), another South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner who also took the New Zealand Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), and was her home country's Champion Older Female Stayer of 1999-2000, and Australia's Champion Older Horse (International) that season. She also passed

on her abilities to three stakes-winners in Showcause (Giant's Causeway), Safwan (Encosta Da Lago) and Safwa (Danehill).

The twice stakes-placed Style By Design is out of the High Chaparral (Sadler's Wells) mare Chaparella, an eight-time winner, including

in two NZ Listed events who's also thrown a Wanganui Listed-winner in Riva Capri (Artlante).

While Chittick is proud of "an extremely even" 60-lot draft from Waikato this year, the plentiful early lookers have backed his contention that this filly is a standout.

"She's just a lovely, very athletic, strong Savabeel filly," he says. "We've all seen plenty of good Savabeel fillies, and good racehorses, and she's got everything that they've got. She totally fills the eye, as one of those dark horses who looks fast and looks a racehorse."

The filly is bred on the same Savabeel-Iffraaj cross as the Listed winner and dual Group 1-placed Te Akau gelding

Brando, and boasts a dual-female 4Sx4D cross of the great Nureyev (Zamazaan).

Queensland provides Magic Millions show-stealers

It could not have been a more Queensland result to the recent Magic Millions 2YO race on the Gold Coast, with a ladies' syndicate put together by Black Soil Bloodstock enjoying their moment in the sun with Skirt The Law (Better Than Ready).

Former South Sydney Rabbitohs player Brian Siemsen and Eureka Stud's Harry McAlpine are the force behind Black Soil Bloodstock, a syndication group named in honour of their proud connection to the fertile dirt that the Darling Downs is famous for.

"It's a bit of a tribute to the black soil of

the Darling Downs where Eureka is, and Brian grew up in Toowoomba and is very much a Toowoomba boy at heart," Harry McAlpine explained.

Siemsen has been great mates with trainer Tony Gollan since he was 15 and that friendship eventually led him to investing in racehorses.

He could not have asked for a better start to that experience with the first two horses he ever owned being multiple stakes winner Temple Of Boom (Piccolo) and Spirit Of Boom (Sequalo).

"Tony had been to Sydney and he went back home to train and picked a horse out of the sales called Temple Of Boom and the second horse he found us was Spirit Of Boom. I was pretty hooked after them," said Siemsen.

Spirit Of Boom's journey back to Eureka Stud where he was born, to stand as their headline stallion, brought Siemsen, a majority shareholder in the horse at the time, and McAlpine together.

Four years ago, they decided to form Black Soil Bloodstock.

"[Brian] wanted to buy mares to go to Spirit and so we set up a partnership company. We target nice fillies that can make nice racehorses and have a page to breed from later on," said McAlpine.

Highly respected bloodstock agent John Foote and Tony Gollan lead their sales selection process.

"John is a legend and an unsung one. He doesn't seek applause and does his work with no fuss. Tony is a very driven trainer and he's very competitive. He thrives on competition."

Since April 2020, Black Soil Bloodstock has had 230 runners and won seven stakes races with the Magic Millions 2YO their crowning glory.

"It's exceeded all expectations. We have a lot of good people around that help. Good farms and advice and Tony's a good judge and I couldn't ask for a better partner than Harry," said Siemsen.

The 44-year-old has a background as a builder engineer and currently runs an insurance technology business and at the rate Black Soil is growing, that might all change.

"The side hustle is quickly turning into our main hustle. Other business has helped feed the passion of what we are doing with bloodstock," he said.

Siemsen's wife Brooke shares in the

ownership of Skirt The Law, along with Jane McAlpine and 18 other ladies.

"The joke amongst us lads - behind every good ladies' syndicate is a bunch of excited husbands. Three starts and \$1.6 million later, the girls have absolutely wiped the floor."

Skirt The Law is now being aimed at the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m).

"To have a runner is exciting and to have a live chance. She's certainly taken us on a ride and we are excited to see what happens over the next couple of weeks."

Whatever she does from here will certainly serve the profile and future of Black Soil Bloodstock well and fly the flag for all parochial Queenslanders.


