Zulfiqar excels as Godolphin enhance autumn armoury

Two-year-old being set for the Blue Diamond while Aft Cabin cements favouritism for Randwick Guineas with Eskimo Prince win

Godolphin have claimed the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in two of the last four editions of the race and the breeding and racing goliath enhanced their armoury for this month's juvenile Group 1 contest when Zulfiqar (2 c Exceed And Excel - Sayf Shamal by Elusive Quality) took out yesterday's Chairman's Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m), becoming the first two-year-old this season to land a second black type victory.

In the wake of Zulfiqar's length-and-a-quarter-victory over Veecee (Capitalist) at Sandown, bookmakers reacted by cutting the James Cummings-trained colt to \$11 for the February 25 Blue Diamond Stakes, having opened the day a \$51 chance.

Zulfiqar, who jumped as the \$7 third-elect, kicked through under Ben Melham to lead from barrier one and was not headed for the remainder of the contest, pulling away from race favourite Veecee (Capitalist) over the concluding stages to record a dominant victory. First stakes winner for Santos

Aquis Farm's first season sire Santos (I Am Invincible) sired both his first winner and first stakes winner from just ten runners yesterday when his daughter Ulanova (2 f ex The Fairy's Kiss by Elusive Quality) hacked up in the Taranaki 2YO Classic (Gr 3, 1200m) at New Plymouth. << *Continued from page 1* of Arrowfield's first season sire Showtime (Snitzel), finished third, three lengths from the winner.

Melham, who rode the colt to win the Maribyrnong Trial Stakes (Listed, 1000m) in October, said that a spell over the summer had done his horse the world of good.

"He has come back a better horse," Melham said. "James (Cummings) actually said that he was the first horse born on the farm.

"These early season two-year-olds, it's got to count for something. He was able to control the race, get to the right part of the track and win really well."

Having never raced beyond 1000 metres, the question remains over whether the colt can run out a strong six furlongs, but Melham believes Zalfiqar will prove a leading contender in the Blue Diamond Stakes.

"He is a very sensible horse," Melham said. "He was very strong to the line and through the line so that is very important. He will run well in the [Blue] Diamond."

Godolphin won the 2019 Blue Diamond Stakes with Lyre (Lonhro), adding to Daumier's triumph 12 months ago, while in 2020 and 2021 the royal blue silks of Sheikh Mohammed finished second as Hanseatic (Street Boss) and Ingratiating (Frosted) posted near misses.

Yesterday's result continued the stellar form of two-year-olds by Darley's linchpin stallion Exceed And Excel (Danehill), who this season has two individual juvenile stakes winners and three stakes placegetters, as well as market protagonist for both the Blue Diamond and Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) next month in Barber, winner of the Kirkham (1000m) and \$1 million Golden Gift (1000m) before Christmas.

Exceed And Excel sits second on the Australian two-year-old sires premiership behind Better Than Ready (More Than Ready), who sired last month's Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) winner Skirt The Law.

Godolphin could have up to three runners in the Blue Diamond this season, with Barber set to make his return to the track in next week's Blue Diamond Prelude (Gr 3, 1100m) before tackling the \$2 million feature second-up, while Amur (Snitzel), a winner of two juvenile handicaps at Moonee Valley, is also set to line up in the juvenile Group 1 at Sandown. *Continued on page 4>>*

Zulfiqar is the first foal out of US-bred mare Sayf Shamal (Elusive Quality), a debut winner for British-based trainer Charlie Appleby at Kempton Park in 2018, but was retired to stud after an unplaced finish at her second start. She is a half-sister to Alizes (Rory's Jester), herself the dam of Group 1 winners Alizee (Sepoy) and Astern (Medaglia D'Oro), as well as Group 2-placed colt-turned-stallion Tassort (Brazen Beau).

Sayf Shamal has subsequently produced a yearling brother to Zulfiqar, while her weanling foal is a filly by Lonhro (Octagonal). She was sent back to Exceed And Excel off a November cover this breeding season.

Aft Cabin stamps Guineas credentials on return

Godolphin's success continued in Sydney in the Eskimo Prince Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) as star colt Aft Cabin (3 c Astern - Shelters by Lonhro) returned to the track with a dominant win over Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m) placegetter Zou Tiger (Zoustar).

Aft Cabin's spring preparation was cut short after suffering a bleeding attack following trackwork, with the colt the red-hot favourite for the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) having won the Caulfield Guineas Prelude (Gr 2, 1400m) in stylish fashion.

Jumping from barrier seven, Aft Cabin settled behind the leading pair, and travelled superior into the straight as he drew clear untroubled to win by a length and three-quarters. Communist (Russian Revolution) followed Zou Tiger in finishing third, two and a half lengths from the winner.

Trainer James Cummings was gleeful about the colt's return to the races.

"He had so much promise about him in the spring," Cummings said. "I feel like he is in for a wonderful campaign."

"I am going to enjoy nominating him for all the good races on Tuesday."

Aft Cabin was partnered by James McDonald, who echoed Cummings' sentiments.

"He oozes so much quality and just floats across the ground," McDonald said. "An unbelievable turn of foot and he can only improve off of today's outing."

Aft Cabin is as short as \$1.80 in all-in markets for the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) on March 4. Golden Mile, Godolphin's Caulfield Guineas winner, and fellow son of Astern, is an \$11 chance after he finished second on his return in the Expressway Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) last weekend.

Madeira rises to the challenge

The Lonhro Plate (Listed, 1000m) at Randwick yesterday went the way of the Michael Freedman-trained filly Madeira Sunrise (2 f I Am Invincible - Indrabeel by Savabeel), who produced a strong finish to defeat race favourite Sicillian (I Am Invincible), making it a quinella for Yarraman Park's champion sire I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) in the Listed two-year-old contest.

However, the race was not without drama before the off, as six two-year-olds headed to the barriers, but only five started after Mexico (Mexico) was a late scratching behind the gates.

As the field turned for home, it was the fillies Madeira Sunrise and Sicillian that battled for supremacy from the 300-metre mark, and it was the latter that proved too tough, finding enough late to prevail.

Ridden by James McDonald, the champion jockey noted Madeira Sunrise still had a lot to learn but saw potential with the win given how tenacious she was to the line to defeat the Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained Sicillian.

<< *Continued from page 4* “She’s a pretty green filly, she’s probably got plenty of upside,” said McDonald. “She just wanted to overdo it a fraction when the speed came back out of the race. She was strong. She had to out tough a horse and she did a good job.”

Freedman delivered a jovial report of his now stakes-winning filly.

“She’s quite progressive and both her trials at Warwick farm were good trials without really being asked to do too much – I think there’s a bit of improvement to come,” Freedman said.

“If she comes through today we can look at one of the good fillies races coming up. Whether it’s the Reisling or the Sweet Embrace.”

Freedman is also the trainer of the late-scratched Mexico, and he was unsure as to what happened to his colt prior to the start.

“It’s a shame, he’s (Mexico) never done anything like that in his two race starts and his two barrier trials. I’m not sure what the story was today but it’s disappointing,” Freedman stated.

Madeira Sunrise was a \$200,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast purchase by Mitchell Bloodstock from the Yarraman Park draft, a filly that clearly slipped under the radar of buyers given the sale average was a touch over \$292,000.

The win gave Yarraman Park’s champion sire I Am Invincible a 197th individual stakes winner from 984 runners, while Waikato Stud’s roster leader Savabeel (Zabeel) earned a fourth two-year-old stakes winner and 22nd individual black type winner as a broodmare sire, a list headed by Empire Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Icebath (Sacred Falls).

Madeira Sunrise’s dam Indrabeel (Savabeel) was a three-time winner from 23 starts, with Madeira Sunrise her first foal. The mare has a filly by Deep Field (Northern Meteor) who heads to April’s Inglis Easter Sale (Lot 177) through the Yarraman Park draft.

The country’s juvenile rankings should become much clearer next week as we see colts and gelding’s Blue Diamond Prelude run alongside the fillies’ Blue Diamond Prelude (Gr 2, 1100m) at Sandown, while the \$2 million Inglis Millennium (RL, 1200m) will see the likes of Widden Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) winner Learning To Fly (Justify) and \$1.7 million yearling Kundalini (I Am Invincible) go head-to-head.



Second for Wrote

Wrote To Arataki (4 m ex Galloping Gerte by Align) became the second individual stakes winner for New Zealand-based Highview Stud stallion Wrote (High Chaparral) when the progressive filly won yesterday's Geoffrey Bellmaine Stakes (Gr 3, 1300m) at Sandown. Trained by Warrnambool-based handler Matthew Williams, Wrote To Arataki won by a long neck from Belle Et Riche (Rich Enuff) and Forbidden City (I Am Invincible), who finished a length and a half from the winner in third in the Trelawney Stud silks. Contesting her first race at stakes level yesterday, Kiwi import Wrote To Arataki backed up a victory over 1400 metres at Flemington on New Year's Day. "It is a fair transition that she has made, but you just get horses like that who can take those steps and she has got a bit of confidence out of winning," Williams said. "She used to get a bit 'stirry' on raceday but she is now a bit more relaxed about it. She has always had ability and we always thought it was there, but six months ago we didn't think we would be winning a Group 3 race and we are rapt to have it now." Wrote To Arataki could now contest the Frances Tressady Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) on February 18, while the Mannerism Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Sandown is also a possibility. "We will see what Jamie [Kah, jockey] thinks," Williams said. "If she could go a bit further then there are probably a couple of mile races as well... This is as good as we could have her and she has done a great job. I have got to thank Phill Cataldo over in New Zealand who sources these horses for us and all the team at home." Wrote To Arataki was switched to the Williams stable off the back of a trial effort at Cambridge. She is the first foal out of

dual winner Galloping Gerte (Align), herself the only foal out of Miss Reset (Reset). Galloping Gerte as an unnamed two-year-old filly named Ring Jessie (Wrote). Yearlings by Wrote, who stands for a fee of \$5,000 (plus GST), sold for up to \$75,000 during Book 2 of the NZB National Yearling Sale earlier this week, with Williams and Cataldo pairing to secure a filly by Wrote out of the Montjeu (Sadler's Wells) mare Montwest for \$45,000.

197 for I Am Invincible

Madeira Sunrise (2 f ex Indrabeel by Savabeel) provided Yarraman Park stallion I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) with a 197th individual stakes winner from 984 runners when she landed the Lonhro Plate (Listed, 1000m) on debut at Randwick yesterday. Trained by Michael Freedman, the juvenile filly was ridden by James McDonald and was always handy, despite being a little keen, before running on strongly in the closing stages to beat favourite Sicilian (I Am Invincible) by half-a-length, with a further length back to Portorosa (Not A Single) in third. A \$200,000 purchase for Mitchell Bloodstock out of the Yarraman Park draft at last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Madeira Sunrise is out of the three-time winning Savabeel (Zabeel) mare Indrabeel. The mare has a filly by Deep Field (Northern Meteor) who heads to April's Inglis Easter Sale (Lot 177) through the Yarraman Park draft. I Am Invincible stands for a fee of \$247,500 (inc GST).

Treble up for Right You Are

The Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained Right You Are (So You Think) continued his progression yesterday with a dominant win in an 1800-metre handicap at Sandown,

completing a hat-trick of successive victories. The son of So You Think (High Chaparral) suffered a suspensory injury at the end of his four-year-old campaign, but has bounced right back to his best since joining the Maher and Eustace outfit, registering a four and a quarter lengths success over Beltoro (Toronado), with a further three-quarters of a length back to the odds-on favourite Detonator Jack (Jakalberry) in third. "Ethan [Brown, jockey] took the race by the scruff of the neck," Eustace said. "They weren't going quick; he knew he was on a fit horse and was able to more that get the job done. He's an older horse now that has had an issue but he's starting to repay the ownership group. He likes fast ground, he likes this sort of trip, and hopefully he can keep going."

Remarque produces classy weight-carrying win

A return to stakes races will now be on the agenda for rapidly improving sprinter Remarque (Snitzel) after he produced a classy weight-carrying performance in yesterday's Benchmark 94 race over 1000 metres at Randwick. The Hawkes racing-trained, four-year-old gelding overcame a ten-kilogram

weight differential to scorch the turf to a length success over Listed winner Dragonstone (Mikki Isle), with a further neck back to Group 3 scorer Sebonack (Capitalist) in third place. "He's had his throat operation, he's had a gelding operation and last prep really put it on the wall for him," co-trainer Michael Hawkes said. "The horse trialled brilliantly, he was first-up today, 62 [kilograms], Timmy [Clark] rode him beautifully. He cuddled him for as long as he could and the part I loved the most is when he got to the front, he pricked his ears and said, 'is that it?'. He's an exciting horse. We've always had a lot of time for him."

Another big-odds success for Carlisle

Despite taking some skin off of his face on the way to Sandown yesterday, the John Moloney-trained Carlisle (So You Think) made no mistake on the track when securing yet another double-figure odds victory in the Benchmark 84 (1300m) contest on the card. Racing Victoria stewards passed the son of So You Think fit to race and, sent off a \$31 chance, he stayed on strongly in the closing stages to beat Hickok (Shooting To Win) by a half-length, with a further neck back to William Thomas (Nicconi) in third. "I was a bit worried about it," Moloney told Racing.com. "I said to the lady owners that I think I am more worried than anyone else. He's marked his face and took a bit of skin off. The vet passed him and I just said to the stewards, 'we don't normally have red earmuffs on him', but it covered him up and we brought him in. I guess it's a bit hard for people to understand when he hasn't had a jump-out or a trial, but he worked beautifully on Tuesday morning and I said to the lady owners that this horse has worked well and I am pretty happy with him and he'll go to the races in good shape. He is a pleasing horse and his CV looks alright with six wins from 15. He's just a genuine racehorse and you can't take that away from the horse. He's a So You Think and he could keep training on."

Melbourne Cup favourite unplaced on resumption

Coming into the race as the equal favourite for the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m), the Chris Waller-trained Soulcombe (Frankel)

ran to be unplaced in the Drinkwise Mile (1600m) at Randwick yesterday. Having made a successful Australian debut in the Queen's Cup (Gr 3, 2600m) at Flemington on November 5, the son of Frankel (Galileo) was slowest away yesterday under James McDonald and could only run on at the one pace to finish four and a quarter lengths behind odds-on winner Banju (Benfica).

Excuses for Inundation

Co-trainer Mick Price has revealed that Inundation (Headwater) will be sent to a heart specialist after he again produced a disappointing effort in the opening race at Sandown yesterday. Sent off as the odds-on favourite under Jamie Kah, the son of Headwater (Exceed And Excel) travelled well, but found nothing off the bridle and faded to finish last of the five runners, beaten four lengths by winner Tycoon Humma (Capitalist). Veterinary stewards at Sandown later reported Inundation had suffered from cardiac arrhythmia. "There's something abnormally wrong with that horse," Price, who trains in partnership with Michael Kent Jnr, told Racing.com. "It's a beautiful day, he's in good order, he's sound... but [Kah] says 100 metres after the line, this horse is wobbling like he's losing all co-ordination. So, he goes missing under pressure, he has not been a bleeder, he's beautifully sound and he's a clean-winded horse. I can only think we need to get a heart specialist on him and have a look at him. And me and junior [co-trainer Michael Kent] too. It's very abnormal for a jockey to report like that. She's a good judge Jamie; she knows what's going on."

Dubenko to tackle Blue Diamond

Chris Bieg has revealed that the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) will be the plan for his promising filly Dubenko (Russian Revolution) after she ran out a commanding winner of a Benchmark 62 contest over 1000 metres at Morphettville yesterday. Slowest away in the four-runner field, the filly comfortably beat Harleen (Written Tycoon) by one and a half lengths, with a further two and three-quarter lengths back to Kristobel (Overshare) in third. "She was very good, probably a little

bit fresh today on the back of only having just one jump-out on Tuesday, she's got plenty of improvement," Bieg told Racing.com. "Once we get into a bigger field with more tempo, it'll suit her to be ridden midfield with some cover. She's come through the run well, had a blow but recovered really quickly after the race. She'll now accept for the Blue Diamond, which is three weeks today. She'll aim to have an exhibition gallop or something a bit more serious in a fortnight's time before heading across to Melbourne."

First city winner for Jeff Dunn

Beaunes-based trainer Jeff Dunn was provided with his first city winner yesterday as two-year-old filly Glass Of Rose (Shooting To Win) came from the clouds to score in the opening contest over 1000 metres at Eagle Farm under jockey Rikki Jamieson. Ridden with patience by Jamieson, the daughter of Shooting To Win (Northern Meteor) just got up in the nick of time to run down long-time leader Bedaub (Easy Rocking) by a short-head at the line, with the pair two lengths clear of the third-placed Mishani Ambitious (Rothesay), reversing the form with the Les Ross-trained rival after finishing fourth behind her on debut at Ipswich. Purchased for \$32,500 by Matilda Koch at last year's Magic Millions National Yearling Sale, Glass Of Rose is out of the two-time winning Testa Rossa (Perugino) mare Sky Rubi.

Jaylah Kennedy to make riding debut

Apprentice jockey Jaylah Kennedy will take her first ride as a professional today as she gets aboard El Santo (Press Statement) in the final race on the Ararat card. Kennedy has the benefit of already knowing the horse well as it has been trained by her employer and mentor Dan O'Sullivan. "It's really been a long time coming, I probably should've been at the races four or so months ago, but I was out injured," Kennedy told Racing.com. "I got hurt in the gym, so it's been a bit of a long road, but I'm really looking forward to it. I'm fully back. Still getting my fitness up a bit, but I'm at a place where I'm pretty happy to be heading to the races. [I'm] pretty lucky to have a lot of good

people around supporting me, I'm pretty glad to finally be here. He's [O'Sullivan] looking after me a bit. [El Santo] is a perfect first ride; he's such a gentleman, he's a pretty good apprentice horse. I haven't drawn the fanciest of barriers, but we'll figure it out and hopefully can get a bit of luck; he's going well so we'll see how we go."

Aquis Farm's first season sire Santos (I Am Invincible) sired both his first winner and first stakes winner from just ten runners yesterday when his daughter Ulanova (2 f ex The Fairy's Kiss by Elusive Quality) hacked up in the Taranaki 2YO Classic (Gr 3, 1200m) at New Plymouth. Ridden by Craig Grylls for trainer Stephen Marsh, the filly was sent off the \$3 favourite following a fourth-placed effort in the Karaka Million 2YO (Listed, 1200m) last time out. She made her class tell here with a pillar-to-post effort, cruising six and three-quarter lengths clear of Lantern Way (Satono Aladdin), with a further half-length back to She Turns Heads (Headwater) in third. "We jumped, found the lead and got it reasonably soft," Grylls said. "Talking to Stephen [Marsh] before the race I said I would try and cuddle her up for as long as possible and she kicked away, where it was pretty easy in the end. She was strong right through the line and I think she is a pretty fair animal who we will see a lot more of." Bred by Ancroft Stud, Ulanova was a \$150,000 purchase for bloodstock agent Michael Wallace out of the Kilgravin Lodge draft at last year's New Zealand Bloodstock's National Yearling Sale. Out of the Group 3-placed winner The Fairy's Kiss (Elusive Quality), she is a half-sister to Merson Cooper

Perfect Scenario (5 g ex Rosetti Bay by Pins) provided his sire Iffraaj (Zafonic) with a 91st individual stakes winner from 1798 starters, when coming home a comfortable victor of the White Robe Lodge (Gr 3, 1600m) at Wingatui yesterday. Also providing trainer Mark Walker and owners Te Akau Racing with an across-the-card feature-race double, the five-year-old gelding took advantage of stablemate and favourite Prise De Fer's (Savabeel) disappointing display to make it a one-horse affair in the closing stages, streaking three and a quarter lengths clear of Live Drama (Ghibellines), with a further three-quarters of a length back to Rock Sensation (Rock 'N' Pop) in third place. "That is a fantastic result for the horse as he has been such an honest performer for us and deserved to get a win like this," Te Akau Racing assistant Sam Bergerson said. "I also thought it was a sensational ride by Joe [Kamaruddin] as he rode for luck and it paid off for him. There was some talk that the inside was off and we should look to go wide. Joe backed himself and when he got the inside

Sporting blinkers for the first time in the hands of jockey Brandon May, the Bruce Tapper and Varma Ramhit-trained three-year-old came around his rivals entering the home straight and strode clear from the 200-metre mark to beat Romancing The Moon (El Roca) by one and a half lengths, with a further three and three-quarter lengths back to Charbano (Vespa) in

third. "Brandon said if he didn't hang out a bit he would have on the steel," Tapper said. "The blinkers helped him as well and so did the firm track, he needs good going. He'll go to Invercargill first for the Southland Guineas and then on to Wellington."

He's done a great job and good horses can do it."

SGP: Star Legend gives Peters first win of the season

Relative newcomer Star Legend (Exosphere) handed trainer James Peters his first win of the season after he emerged victorious in yesterday's 1200-metre maiden at Kranji.

Peters, who finished eighth with 27 winners on the trainers' log last year, was the last of 23 trainers at Kranji to open his 2023 account with his 22nd runner. Star Legend, a four-year-old son of Exosphere (Lonhro), settled in midfield on the rails after leaving the stalls and stayed on strongly under a drive from jockey Louis-Philippe Beuzelin to score by a head from favourite Tributo (Capitalist) with a further half-length back to debutant Schneider (Mr Speaker) in third. "He's just won a maiden [race] today, but I do think he's going to get better after he steps up to the 1400 and 1600 metres," Peters said. "Pleased for the owner who supported me with a few young horses, and this one's got a lot of potential. We'll see what's available and maybe run him in a Novice or Class 4 race over 1400 metres in three to four weeks' time. He's a big, strong and mature horse so I think he can take his racing. It was a bit rushed [during his] last preparation to get him to the races [at his] last start, but he's trialled nicely in two trials. He's strong to the line and he had to fight. He's done a good job today. We've had a slow start, but with two seconds and two thirds, we knew the time would come. I'm just relieved that we won."

He was my first ride (on January 14), but I told myself to enjoy myself at my first ride. But I expected him to win today because he's drawn gate two and my four-kilo claim can help him."

UK: Middle Eastern buyers prominent on day two of February Sale

Day two of the Tattersalls February Sale on Friday saw the William Haggas-trained Mohatu (Roaring Lion) purchased for 80,000gns (approx. AU\$139,940) by Abdullah Salman Hamoud Alsabah when offered by Jamie Railton. The three-year-old was catalogued as the winner of one race, but had doubled his tally with the

help of the stewards having been promoted from second to first after being bumped in the closing stages of a Southwell handicap over a mile; eight days before coming under the hammer. Mohatu previously ran in the colours of Qatar Racing, as did his sire, the three-time Group 1 scorer Roaring Lion (Kitten's Joy). He is the first foal out of the winning mare Tiger Eye, a Frankel (Galileo) half-sister to the Group 2-winning sprinters Caspian Prince (Dylan Thomas) and Spirit Quartz (Invincible Spirit). "He has been bought to race in Saudi Arabia," Alsabah said. "I now have seven horses and I will own and train him. He's an improving horse with good form. The programme is expanding in Saudi Arabia and it is thriving. The [racing] surface is very good, which is so important for the horses." Yesterday's top lot saw classy flat operator Brentford Hope (Camelot) bought for 90,000gns (approx. AU\$157,430) by fledgling jumps trainer Harry Derham. A son of Camelot (Montjeu), he has been placed at stakes level on three occasions, including in the 2021 renewal of the Premio Roma Italian Champions (Gr 2, 2000m).

UK: Goffs to offer breeding rights in Profitable and Cloth Of Stars

Goffs has announced initial entries for the online sale of stallion breeding rights to be held following the February Sale next Friday, with rights in Darley's established King's Stand Stakes (Gr 1 5f)-winning sire Profitable (Invincible Spirit) and the promising Cloth Of Stars (Sea The Stars). Kildangan Stud's Profitable has sired two Group 2-winning sprinters from his first two

crops in Queen Mary Stakes (Gr 2, 5f) victress Quick Suzy and Prix du Calvados (Gr 2, 1400m) scorer Wed. Profitable's yearlings sold for up to 150,000gns in 2022, while he also covered 116 mares that year. He is standing for a fee of €9,000 (approx. AU\$14,070) this year. Among his first winners is the William Haggas-trained Laafi, who took the same Nottingham maiden won by Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) heroes Golden Horn (Cape Cross) and Adayar (Frankel) at two. Cloth Of Stars' fee this year is €7,000 (approx. AU\$10,940).

UAE: Valiant Prince remains unbeaten in Meydan

The Charlie Appleby-trained Valiant Prince (5 g Dubawi - Chachamaidee by Footstepsinthesand) landed his third straight stakes success when he ran out a narrow victor of Friday's Singpiel Stakes (Gr 2, 1800m) at Meydan. Having reappeared with a decisive win in the Al Rashidiya (Gr 2, 1800m) last month, the five-year-old son of Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) travelled well throughout the contest and ran on strongly to lead on the line, beating last year's Jebel Hatta (Gr 1, 1800m) winner Alfareeq (Dark Angel) by a short-head with a further one and a quarter lengths back to stablemate and favourite Ottoman Fleet (Sea The Stars) in third. The win now takes Valiant Prince's Meydan record to four wins from the same number of starts.
